# The annual variation rate of the IPRIX stands at 3%, more than one point lower than that registered in May

# The annual variation rate of the IPRIM is 4.6%, one point and two tenths below that registered the previous month

#### Annual evolution of export prices

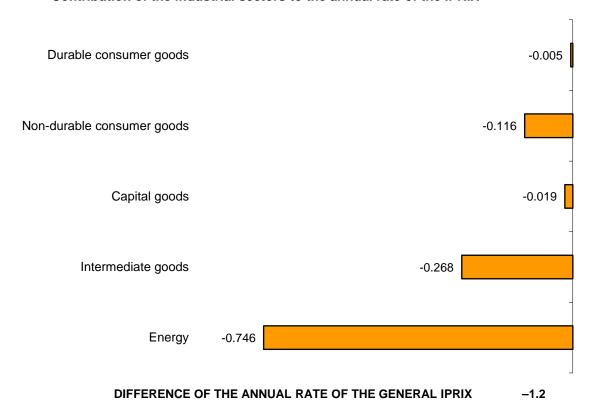
The annual rate of the Export Price Index (IPRIX) was **3.3%** in the month of June, more than one point below that registered in May.

By economic destination of the goods, all the industrial sectors had a negative effect in this decrease. Among them worth noting were:

- *Energy*, whose annual variation decreased almost 20 points to **13.1%**. This behaviour was due to the decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of refined petroleum products*, as compared to the increase of the previous year, and to the prices of *Electric power generation, transmission and distribution* increased this month less than they did in June 2016.
- Intermediate goods, whose annual variation stood at 4.6%, almost one percent below that registered in May. Worth noting in this behaviour was the decrease in the prices of Manufacture of basic iron and steel and of ferro-alloys, Manufacture of basic precious and other non-ferrous metals and Manufacture of basic chemicals, fertilisers and nitrogen compounds, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms, as compared with the increases registered the previous year.
- Non durable consumption goods, with a rate of 2.1%, six tenths lower as compared to the previous month, mainly as a consequence of the stability in the prices of *Processing* and preserving of meat and production of meat products as compared to the increase registered in 2016.

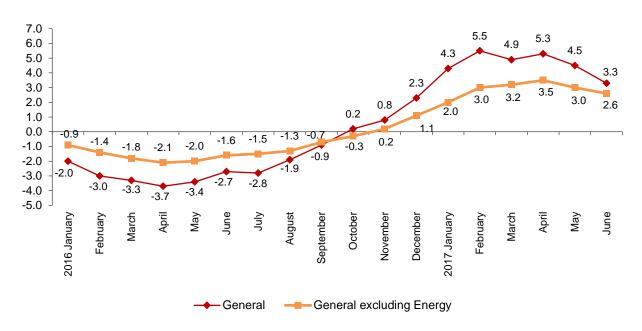
Another reason for this variation, though to a lesser extent, was the decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of pharmaceutical specialities* and *Manufacture of vegetable and animal oils and fats*, which increased in May last year.

#### Contribution of the industrial sectors to the annual rate of the IPRIX



The annual variation rate of the **general index excluding** *Energy* decreased four tenths, to **2.6%** standing seven tenths below that of the general IPRIX.

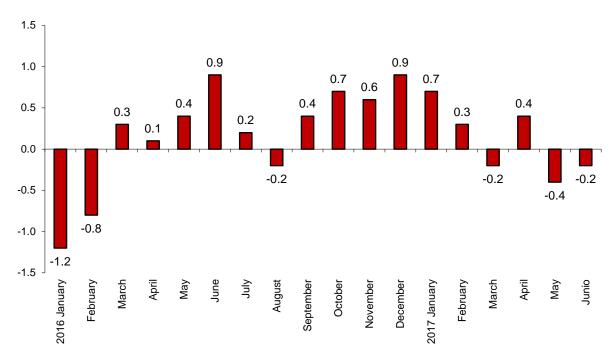
#### Annual evolution of the IPRIX General index and general excluding Energy



#### Monthly evolution of export prices

In June, industrial export prices registered a monthly rate of -0.2%, as compared to the month of May.

By economic destination of the goods, all the industrial sectors presented a negative monthly effect on the general index. Among them worth noting were:

- *Intermediate goods*, with a variation of -0.2% and a contribution of -0.092. Of particular note in this behaviour was the decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of basic chemical products*, *nitrogenous compounds*, *fertilisers*, *plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms*.
- *Energy*, whose variation rate stood at **-1.6%**, due to the decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of refined petroleum products*.

It is noteworthy, although in the opposite direction, the increase in the prices of *Electric power generation, transmission and distribution.* 

The contribution of this group to the overall IPRIX was -0.066.

• Capital goods, whose -0.1% variation rate contributed by -0.040, mainly due to the decrease in the prices of Manufacturing of motor vehicles.

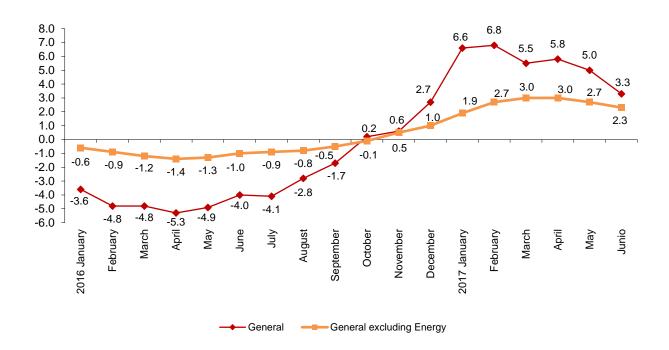

## Annual evolution of industrial prices, aggregating the domestic and foreign markets

In June, the Industrial Price Index of the domestic and foreign markets, as the aggregation of the IPRIM and the IPRIX, presented an annual rate of **3.3%**, almost two points lower than that registered in May.

On the other hand, the annual variation rate of the **general index excluding** *Energy* decreased four tenths to **2.3%**, standing one point below the general IPRIM+IPRIX.

#### Annual evolution of the IPRIX General index and general excluding Energy



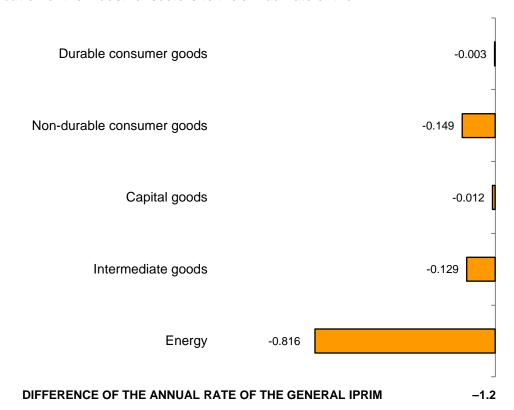
#### Annual evolution of import prices

The Import Price Index (IPRIM) registered an annual rate of **4.6%** in June, more than one point lower than that of May.

By economic destination of the goods, all the industrial sectors had a negative effect in this decrease. Among them worth noting were:

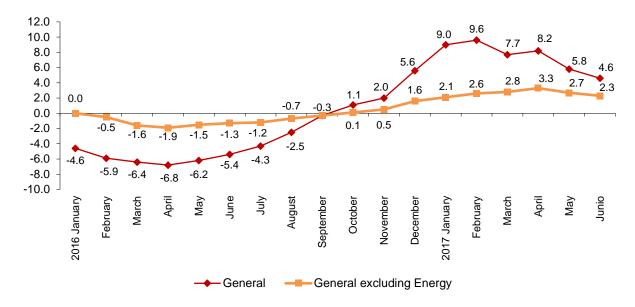
- *Energy*, whose annual rate stood at **12.5**%, four and a half points lower than that of the previous month, mainly due to the decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products*, which increased in 2016.
- **Non-durable consumption goods**, whose variation decreased seven tenths, to **1.5%**, due to the decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of wearing apparel* and *Manufacture of food products*, as compared with the increase registered in June last year.
- *Intermediate goods*, whose annual variation stood at **5.2%**, five tenths below that registered in May. This behaviour was due to the decrease in the prices of *Metallurgy; manufacture of iron, steel and ferro-alloy products*, as compared to the increase registered in June last year.

#### Contribution of the industrial sectors to the annual rate of the IPRIM



The annual variation rate of the **general index excluding** *Energy* decreased four tenths, to **2.3%** standing at more than two points below that of the general IPRIM.

#### Annual evolution of the IPRIM General index and general excluding Energy



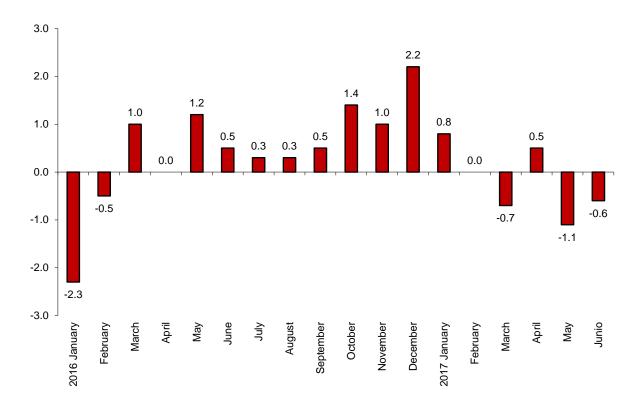
A more detailed analysis showed that, among the activities that most affected the decrease in the annual rate of the IPRIM, worth noting were:

- Manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products, whose rate decreases 16.5 points to 4.6%, due to the decrease in the prices in this industry in this month, while they increased in the same month last year.
- Metallurgy; manufacture of iron, steel and ferro-alloy products, whose annual variation decreased almost two points, standing at 15.4%, due to the decrease in their prices this month, as compared to the increase registered in June 2016.
- Manufacture of wearing apparel, with a variation rate of -0.4%, almost one and a half percentage point lower than that of the previous month, due to the decrease in their prices this month, which increased in June 2016.
- Manufacture of food products, whose variation decreased almost one percentage point to 4.1%, due to the decrease in their prices this month.

#### Monthly evolution of import prices

In June, the monthly variation of the Import Price Index was **-0.6%**.

#### Monthly evolution of the IPRIMGeneral index



By economic destination of the goods, all the industrial sectors presented a negative monthly effect on the general index. Among them worth noting were:

- *Energy*, with a monthly variation of -1.9% and a contribution of -0.385, due to the decrease in the prices of Coke and refined petroleum products and the *Extraction of crude petroleum and natural gas*.
- **Non durable consumption goods**, that registered a variation rate of **-0.5%**, due to the decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of food products* and *Manufacture of wearing apparel*. Its contribution to the general IPRIM was **-0.109**.
- Intermediate goods, with a variation rate of -0.3%, which contributed -0.077.
