**Encuestas de ocupación en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros**  
Enero 2016. *Datos provisionales*

**Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros  
aumentan un 8,4% en enero respecto al mismo mes de 2015**

Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros (apartamentos, campings, alojamientos de turismo rural y albergues) superan los 5,4 millones en enero, un 8,4% más que en el mismo mes de 2015. Las pernoctaciones de residentes aumentan un 14,1% y las de no residentes un 7,0%.

La estancia media es de 6,6 pernoctaciones por viajero.

Los viajeros y pernoctaciones en los alojamientos turísticos colectivos extrahoteleros durante el mes de enero son:

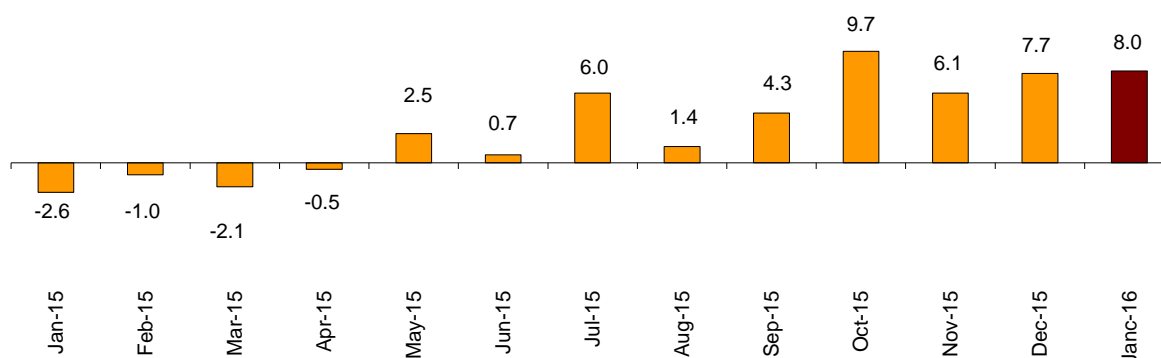
**Apartamentos turísticos**

Las pernoctaciones en apartamentos turísticos aumentan un 8,0% en enero. Las de residentes suben un 16,0% y las de no residentes un 6,7%.

La estancia media baja un 6,1% respecto a enero de 2015, situándose en 7,5 pernoctaciones por viajero.

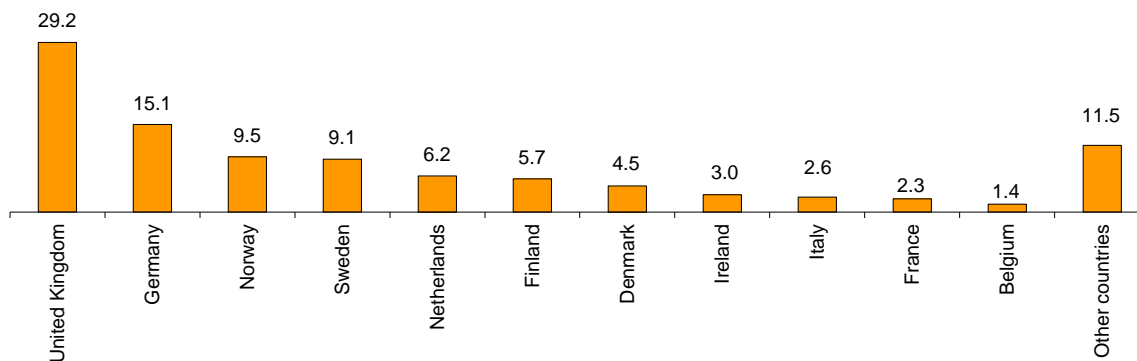
En enero se ocupan el 35,4% de las plazas ofertadas por los apartamentos turísticos, un 4,0% más que en el mismo mes de 2015. El grado de ocupación por plazas en fin de semana se sitúa en el 38,1%, con un incremento del 5,5%.

Las pernoctaciones de no residentes en apartamentos turísticos representan el 85,2% del total. Reino Unido es el principal mercado emisor, con 997.745 pernoctaciones, un 6,4% más que en enero de 2015. El siguiente mercado emisor es Alemania, con 514.953 pernoctaciones, un 3,2% menos.

Canarias es el destino preferido en apartamentos, con más de 2,8 millones de pernoctaciones, un 4,4% más que en enero de 2015. Esta comunidad también alcanza la mayor ocupación, con el 84,2% de los apartamentos ofertados.

Por zonas turísticas, la isla de Gran Canaria es el destino preferido, con más de un millón de pernoctaciones y una ocupación del 89,1% de los apartamentos ofertados.

Los puntos turísticos con mayor número de pernoctaciones en enero son San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona y Mogán.

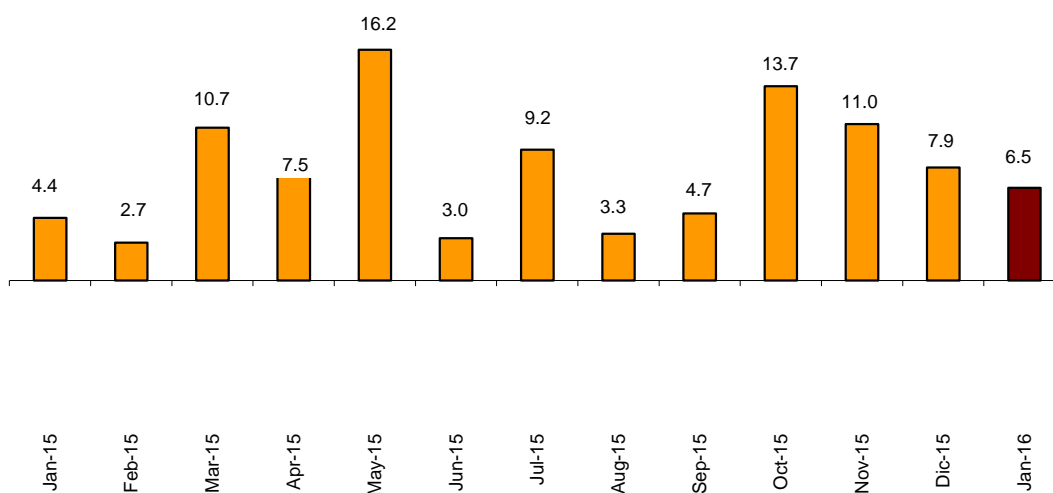
## Campings

Las pernoctaciones en campings registran en enero un incremento anual del 6,5% respecto al mismo mes del año anterior. Las de residentes aumentan un 2,2% y las de no residentes un 7,6%.

Durante el mes de enero se ocupan el 35,8% de las parcelas ofertadas, un 1,3% más. El grado de ocupación por parcelas en fin de semana alcanza el 37,6%, con un aumento anual del 2,3%.

El 80,6% de las pernoctaciones en campings las realizan viajeros no residentes. Reino Unido es el principal mercado emisor, con el 35,1% de las pernoctaciones de no residentes, un 8,2% más que en enero de 2015.

Comunitat Valenciana es el destino preferido en campings, con 527.467 pernoctaciones, un 7,0% más que en enero de 2015.

La Rioja es la comunidad con el mayor grado de ocupación, el 63,0% de las parcelas ofertadas.

Por zonas turísticas, la Costa Blanca es el destino preferido, con 318.731 pernoctaciones y una ocupación del 80,8% de las parcelas ofertadas.

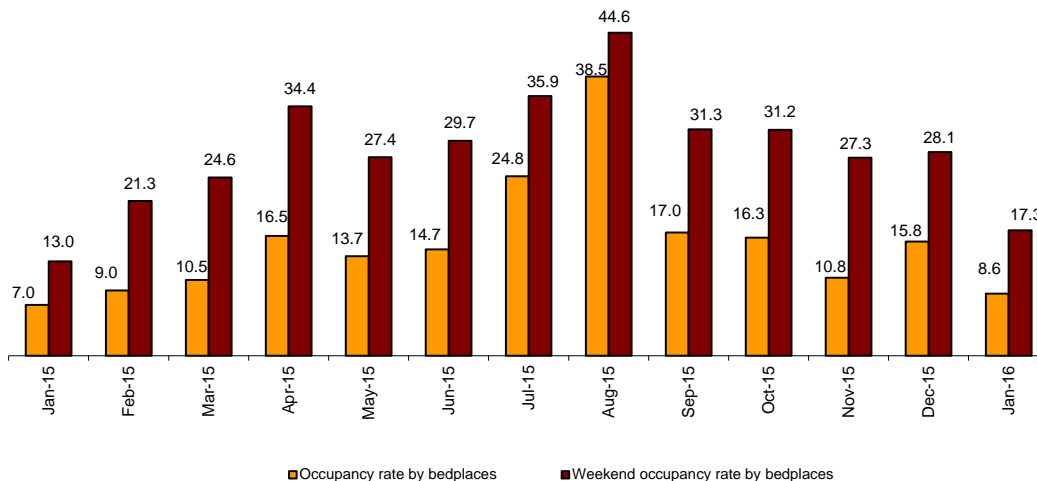
Los puntos turísticos con más pernoctaciones son Benidorm, Cartagena y Marbella.

## Alojamientos de turismo rural

Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos de turismo rural presentan un aumento anual del 24,5% en enero. Las de residentes suben un 22,8% y las de no residentes un 32,2%.

En los alojamientos de turismo rural se ocupan el 8,6% de las plazas, con un crecimiento del 21,9% respecto a enero de 2015. El grado de ocupación en fin de semana se sitúa en el 17,3%, con un incremento del 33,0%.

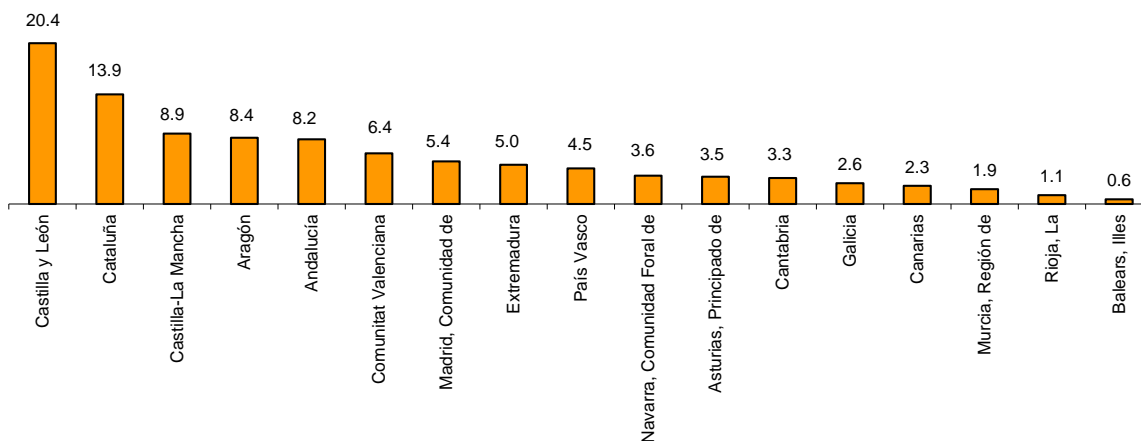
Occupancy rate by bedplaces and bedplaces on weekends



Por comunidades, Castilla y León es el destino preferido, con 58.371 pernотaciones, un 11,7% más que en enero de 2015. Canarias alcanza el mayor grado de ocupación, con el 33,9% de las plazas ofertadas.

Por zonas turísticas, Pirineus es el principal destino, con 19.495 pernотaciones. El Parque Nacional del Teide alcanza la mayor ocupación, del 39,4% de las plazas ofertadas.

## Albergues

Las pernотaciones en albergues registran en enero un descenso anual del 6,8%. Las de residentes suben un 0,2%, mientras que las de no residentes bajan un 19,8%.

Se ocupan el 13,0% de las plazas, un 2,5% más que en enero de 2015. El grado de ocupación en fin de semana alcanza el 19,3%, con un aumento del 29,1%.

Por comunidades, Cataluña es el destino preferido, con 28.904 pernотaciones, un 6,4% menos que en enero de 2015. Esta comunidad también alcanza la mayor ocupación, con el 23,7% de las plazas ofertadas.

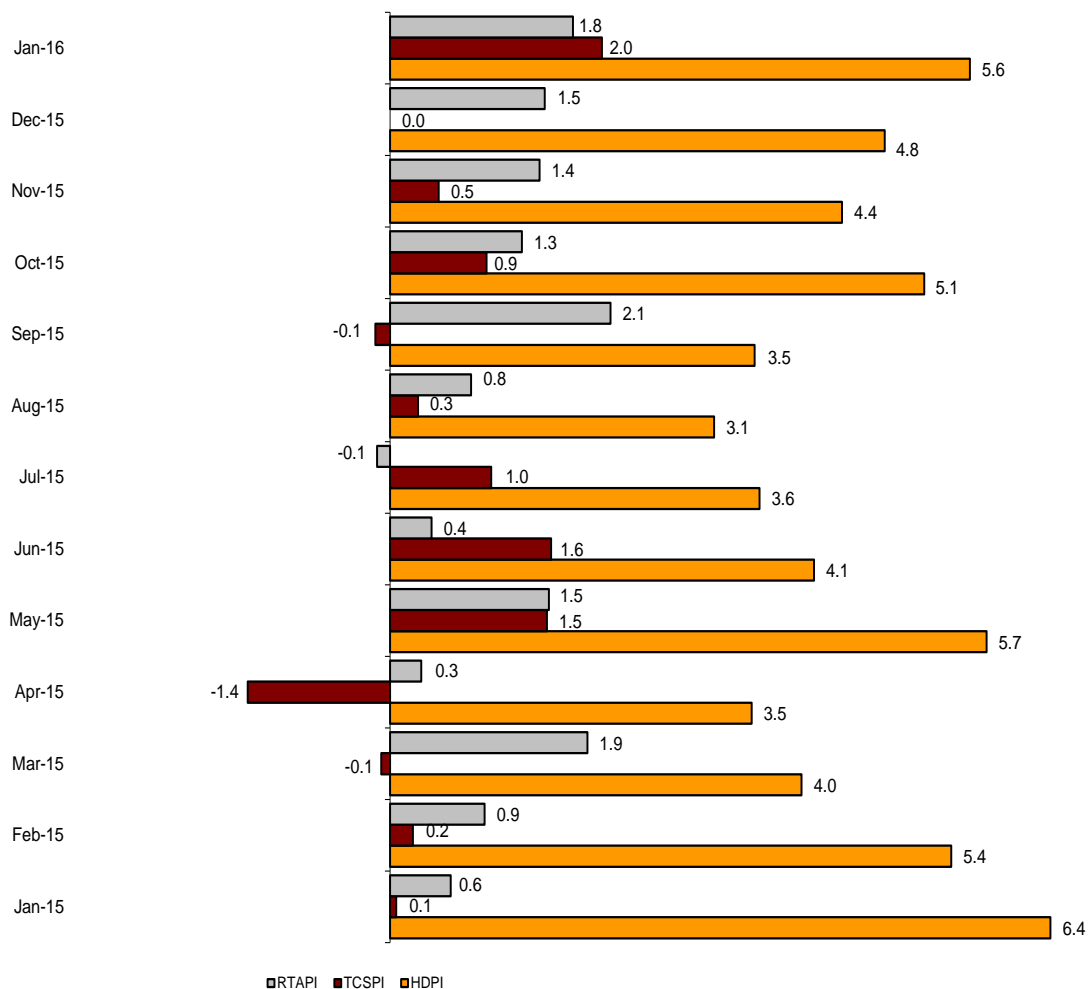
## Índices de precios

El Índice de Precios de Apartamentos Turísticos (IPAP) aumenta un 5,6% respecto a enero de 2015. La tarifa *tour-operadores y agencias de viajes*, que tiene el mayor peso en la estructura de ponderaciones este mes (61,0%), sube un 5,6%.

El Índice de Precios de Campings (IPAC) se incrementa un 2,0% en tasa anual. La tarifa *bungalow*, que tiene el mayor peso en la estructura de ponderaciones en enero (37,8%), sube un 2,9% respecto al mismo mes de 2015.

El Índice de Precios de Alojamientos de Turismo Rural (IPTR) registra un aumento del 1,8% en enero. La tarifa *fin de semana*, que supone el 64,7% del peso total, sube un 2,1% en tasa anual.

## Evolución de los viajeros y las pernoctaciones en todos los alojamientos turísticos colectivos españoles

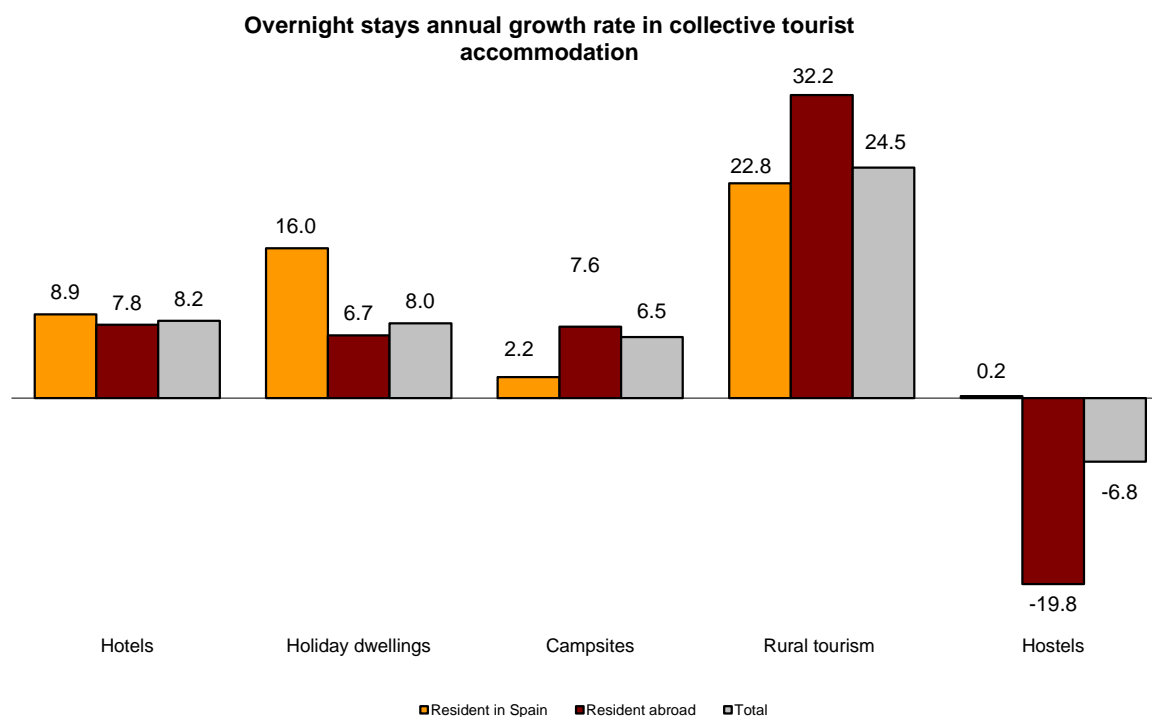
Las pernoctaciones en el conjunto de alojamientos turísticos colectivos españoles (hoteles<sup>1</sup>, apartamentos, campings, alojamientos de turismo rural y albergues) aumentan un 8,3% en enero en tasa anual. Las de residentes suben un 9,7% y las de no residentes un 7,5%.

La estancia media baja un 2,4%, situándose en 3,6 pernoctaciones por viajero.

Del total de pernoctaciones realizadas en alojamientos turísticos colectivos, un 73% corresponde a hoteles y un 27% a alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros.



Los principales mercados emisores en el conjunto de alojamientos turísticos reglados son el británico (con el 25,6% del total de pernoctaciones de no residentes), el alemán (19,9%) y el francés (5,4%).

Canarias es el destino preferido, con 8,3 millones de pernoctaciones (un 3,8% más que en enero de 2015). Le siguen Andalucía, con más de 2,6 millones (y un aumento anual del 12,9%) y Cataluña, con 2,2 millones (y un incremento del 10,3%).
