Encuestas de ocupación en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros
Enero 2017. *Datos provisionales*

Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros aumentan un 6,1% en enero respecto al mismo mes de 2016

Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros (apartamentos, campings, alojamientos de turismo rural y albergues) superan los 5,7 millones en enero, un 6,1% más que en el mismo mes de 2016. Las pernoctaciones de residentes aumentan un 1,9% y las de no residentes un 7,2%.

La estancia media es de 6,6 pernoctaciones por viajero.

Los viajeros y pernoctaciones en los alojamientos turísticos colectivos extrahoteleros durante el mes de enero son:

Apartamentos turísticos

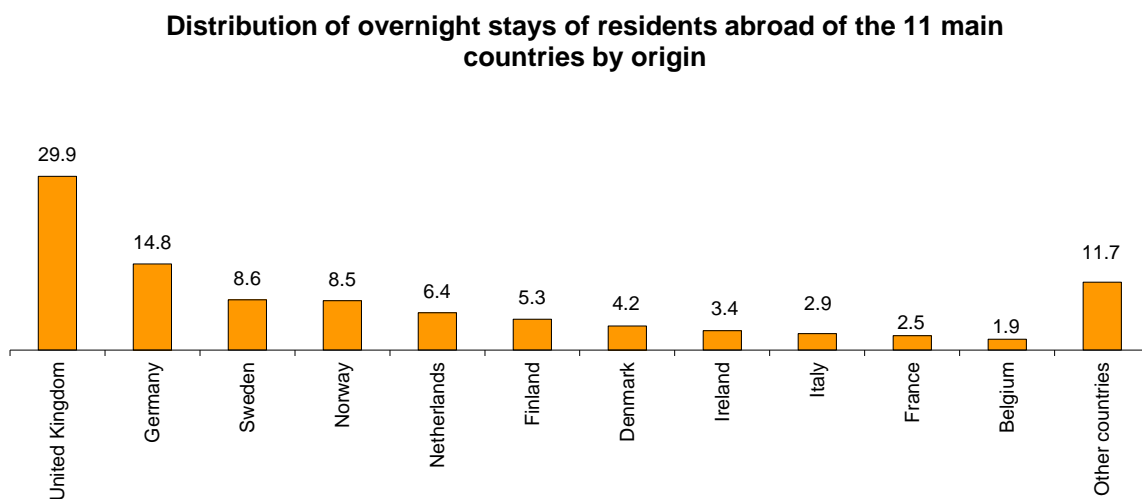
Las pernoctaciones en apartamentos turísticos aumentan un 7,5% en enero. Las pernoctaciones de residentes suben un 9,4% y las de no residentes un 7,2%.

La estancia media baja un 0,9% respecto a enero de 2016, situándose en 7,3 pernoctaciones por viajero.

En enero se ocupan el 34,4% de las plazas ofertadas por los apartamentos turísticos, un 1,7% menos que en el mismo mes de 2016. El grado de ocupación por plazas en fin de semana se sitúa en el 35,7%, con un descenso del 5,2%.



Las pernoctaciones de no residentes en apartamentos turísticos representan el 84,8% del total. Reino Unido es el principal mercado emisor, con más de un millón de pernoctaciones, un 9,7% más que en enero de 2016. El siguiente mercado emisor es Alemania, con 539.044 pernoctaciones, un 4,8% más.



Canarias es el destino preferido en apartamentos, con más de 2,8 millones de pernoctaciones, y un aumento del 3,2% respecto a enero de 2016. Esta comunidad también alcanza la mayor ocupación, con el 87,4% de los apartamentos ofertados.

Por zonas turísticas, la isla de Gran Canaria es el destino preferido, con 977.584 pernoctaciones y una ocupación, del 91,6% de los apartamentos ofertados.

Los puntos turísticos con mayor número de pernoctaciones en enero son San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona y Tías.

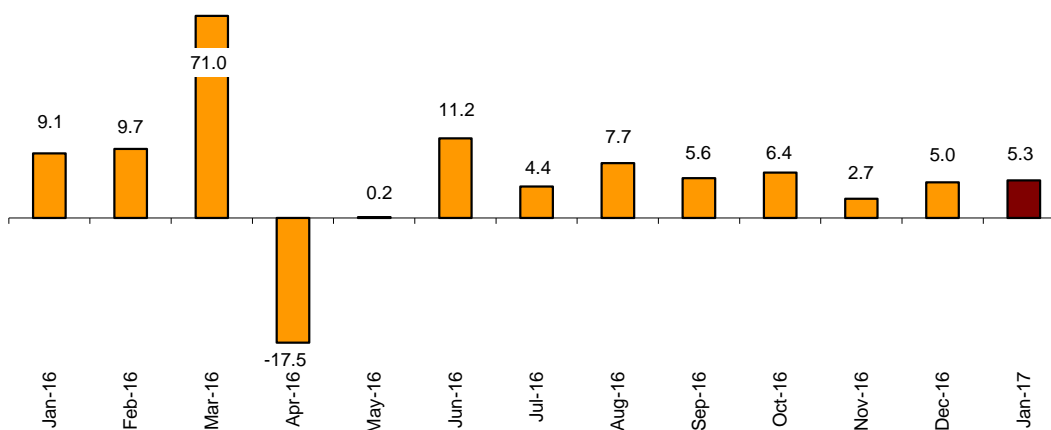
Campings

Las pernoctaciones en campings registran en enero un incremento anual del 5,3% respecto al mismo mes del año anterior. Las de residentes aumentan un 0,6% y las de no residentes un 6,6%.

Durante el mes de enero se ocupan el 37,7% de las parcelas ofertadas, un 3,0% más que en el mismo mes de 2016. El grado de ocupación por parcelas en fin de semana alcanza el 39,1%, con un aumento anual del 0,6%.

El 80,2% de las pernoctaciones en campings las realizan viajeros no residentes. Reino Unido es el principal mercado emisor, con el 35,8% de las pernoctaciones de no residentes, un 6,8% más que en enero de 2016.

Comunitat Valenciana es el destino preferido en campings, con 583.582 pernoctaciones, un 6,7% más que en tasa anual. La Rioja alcanza el mayor grado de ocupación, con el 63,9% de las parcelas ofertadas.

Por zonas turísticas, la Costa Blanca es el destino preferido, con 328.241 pernoctaciones y una ocupación del 83,3% de las parcelas ofertadas.

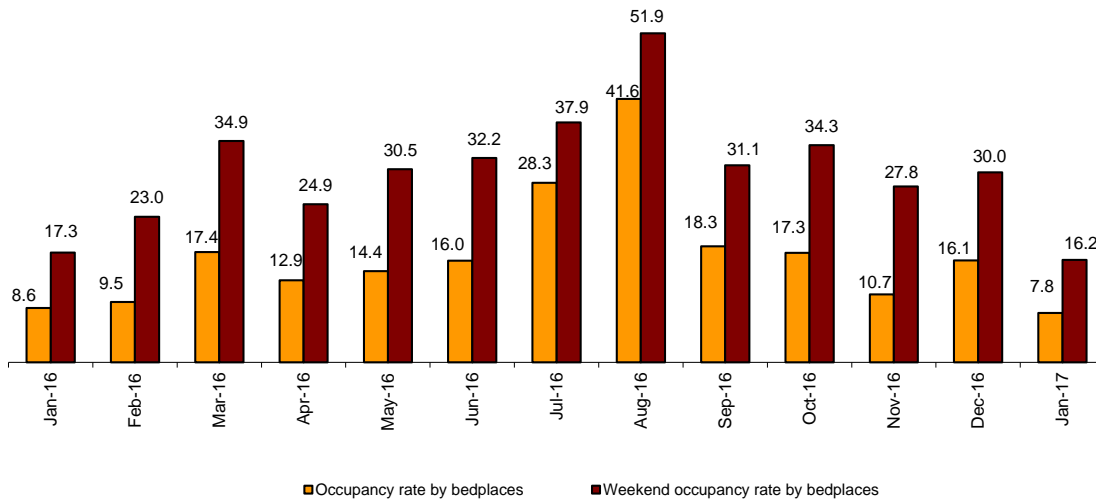
Los puntos turísticos con más pernoctaciones son Benidorm, Cartagena y Marbella.

Alojamientos de turismo rural

Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos de turismo rural presentan un descenso anual del 5,4% en enero. Las de residentes bajan un 9,7%, mientras que las de no residentes suben un 12,7%.

En los alojamientos de turismo rural se ocupan el 7,8% de las plazas, con un descenso del 8,9% respecto a enero de 2016. El grado de ocupación en fin de semana se sitúa en el 16,2%, con una bajada anual del 6,5%.

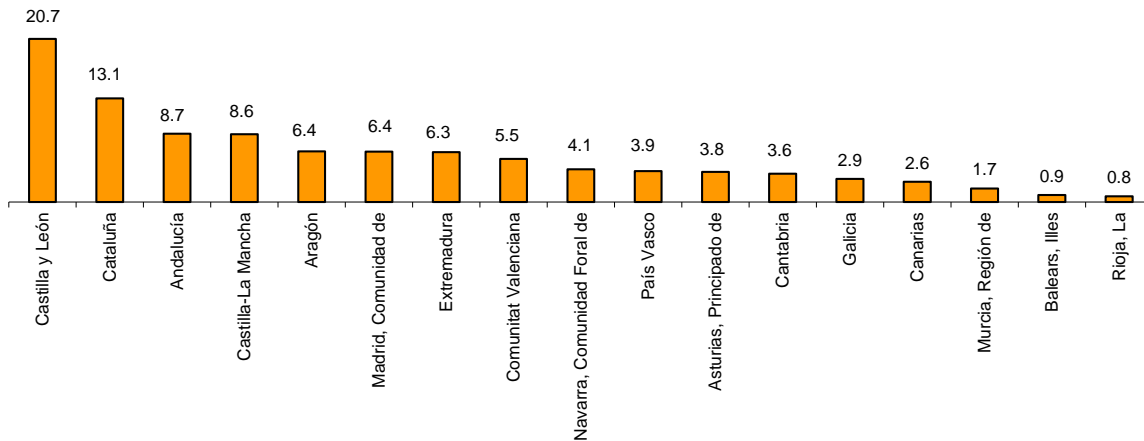
Occupancy rate by bedplaces and bedplaces on weekends in rural tourism accommodation



Por comunidades, Castilla y León es el destino preferido, con 53.720 pernотaciones, un 8,2% menos que en enero de 2016. Canarias alcanza el mayor grado de ocupación, con el 40,6% de las plazas ofertadas.

Por zonas turísticas, Pirineus es el destino preferido, con 19.542 pernотaciones. La isla de Lanzarote alcanza la mayor ocupación, del 48,5% de las plazas ofertadas.

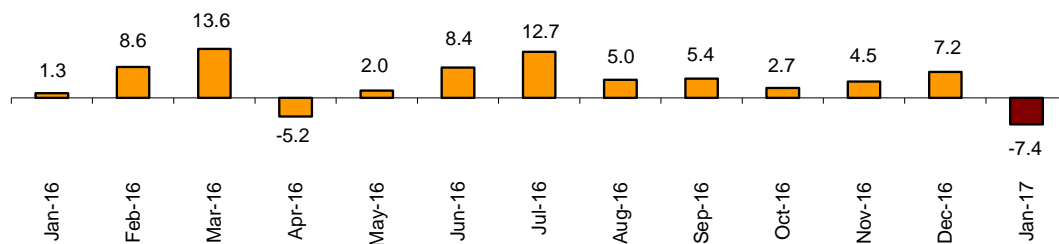
Distribution of overnight stays of traveller residents by autonomous community of destination in rural tourism accommodation in %



Albergues

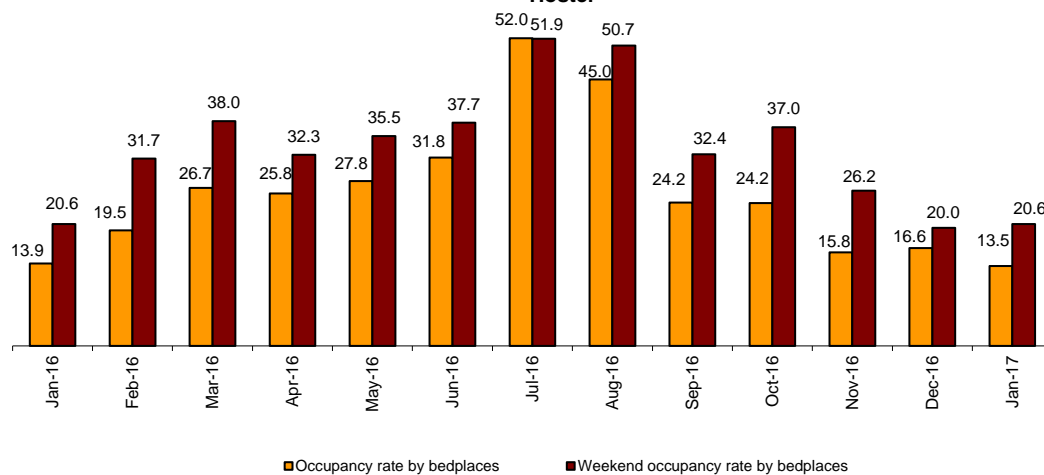
Las pernoctaciones en albergues registran en enero un descenso anual del 7,4%. Las de residentes bajan un 15,7%, mientras que las de no residentes suben 8,8%.

Se ocupan el 13,5% de las plazas, un 2,9% menos que en enero de 2016. El grado de ocupación en fin de semana alcanza el 20,6%, con un descenso del 0,1%.

Por comunidades, Cataluña es el destino preferido, con 32.924 pernoctaciones, un 0,2% menos que en enero de 2016. Esta comunidad también alcanza la mayor ocupación, con el 24,8% de las plazas ofertadas.

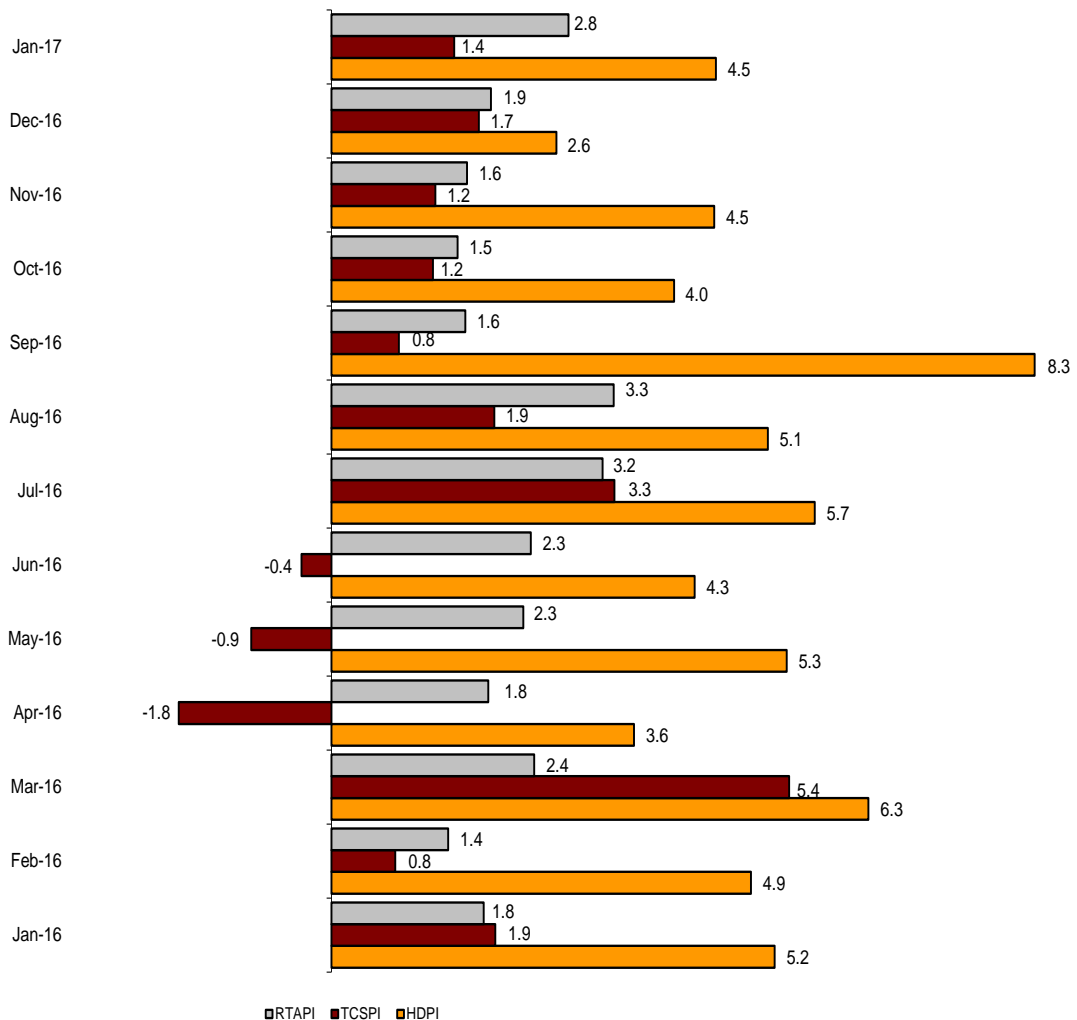
Índices de precios

El Índice de Precios de Apartamentos Turísticos (IPAP) aumenta un 4,5% respecto a enero de 2016. La tarifa *tour-operadores y agencias de viajes*, que tiene el mayor peso en la estructura de ponderaciones este mes (60,1%), sube un 4,7%.

El Índice de Precios de Campings (IPAC) se incrementa un 1,4% en tasa anual. La tarifa *normal*, que tiene el mayor peso en la estructura de ponderaciones en enero (35,8%), sube un 2,2% respecto al mismo mes de 2016.

El Índice de Precios de Alojamientos de Turismo Rural (IPTR) registra un aumento del 2,8% en enero. La tarifa *fin de semana*, que supone el 72,2% del peso total, sube un 2,8% en tasa anual.

Evolución de los viajeros y las pernoctaciones en todos los alojamientos turísticos colectivos españoles

Las pernoctaciones en el conjunto de alojamientos turísticos colectivos españoles (hoteles¹, apartamentos, campings, alojamientos de turismo rural y albergues) aumentan un 4,2% en enero en tasa anual. Las de residentes descienden un 4,7%, mientras que las de no residentes suben un 8,6%.

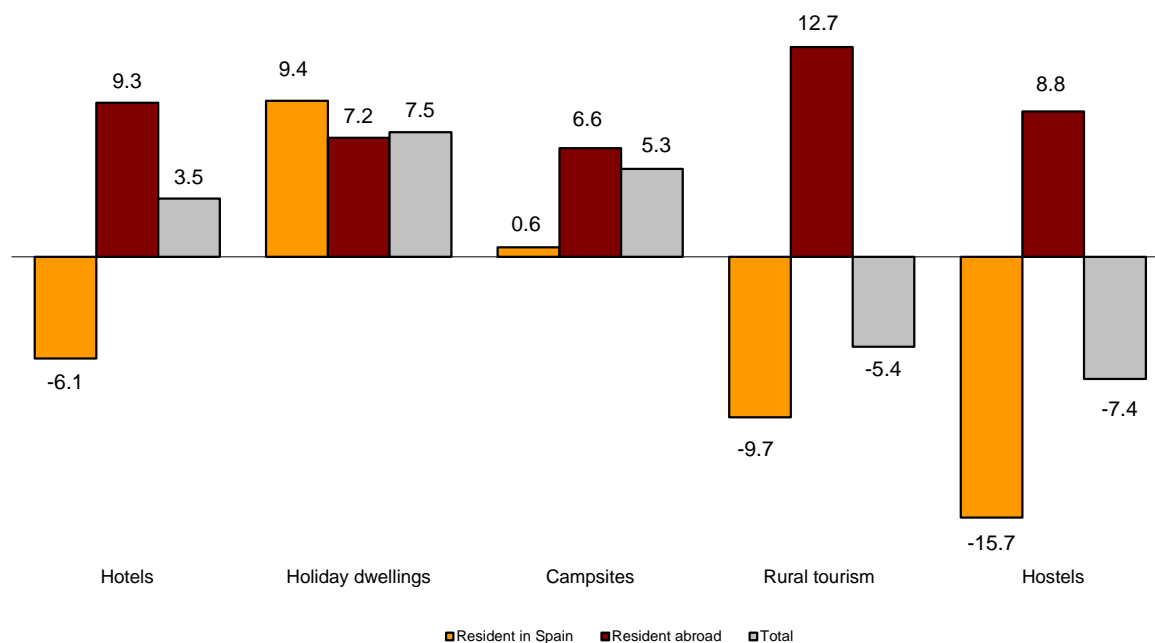
La estancia media baja un 1,3%, situándose en 3,6 pernoctaciones por viajero.

Del total de pernoctaciones realizadas en alojamientos turísticos colectivos, un 72% corresponde a hoteles y un 28% a alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros.

Los principales mercados emisores en el conjunto de alojamientos turísticos reglados son el británico (con el 25,8% del total de pernoctaciones de no residentes), el alemán (19,1%) y el francés (5,0%).

Canarias es el destino preferido, con más de 8,7 millones de pernoctaciones (un 5,0% más que en enero de 2016). Le siguen Andalucía, con más de 2,7 millones (y un aumento anual del 4,2%) y Cataluña, con 2,3 millones (y un incremento del 2,8%).
