Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey Year 2012. Provisional data

Main results

- In 2012, it was registered 101.9 million of overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation), 1.2% less than in 2011. Overnight stays by residents dropped 4.8%, whereas those by non-residents rose 1.0%.

-Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decreased 1.1%. Travellers resident abroad registered 76.7% of the total number of overnight stays, being Canarias their main destination.

-In campsites, overnight stays decreased 1.1%. Cataluña was the main destination in this accommodation modality and Holland was the main country of origin.

–Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation decreased 2.5%. Travellers resident in Spain registered 77.0% of the total number of overnight stays. Illes Balears was the main destination of non-residents.

-The Holliday Dwellings and Campsites Price Indeces showed a positive annual growth, whereas that of Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index registered an average drop of 0.7%.

The INE publishes for the first time, independently, an annual summary of the performance of the non-hotel accommodation occupancy surveys (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation). The information used is based on the annual data of 2012, as well as the performance registered for the five last years.

Performance of the overnight stays in non-hotel accommodation


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Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourist accommodation) reached the figure of 101.9 millions in 2012, with a decrease of 1.2% as compared with the previous year.


This variation rate was 6.7 points lower than that registered in 2011, when overnight stays increased 5.5%.


In 2012, overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 4.8%, and those by non-resident travellers increased 1.0%. Resident travellers, representing 53.1% of the total, registered 36.4% of the total figure of overnight stays.

62% of the overnight stays was registered in holiday dwellings, 31% in campsites and 7% in rural tourism accommodation.





Annual overnight stays in non-hotel accomodation by origin (in millions). Annual serie





■ Residents in Spain ■ Residents abroad ■ Total







Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decreased 1.1% in 2012. Overnight stays of residents decreased 6.1% and those of non-residents increased 0.6%.

Of the total overnight stays during the year, 64.6% were accounted for in the months between May and October.

Non-resident travellers registered 76.7% of the overnight stays.




Overnight annual growth rate in holiday dwellings. Annual serie

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
Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with 29.8 million overnight stays, 3.2% less than in 2011.

Illes Balears was the second destination of choice, with more than 9.5 million overnight stays, 1.7% less.

The Autonomous Communities that registered the greatest variation rates of overnight stays during the year were La Rioja (18.8%), Extremadura (18.1%) and Galicia (12.8%). Conversely, the Autonomous Communities with the greatest negative rates were Principado de Asturias (-21.3%), Cantabria (-13.7%) and Comunidad Foral de Navarra (-13.2%).




Overnight stays in holiday dwellings by autonomous community of destination in 2012. Annual growth rate

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
The British market consolidated its position as the main country of origin in holiday dwellings, with 16.6 million of overnight stays, 4.8% less than in 2011.

The following country of origin was Germany, with 8.1 million overnight stays and an annual rate of -1.0%.

In 2012, Norway, Danemark, United States and Sweden registered the most significant growths. The countries of origin that showed the lowest rates were Austria, United Kingdom and Portugal.




Annual variation rate of overnight stays in holiday dwelling of the 11 main origin countries in 2012, as compared with 2011




Holiday dwellings offered an average of 442.201 available bedplaces, 0.6% more than in 2011.

The occupancy rate by bedplaces decreased 1.8% and the weekend occupancy rate decreased 2.1%.



Occupancy rate by bedplaces in holiday dwellings. Annual serie


Occupancy annual growth rate by bedplaces in holiday dwellings. Annual serie



Tourist Campsites

Overnight stays in campsites decreased 1.1% in 2012. Resident travellers registered an annual rate of -3.1% and non-resident travellers registered an annual rate of 1.3%.


Of the total overnight stays during the year, 80.7% were accounted for in the months between May and October.




Overnight annual growth rate in campsites. Annual serie


Cataluña was the preferred destination in tourist campsites, with 14.3 million overnight stays, 0.8% more than in 2011. Comunitat Valenciana was the Autonomous Communities that registered the greatest growth during the year, 1.3% more than in 2011. By contrast, Castilla-La Mancha showed the lowest variation rate, 19.0% less.




Overnight stays in campsites by autonomous community of destination in 2012. Annual growth rate



The Dutch market, with was the main country of origin with 25.7% of the total number of overnight stays, registered a growth of 4.2% as compared with 2011. It was followed by France and the United Kingdom with 20.1% and 18.8% of the total number of overnight stays, respectively.




Distribution of the total overnight stays of non-residents in campsites of the main 10 countries by origin in 2012 (%)



Annual variation rate of overnight stays of the 10 main countries in 2012, as compared with 2011


The annual average occupancy rate of available pitches decreased 3.0%, whereas the weekend occupancy rate did so by 3.2%

La Rioja reached in average the greatest rate of occupancy in campsites (62.8%), followed by Comunidad de Madrid (48.6%) and Comunitat Valenciana (46.3%).



Average occupancy rate by pitches in campsites. Annual serie

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


Average occupancy rate by pitches in campsites by autonomous community in 2012

Rural Tourism Accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation registered a decreased of 2.5% in 2012, reaching 7.5 million of overnight stays.

Resident overnight stays decreased 6.2% while non-resident overnight stays increased 12.4%.




Overnight annual growth rate in rural tourism accommodation. Annual serie


Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 1.3 million overnight stays, 5.0% less than in 2011.

Worth noting the growth of overnight stays in Illes Balears, with an increase of 18.7%, mostly due to the increase of those registered by non-residents.




Distribution of total overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation by autonomous community of destination in 2012 in %


Total overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation by autonomous community of destination in 2012. Annual growth rate



Distribution of overnight stays of non-residents in rural tourism accommodation by autonomous community of destination in 2012 in %




The average occupancy rate was 14.3% in 2012, with an annual decrease of 5.6%. The average weekend occupancy rate decreased 6.1% in 2012 and stood at 23.6%. Illes Balears reached in average the greatest occupancy rate (51.2%). It was followed by Canarias (23.1%) and País Vasco (19.9%).



Occupancy rate by bedplaces in rural tourism accommodation. Annual serie


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Occupancy rate by bedplaces on weekends in rural tourism by autonomous community in 2012


In 2012, the Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered an increase of 1.5%.



Holiday dwelling price index. Annual growth rate


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In turn, the Tourist Campsite Price Index registered an average growth of 0.5%.



Tourist campsite price index. Annual growth rate


The Rural Tourist Accommodation Price Index registered an average drop of 0.7% in 2012.

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The Autonomous Community where the Rural Tourist Accommodation Price Index showed the greatest growth was Aragón, with an average annual rate of 3.7%, whereas the Autonomous Community with the greatest drop was País Vasco, with -4.8%.

Performance of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation in 2012.¹

The overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) exceeded 383.2 million of overnight stays in 2012, with a drop of 1.7% as compared with the previous year.

Overnight stays by residents dropped 7.5%, whereas those by non-residents rose 1.9%.

The average stay increased 0.7%, and stood at 3.8 overnight stays per traveller.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 26.7% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (23.5%) and France (7.4%).

Canarias was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 87.7 million overnight stays, (2.3% less than in 2011). Cataluña followed it, with more than 69.5 million overnight stays (0.4% more) and Illes Balears, with more than 64.8 million overnight stays (0.9% more).

¹The annual data on travellers and overnight stays in hotels showed together with the rest of the accommodations in this section, have been subject of a previous dissemination by the INE (press release of January 29)

²The results showed by the table are the addition of the monthly figures. The potential gaps between subtotals and the total are due to the fact that the data are shown without decimals, but they are calculated taking them into account. So, the differences may be explained by the rounding.

Methodological note

The main objective of the Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey (holiday dwellings, campsites, and rural tourism accommodation) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that allow us to describe the basic characteristics of this sector. These variables are the following: with regards to demand, there is information on travellers, overnight stays and average stay distributed by country of residence of the travellers and category of the establishment they are staying in or by Autonomous Community of origin in the case of Spanish travellers. As regards the supply, information includes the estimated number of establishments open for the season, estimated number of vacancies, level of occupancy and information on employment in the sector, in terms of the category of the establishment. This information is offered monthly, on a national, autonomous community, provincial and tourist area level. And afterwards, one the year is over, the data of the 12 months are disseminated.

The two main variables in these surveys are *travellers checked-in*, which are all persons who stay one or more consecutive nights in the same accommodation, and *overnight stays*, that are understood to be every night that a traveller stays in the establishment.

The target population of study is constituted by all the non-hotel tourist accommodation established in the Spanish territory.

A tourist apartment establishment is understood to be any productive unit whose exclusive or productive activity is to accommodate tourists, distributed in furnished units (apartments, chalets, villas, bungalows,...). A tourist apartment (unit) is considered to be a property that is habitually rented for occasional guests.

Tourist campsites are understood to be those land spaces which are duly delimited, equipped and conditioned, destined to habitually provide people, after the payment of a stipulated price, a place to live outdoors for a limited period of time for holiday or tourism purposes, and using as a residence mobile homes, caravans, tents or other similar easily transportable elements.

Rural Tourism Accommodation Establishments are those establishments or dwellings destined for tourist lodging in exchange for a price with or without any other complementary services that are registered in the corresponding Register of each Autonomous Community. These establishments usually present a determined set of characteristics:

They are located in a rural environment.

They are constructions with a common architectonic style that is characteristic of the area or which are located in land properties that maintain active livestock and farming operations (agrotourism).

They offer a limited number of vacancies and rooms for the accommodation of guests and comply with certain infrastructure and basic services requirements.

The *Holiday Dwelling Price Index*, HDPI, is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the series of main price rates used by holiday dwelling establishment.

The *Tourist Campsites Price Index*, TCPI, is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the series of main price rates used by campsites.

The *Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index*, RTAPI, is a statistical measurement of the monthly evolution of prices applied by those running this type of establishment to their clients.
