
#### Industrial New Orders Received Indices (INORI). Base 2010 September 2017. Provisional data

The monthly variation of the General Industrial New Orders Received Index<sup>1</sup> is 5.0% after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects

The annual rate stands at 14.9% in the series adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects, and at 11.9% in the original series

#### **Monthly evolution of New Orders Received**


The monthly variation of the Industrial New Orders Received Index between September and August stood at 5.0%, after adjusting for the seasonal and calendar effects. This rate was 4.3 points higher than that registered in the previous month.



<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> As reflected in the methodology of this value index, the information is presented in current terms (nominal terms), this is, without adjusting the effects in the price variation thereof.

By economic destination of goods, all sectors had positive monthly rates. Worth noting were the increases in Capital goods (13.8%) and Energy (8.3%).



#### Monthly evolution of New Orders Received

The Industry New Order Received Index (INORI) adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects, registered a variation of 14.9% in September, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate was 6.5 points higher than that registered in August.

The original series of the INORI registered an annual variation of 11.9%. This rate was 6.5 points higher than that registered in August.

### Industry New Orders Received General Index Annual rates



By economic destination of goods, the indices adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects recorded positive annual rates in all the sectors analysed. The greatest increases were registered in Energy (27.9%) and Capital goods (23.7%).



By geographical destination of sales, in September, all the markets showed positive annual rates. Worth noting was the 17.0% increase in the euro zone of the foreign market.


### Industrial new orders received indices: General and by market Annual rate



### Results by Autonomous Communities. Annual variation rate of the Industrial. New Orders Received. Original series

New orders received increased in 12 Autonomous Communities and decreased in the remaining five as compared to September 2016. The greatest increase was recorded in Comunidad de Madrid (76.8%) and the greatest decrease was registered in Galicia (-8.8%).
