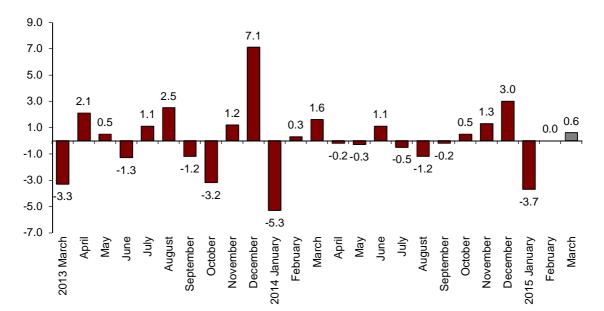
#### Industrial New Orders Received Indices (INORI). Base 2010 March 2015. Provisional data

#### The monthly variation of the General Industrial New Orders Received Index stands at 0.6% after adjusting for the seasonal and calendar effects

## The annual rate stands at 0.2% in the series adjusted for the seasonal and calendar effects and at 2.4% in the original series

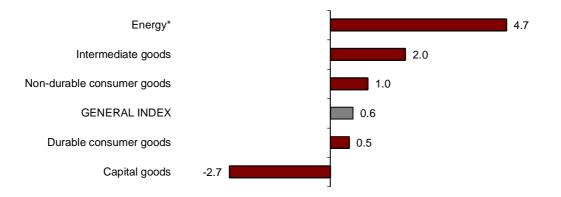
#### Monthly evolution of New Orders Received

The monthly variation of the Industrial New Orders Received Index (INORI) between March and February stood at 0.6%, after adjusting for the seasonal and calendar effects. This rate was six tenth higher than that registered the previous month.



New Orders Received General Index Adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects. Monthly rate By economic destination of the goods, four out of five sectors registered positive monthly rates. Energy (4.7%) and Intermediate goods (2.0%) registered the greatest increases. The only sector to register a decrease was Capital goods (-2.7%).

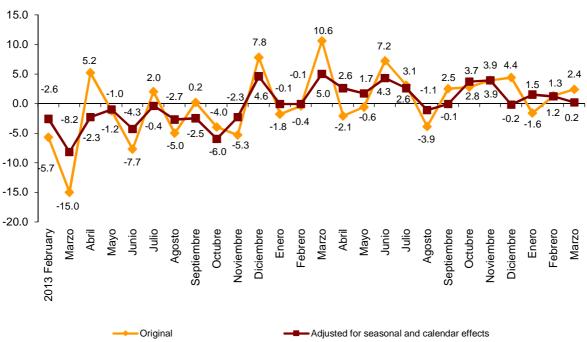
#### Annual evolution of the New Orders Received

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The Industrial New Orders Received Index (INORI), after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, registered a variation of 0.2% in March, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate was one point lower than that registered in February 2015.

The original series of the INORI registered an annual variation of 2.4%, that is, 1.1 points higher than that registered in February 2015.



## Industry New Orders Received General Index Annual rates

By economic destination of the goods, three out of five sectors recorded positive rates, after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects. Durable consumer goods (9.8%) registered the greatest increase (9.8%), whereas Energy registered the greatest decrease (–17.0%).

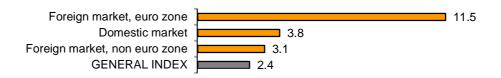

## Annual evolution of New Orders Received by destination market. Original series

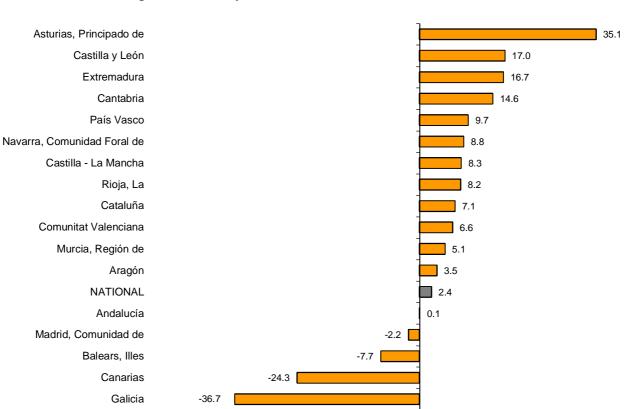
By geographical destination, in March, all markets registered positive annual rates. Worth noting was the increase of 11.5% in the euro zone of the foreign market.

## Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rate of the industrial turnover. Original series

Turnover increased in the annual rate in 13 Autonomous Community and decreased in the remaining four. The greatest increase was recorded in Principado de Asturias (35.1%) and the greatest decrease was registered in Galicia (--36.7%).
