
### Industrial New Orders Received Indices (INORI). Base 2010 August 2015. Provisional data


The monthly variation of the General Industrial New Orders
Received Index<sup>1</sup> stands at -4.4% after adjusting for the seasonal<sup>2</sup>
and calendar effects

The annual rate stands at 1.7% in the series adjusted for the seasonal and calendar effects and at 4.2% in the original series

#### Monthly evolution of New Orders Received

The monthly variation of the Industrial New Orders Received Index (INORI) between August and July stood at –4.4%, after adjusting for the seasonal and calendar effects. This rate was 7.1 points lower than that registered the previous month.





<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> During the summer months, the seasonal adjustment may be influenced upwards or downwards, because of changes in the vacation pattern in comparison with its previous guidelines.

By economic destination of the goods, all sectors registered negative monthly rates. Worth noting was the decrease of Capital goods (-0.8%) followed by Energy (-6.9%).



#### Annual evolution of the New Orders Received

The Industrial New Orders Received Index (INORI), after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, registered a variation of 1.7% in August, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate was 5.5 points lower than that registered in July 2015.

The original series of the INORI registered an annual variation of 4.2%, that is, 4.0 points lower than that registered in July 2015.

#### **Industry New Orders Received General Index Annual rates**



By economic destination of the goods, three out of five sectors recorded positive rates, after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects. Capital goods (27.8%) registered the greatest increase.



By geographical destination, in August, all markets registered positive annual rates. Worth noting was the increase of 16.2% in the non-euro zone of the foreign market.


#### Industrial new orders received indices: General and by market Annual rate



### Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rate of the Industrial New Orders Received. Original series

New orders received increased in the annual rate in 12 Autonomous Communities and decreased in the remaining five as compared to August 2014. The greatest increase was recorded in Comunitat Valenciana (23.9%) and the greatest decrease was registered in Canarias (–28.3%).
