Industrial New Orders Received Indices (INORI). Base 2010 December 2013. Provisional data

The annual rate of the General Industrial New Orders Received Index stands at 4.6% in the series adjusted for the seasonal and calendar effects and at 7.8% in the original series

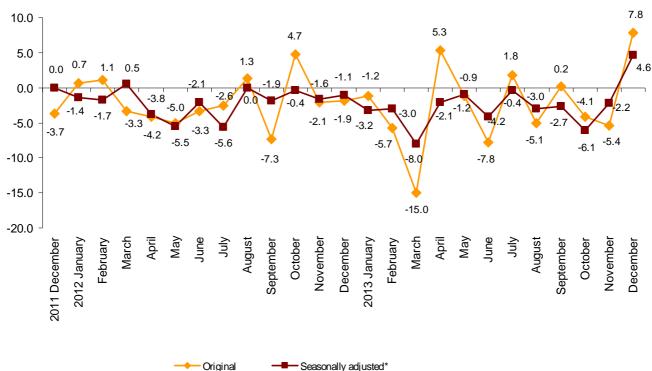
The monthly variation stands at 6.2%, adjusted for the seasonal and calendar effects

The Industrial New Orders Received Index (INORI) registered an annual variation of 7.8% in December, more than 13 points over that registered in November.

After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, the annual rate stood at 4.6%, nearly seven points higher than that of November.

The average of the general index of 2013 registered a variation rate of -2.7%, as compared with the average of 2012.

Annual evolution of the New Orders Received by economic destination of the goods

Three of the sectors analysed registered a decrease in the value of the orders received in December, as compared with the same month of 2012, in particular in Energy (–9.7%). The other two sectors registered an increase, in particular Capital goods (33.0%).

After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, the annual variation remained negative in three sectors and positive in two sectors. Worth noting again Energy (–10.2%) and Capital goods (29.4%).

In turn, the average of the general index in 2013 recorded negative rates in all sectors, except in Capital goods (1.6%).

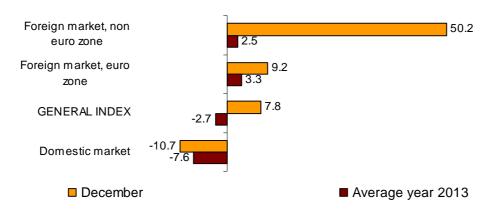
Annual evolution of New Orders Received by destination market

In December, new orders received registered an increase in all markets, as compared with the same month of 2012, except for Domestic market (–10.7%).

The greatest increase was registered in new orders received from the non euro zone, with an annual rate of 50.2%.

In turn, the average variation of 2013, as compared with 2012 was positive within the foreign markets and negative in the domestic market (-7.6%).

Industrial new orders received indices: General and by market Annual and average rate 2013



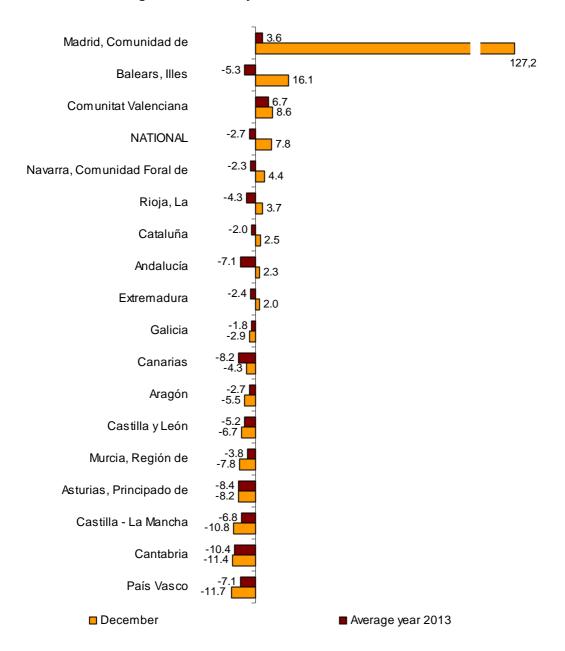
Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rate of the New Orders Received.

In December, nine Autonomous Communities registered decreases in their New Orders Received, as compared with the same month of 2012. País Vasco (-11.7%), Cantabria (-11.4%) and Castilla-La Mancha (-10.8%) showed the greatest drops.

In turn, Comunidad de Madrid registered the greatest rise (127.2%).

The average of the general index in 2013 decreased in all Autonomous Communities, except in Comunitat Valenciana (6.7%) and Comunidad de Madrid (3.6%).

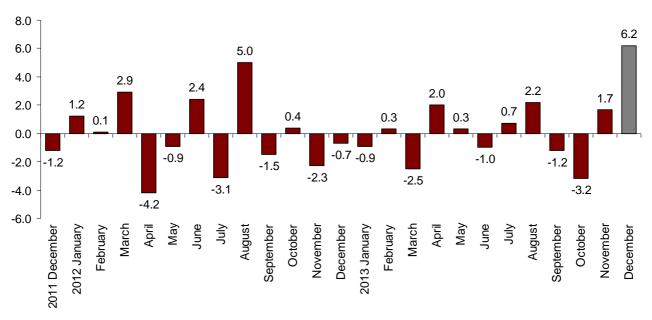
General indices: national and by Autonomous Community Annual and average rate of Industry New Orders Received

The General Industrial New Orders Received Index variation between December and November, after adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, was 6.2%. This rate was four points and a half above that of November.

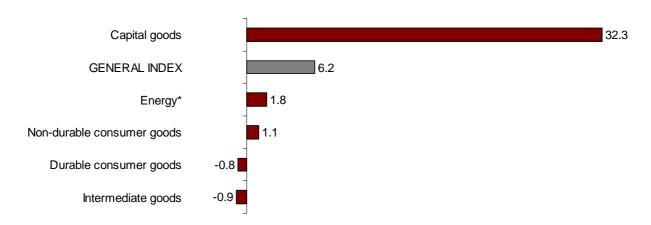
New Orders Received General Index Seasonally and calendar adjusted. Monthly rate

After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, three sectors registered positive monthly rates and two sectors presented negative variations. It is worth noting the increase of new orders received in Capital goods (32.3%).
