**Industrial New Orders Received Indices (INORI). Base 2010**  
October 2015. *Provisional data*

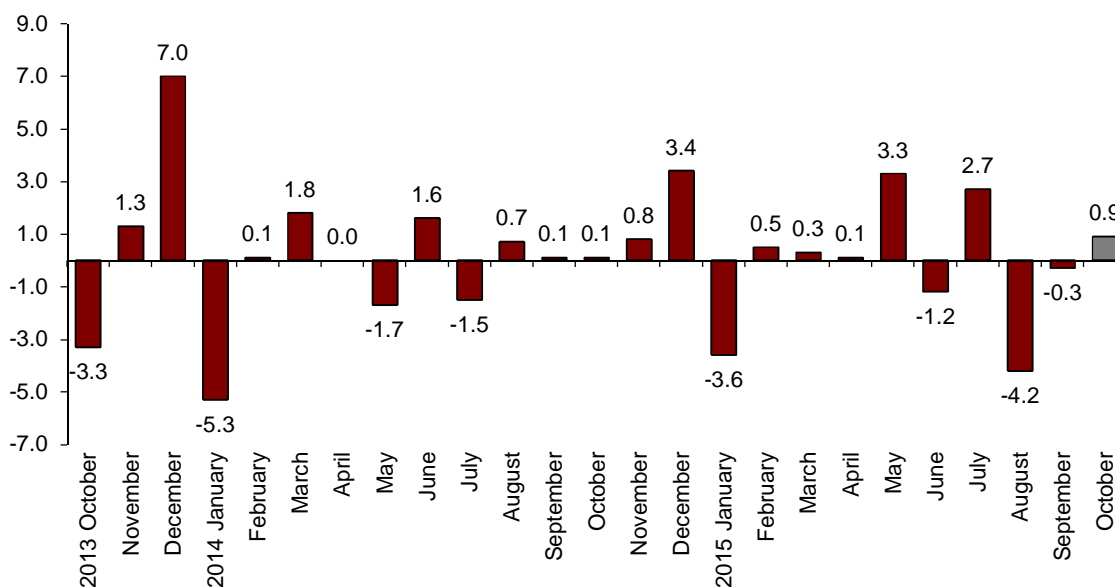
**The monthly variation of the General Industrial New Orders Received Index<sup>1</sup> stands at 0.9% after adjusting for the seasonal and calendar effects**

**The annual rate stands at 2.3% in the series adjusted for the seasonal and calendar effects and at –2.8% in the original series**

**Monthly evolution of New Orders Received**

The monthly variation of the Industrial New Orders Received Index (INORI) between October and September stood at 0.9%, after adjusting for the seasonal and calendar effects. This rate was 1.2 points higher than that registered the previous month.

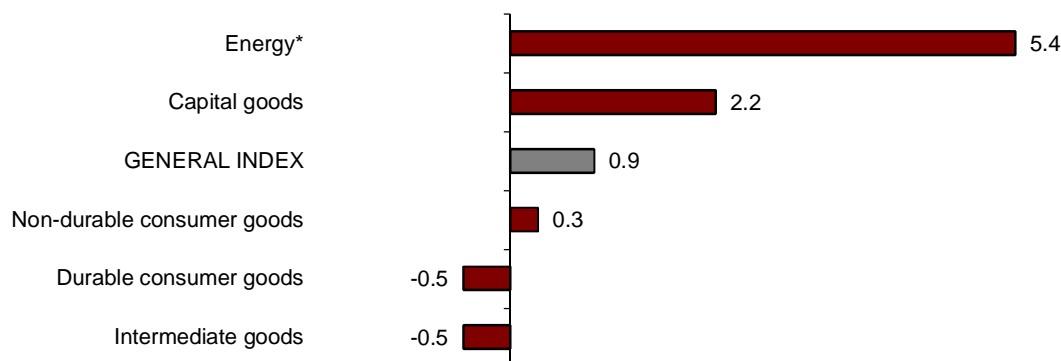
**New Orders Received General Index**

<sup>1</sup> As explained in the methodology for this value unit index, information is presented in current terms (nominal terms), that is, without adjusting the effects in the price variation of it.

By economic destination of the goods, Energy (5.4%), Capital goods (2.2%), and Non-durable consumer goods (0.3%) registered positive monthly rates. In turn, Intermediate goods (−0.5%), and Durable consumer goods (−0.5%) registered negative monthly rates.

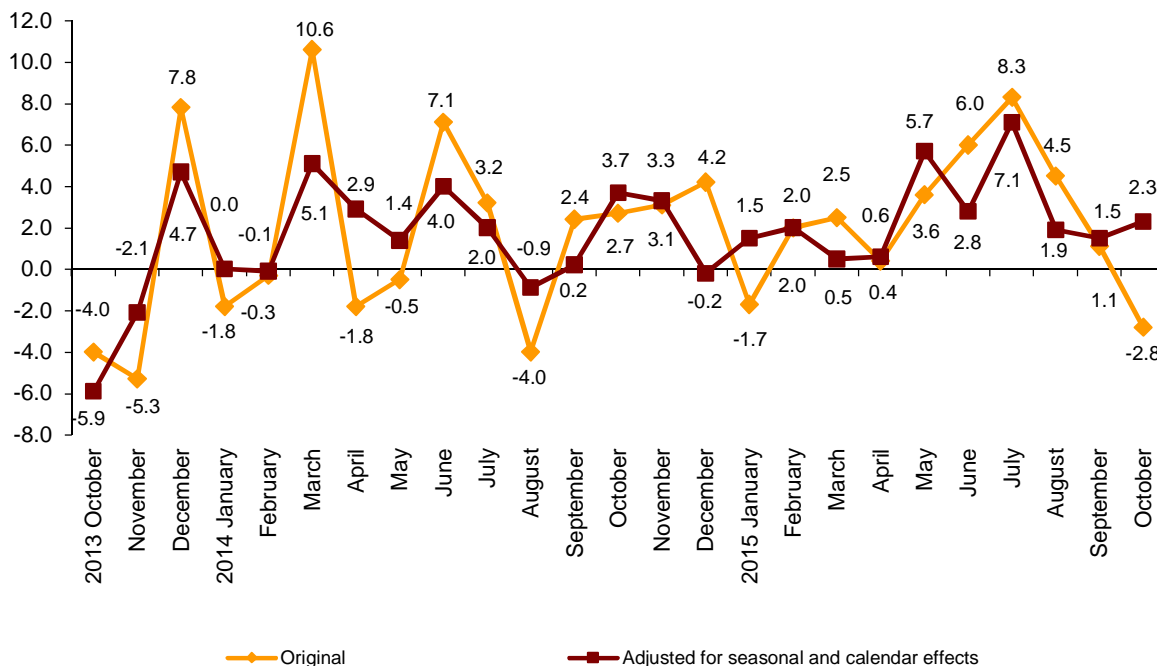

### Annual evolution of the New Orders Received

The Industrial New Orders Received Index (INORI), after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, registered a variation of 2.3% in October, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate was eight tenths higher than that registered in September 2015.

The original series of the INORI registered an annual variation of -2.8%, that is, nearly four points lower than that registered in September 2015.

#### Industry New Orders Received General Index Annual rates



By economic destination of the goods, four out of five sectors recorded positive rates, after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects. Capital goods (8.8%) registered the greatest increase.

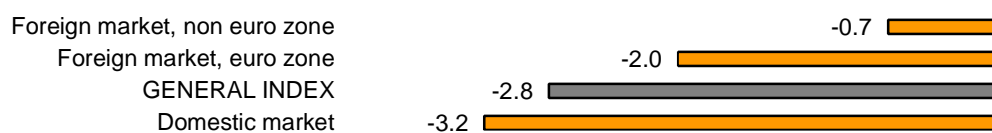

By geographical destination, in October, all the markets recorded negative annual rates. Worth noting was the decrease of 3.2% in the domestic market.

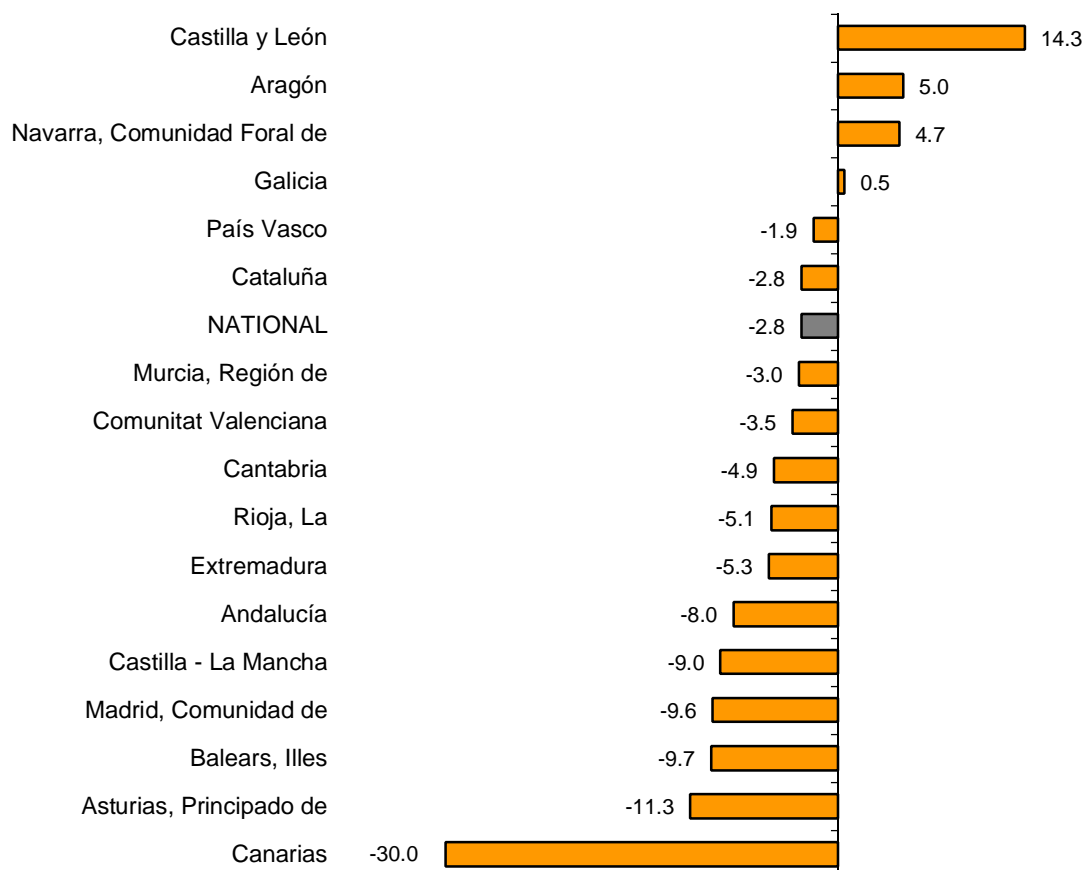
**Industrial new orders received indices: General and by market

**Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rate of the Industrial New Orders Received. Original series**

New orders received decreased in the annual rate in 13 Autonomous Communities and increased in the remaining four as compared to October 2014. The greatest decrease was registered in Canarias (-30.0%) and the greatest increase was registered in Castilla y León (14.3%).
