Industrial Turnover Indices (ITI). Base 2005
Industrial New Orders Received Indices (INORI). Base 2005
September 2011. *Provisional data*

Main results

- The annual rate of the **Industrial Turnover Index** stands at **4.4%** in the month of September, more than five points lower than that registered in August.
- By economic destination of the goods, **all sectors register positive interannual rates, except Durable consumer goods**.
- The **variation of average** Turnover is **6.7%** in the first nine months of the year.
- The annual variation rate of **New Orders Received** in the month of September is **5.6%**, among four points lower than in August.
- The **average rate** of the General Industrial New Orders Received Index stands at **7.2%** in the first nine months of the year.

Evolution of Industrial Turnover

The Industrial Turnover Index (ITI) experienced an interannual variation of **4.4%** in September, more than five points lower than that registered in August.

By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors that presented the greatest positive effects on the general index were:

- **Energy**, with an annual variation of **31.3%** and an effect of **2.494** on the general index, due to the increase observed in the *Manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products*.
- **Capital goods**, with an annual rate of **5.5%** and an effect of **1.310**, mainly due to the increase in the *Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers*.
- **Non-durable consumer goods**, with an annual rate of **2.2%** and an effect of **0.627**. Turnover increased in half of the activities in this sector, with the increase in the *Food industries (except grain mill products and food for animals)* worth noting, due to its influence.

In turn, the **Durable consumer goods** sector was the only sector to have a negative influence on the general index, with an annual variation of **-14.6%** and an effect of **-0.421**, as a result of the negative evolution in almost all activities comprising this sector. Among these drops, worth highlighting was the *Manufacture of consumer electronics, optical instruments and photographic equipment*.

Details of the interannual variations

A more detailed analysis showed the activities that had the greatest effect on the annual rate of the ITI for the month of September.

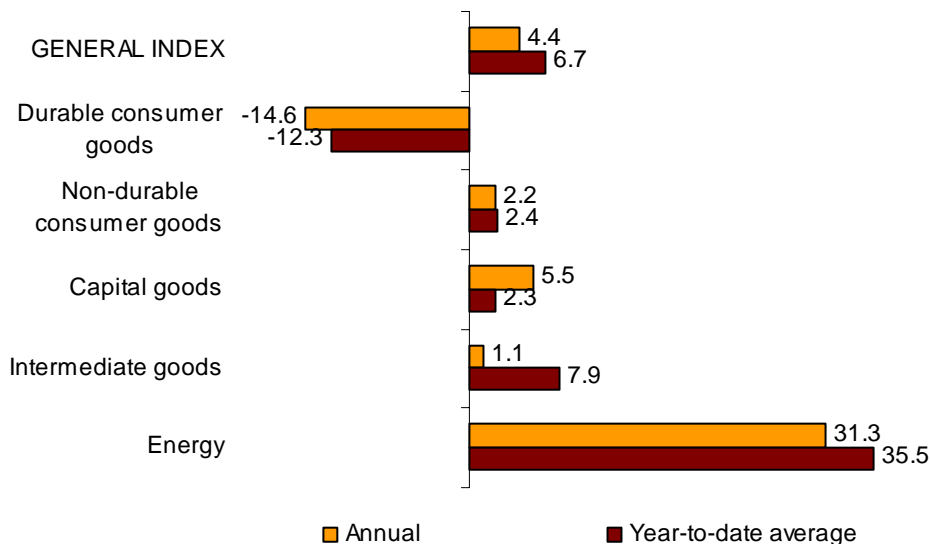

Year-to-date average rates

The average for the Industrial Production Index registered a variation rate of **6.7%** in the first nine months of the year, as compared with the same period the previous year.

By economic destination of the goods, this rate was positive in Energy (35.5%), Intermediate goods (7.9%), Non-durable consumer goods (2.4%) and Capital goods (2.3%). In contrast, it was negative in Durable consumer goods (-12.3%).

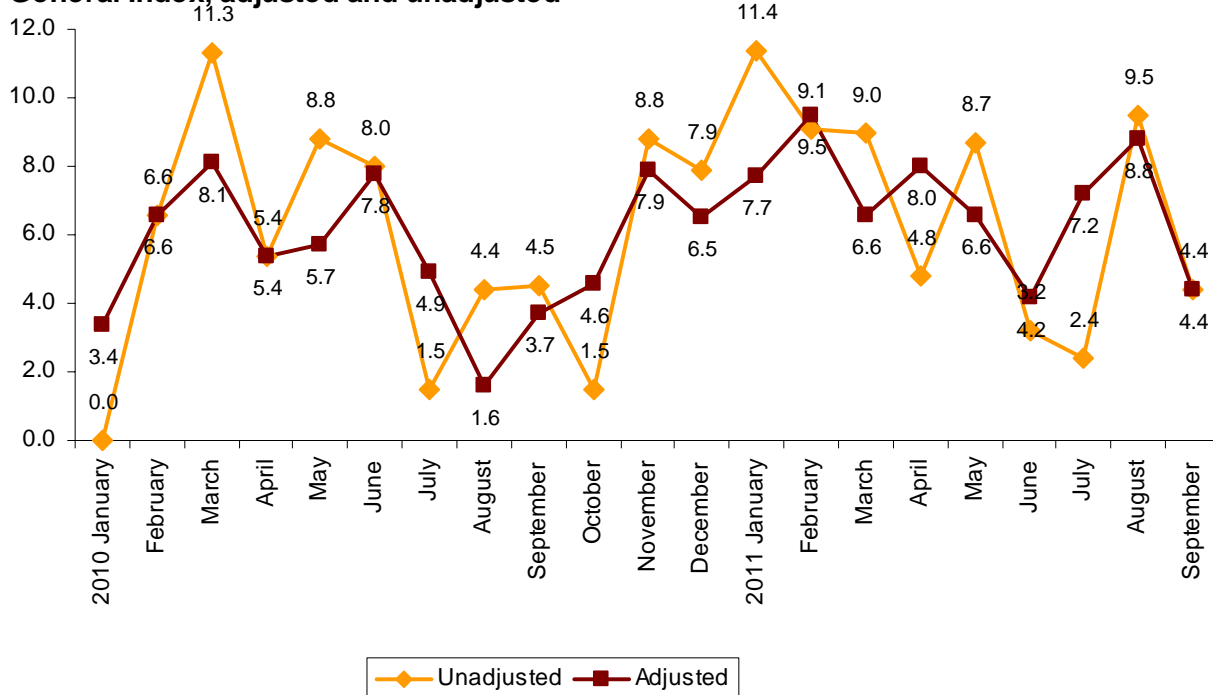
**Annual and average rates of the ITI

After eliminating the calendar effect, that is, the difference between the number of working days in a given month in different years, the interannual variation of the ITI in the month of September was 4.4%, nearly four-and-a-half points lower than that registered in August.

Evolution of Industrial New Orders Received

The Industrial New Orders Received Index (INORI) experienced an interannual variation of **5.6%** in September, almost four points below that registered in August.

By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors that presented the greatest positive effects on the general index were:

- **Energy**, with an annual variation of **30.9%** and an effect of **2.543** on the general index, mainly due to the increase in new orders received in the *Manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products*.
- **Capital goods**, with an annual rate of **8.3%** and an effect of **1.781**, mainly caused by the increase registered in *Naval, railway, aircraft and spacecraft construction. Combat vehicles*.

In turn, the only industrial sector with a negative effect on the general index was:

- **Durable consumer goods**, with an annual variation of **-17.6%** and an effect of **-0.507**, caused by the negative evolution of all activities comprising this sector.

Details of the interannual variations

A more detailed analysis showed the activities that most affected the annual rate of the INORI in the month of September.

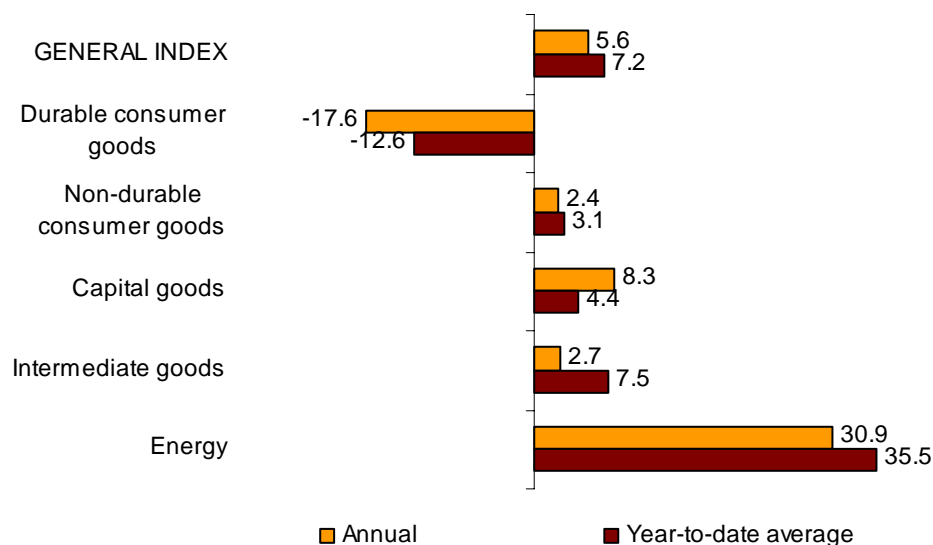

Year-to-date average rates

The average rate of the General Industrial New Orders Received Index during the first nine months of the year presented a variation of **7.2%**, as compared with the same period the previous year. By economic destination of the goods, this rate was positive in all industrial sectors, except in Durable consumer goods.

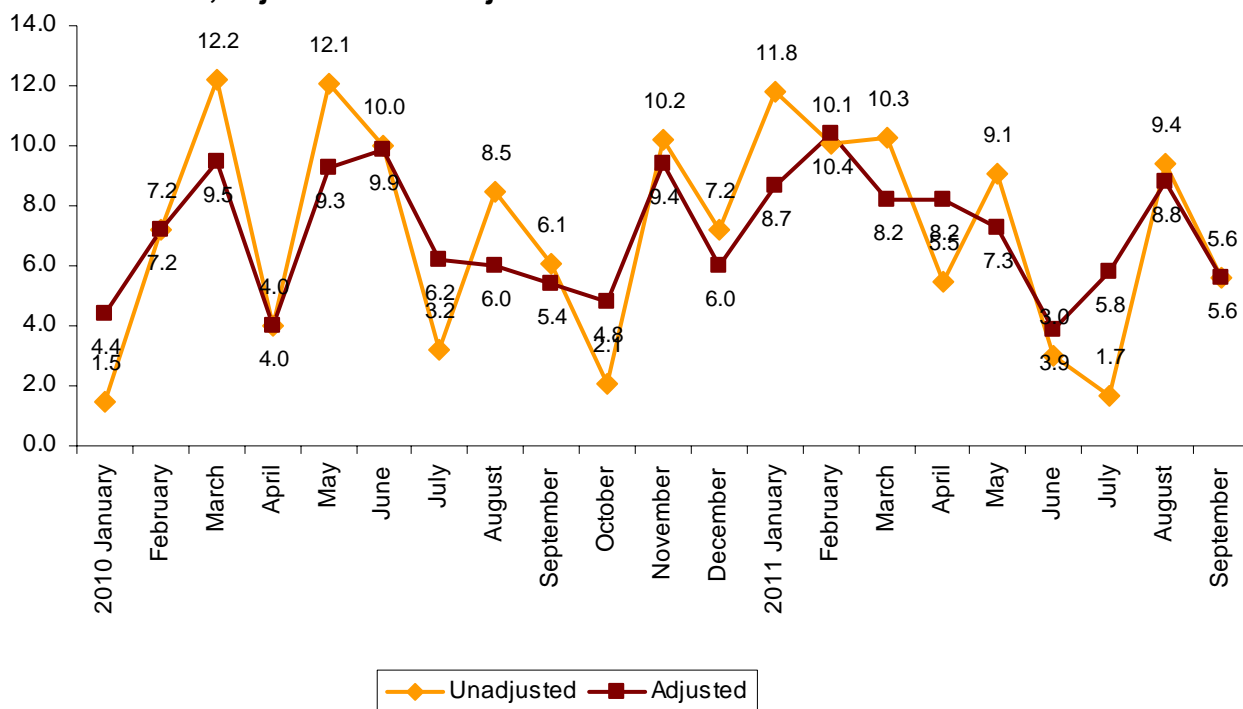
Annual and average rates of the INORI
