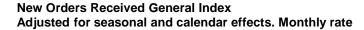
Industrial New Orders Received Indices (INORI). Base 2010 April 2017. Provisional data

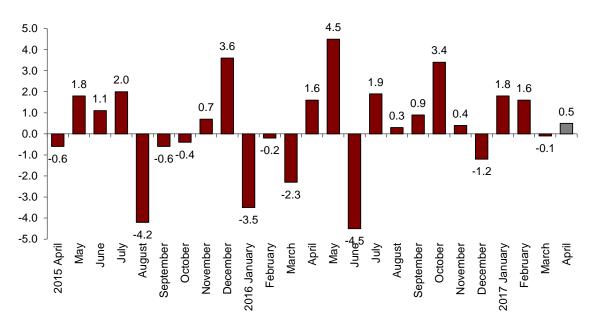
The monthly variation of the General Industry New Order Entries Rates¹ is 0.5% if the seasonal and calendar effects are eliminated

The annual rate stands at 9.5% in the series adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects, and at 0.0% in the original series

Monthly evolution of New Orders Received

The monthly variation of the Industrial New Orders Received Index between April and March stood at 0.5%, after adjusting for the seasonal and calendar effects. This rate is six tenths higher than that of the previous month.



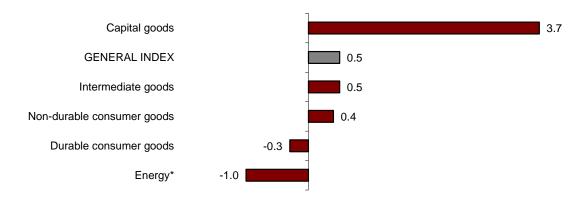


¹ As reflected in the methodology of this rate of value, the information is presented in current terms (nominal terms), this is, without adjusting the effects in the price variation of it.

By economic destination of the goods, *Capital goods* (3.7%), *Intermediate goods* (0.5%) and *Non-durable consumer goods* (0.4%) registered positive monthly rates.

In turn, Energy (-1.0%) and Durable consumer goods (-0.3%) registered negative rates.

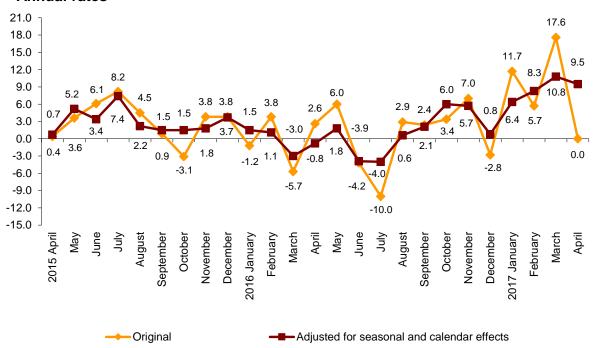

Annual evolution of New Orders Received

The Industrial New Orders Received Index (INORI), after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, registered a variation of 9.5% in April, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate is 1.3 points lower than that registered in March.

The original series of the INORI registered an annual variation of 0.0%. This rate is 17.6 points lower than that registered in March.

Industry New Orders Received General Index Annual rates



By economic destination of the goods, the indices adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects recorded positive annual rates in all the sectors analysed. Among them, worth noting was the increase of *Energy* (34.7%).

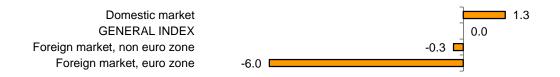

Annual evolution of New Orders Received by market. Original series

By geographical destination of sales, in April two out of the three markets analysed registered negative annual rates. Worth noting was the 6.0% decrease in the euro zone of the foreign market.

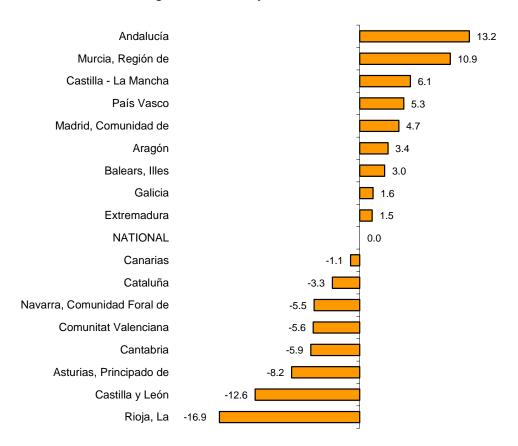
Industrial new orders received indices: General and by market Annual rate



Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rate of the Industrial New Orders Received. Original series

New orders received increased in nine Autonomous Communities and decreased in the remaining eight as compared to April 2016. The highest increases were registered in Andalucía (13.2%), Región de Murcia (10.9%) and Castilla-La Mancha (6.1%), while the highest decreases were registered in La Rioja (-16.9%), Castilla y León (-12.6%) and Principado de Asturias (-8.2%).
