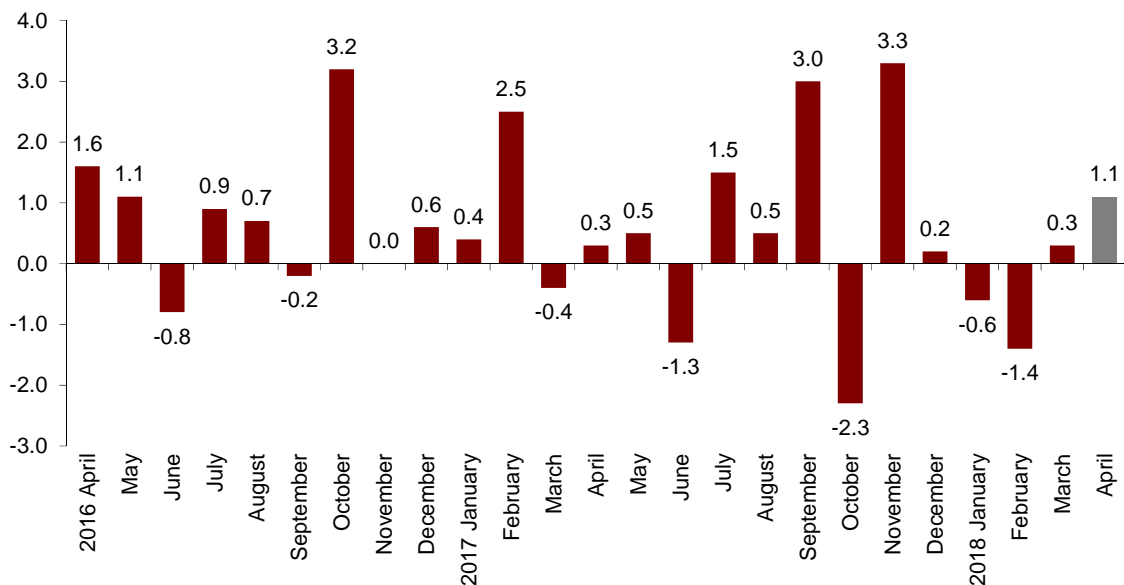
The monthly variation of the General Industrial New Orders Received Index¹ is 1.1% after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects

The annual rate stands at 4.8% in the series adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects and at 12.9% in the original series

Monthly evolution of Industrial New Orders Received

The monthly variation of the Industrial New Orders Received Index between April and March stood at 1.1%, after adjusting for the seasonal and calendar effects. This rate is eight tenths higher than that of the previous month.

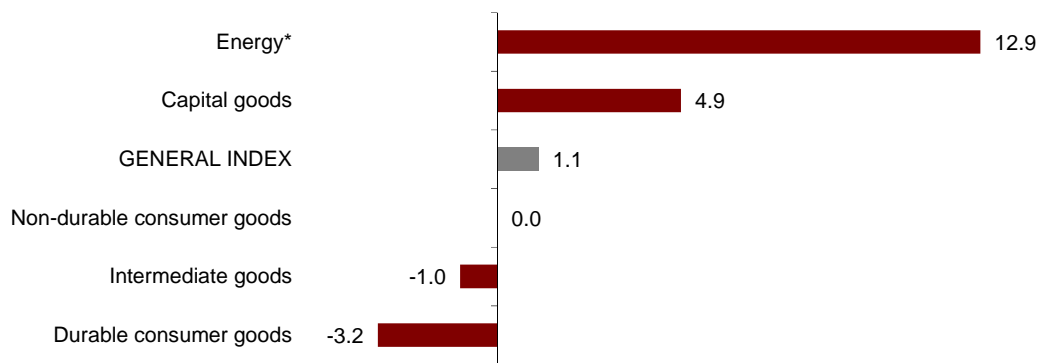
New Orders Received General Index

¹As reflected in the methodology of this value index, the information is presented in current terms (nominal terms), this is, without adjusting the effects in the price variation of it.

By economic destination of the goods, *Energy*² (12.9%) and *Capital goods* (4.9%) recorded positive monthly rates. *Durable consumer goods* (-3.2%) and *Intermediate goods* (-1.0%) recorded negative monthly rates.

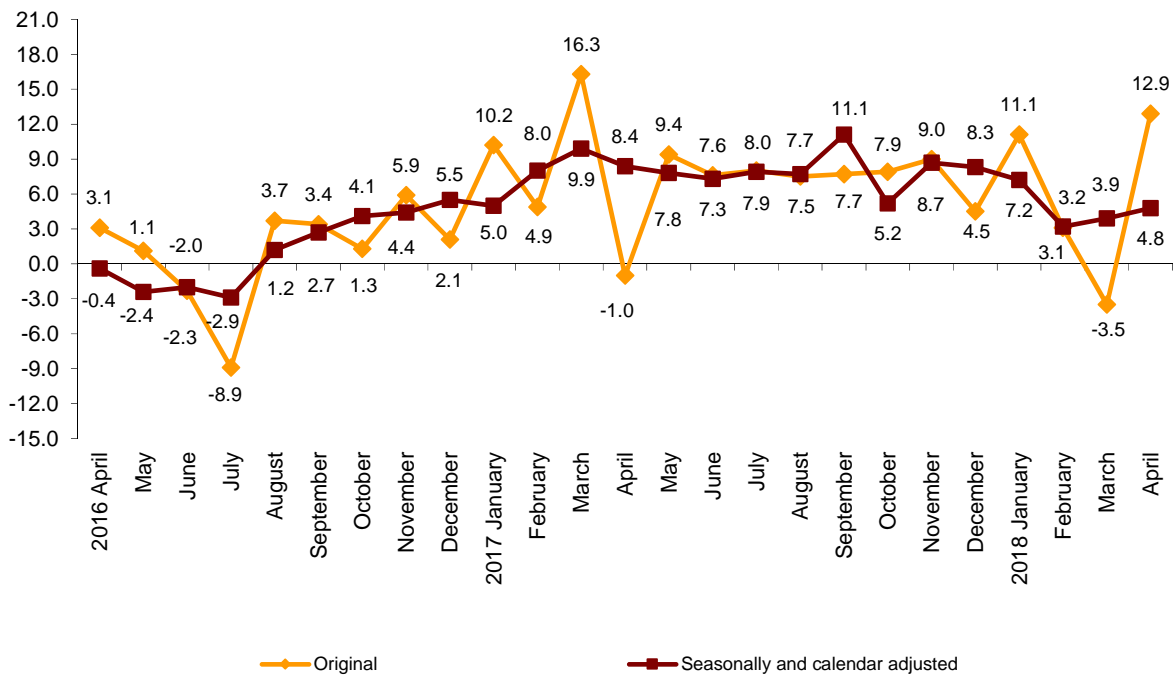

Annual evolution of New Orders Received

The Industrial New Orders Received Index (INORI), after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, registered a variation of 4.8% in April, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate is almost one percentage point higher than in March.

The original series of the INORI registered an annual variation of 12.9%. This rate is 16.4 points higher than that registered in March.

Industry New Orders Received General Index Annual rates



By economic destination of the goods, the indices adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects showed positive annual rates in four of the five sectors analysed. Worth noting was the increase in *Energy*² (30.3%).

Annual evolution of New Orders Received by market. Original series

By geographical destination of sales, in April, all the markets showed positive annual rates. The euro zone of the foreign market registered the greatest increase, 15.3%.

Industry New Orders Received Indices: General and by market Annual rate

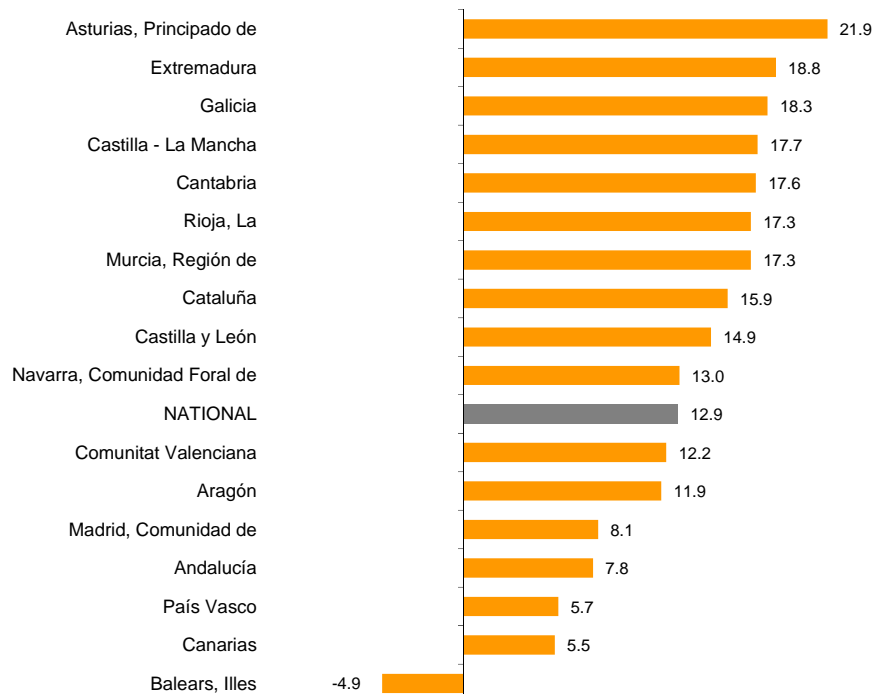


Results by Autonomous Communities. Annual variation rates of the Industrial

New Orders Received. Original series

New orders received increased as compared to April 2017 in 16 Autonomous Communities and only decreased in Illes Balears (-4.9%). The greatest increases were recorded in Principado de Asturias (21.9%), Extremadura (18.8%) and Galicia (18.3%).
