Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
February 2014. *Provisional data*

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increases 5.2% in February, as compared with the same month of 2013

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) exceeded 4.9 millions in February, 5.2% more than in the same month of 2013. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 5.4% and those of non-residents increased 5.1%. The average stay stands at 6.9 overnights per traveller.


In January and February 2014, overnight stays increased 6.4% as compared with the same months of the previous year.

Holiday Dwellings


Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased 3.6% in February. Those of residents decreased 1.0%, whereas overnight stays of non-residents increased 4.4%. The average stay increased 2.3% standing at 7.9 overnight stays per traveller.



In February, 37.4% of the bedplaces available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 5.8% more than in the same month of 2013. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 39.2%, with an annual increase of 6.5%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 87.4% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 845,538 overnight stays, 1.4% more than in February 2013. The following country of origin was Germany, with 589,371 overnight stays, 1.4% more.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.6 million overnight stays, 0.3% more than in February 2013. This Autonomous Community registered the highest occupancy rate with 85.1% of the dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination, with 943,239 overnight stays. This island reached the highest occupancy rate with 88.0% of the dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in February were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Mogán.


Campsites

The overnight stays in tourist campsites registered an annual increase of 10.2% in February. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 15.7%, whereas those of non-resident travellers increased 8.7%.

During the month of February, 37.1% of the offered pitches were occupied, that is, a 3.4% increase. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 38.7%, with an annual increase of 5.3%.

78.0% of the overnight stays in tourist campsites were by non-residents. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 34.2% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 9.9% more than in February 2013.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination regarding campsites, with 476,832 overnight stays, 12.8% more than in February 2013. Comunitat Valenciana is also the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate on campsites, with 58.8% of the pitches offered.


By tourist area, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination for camping, with 265,856 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 80.9% of the pitches offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Marbella.

Rural Tourism Accommodation


Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 10.0% in February. Residents' overnight stays increased 11.7% while those of non-residents did so by 4.6%.

Regarding the rural tourism accommodation, 7.5% of the bedplaces were occupied, representing a 10.2% increase as compared to February 2013. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 17.4%, with an increase of 11.3%.



By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 50,995 overnight stays, 1.3% more than in February 2013. Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate as well, with 32.2% of the bedplaces offered.

By tourist area, Pirineus was the main destination, with 14,237 overnight stays. In turn, Parque Nacional del Teide reached the greatest occupancy rate, with 46.8% of the bedplaces offered.




Price Indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) increased 1.1%, as compared to February 2013. The tour operators and travel agencies rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (61.1%), increased 1.7%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) increased 1.6% in the annual rate. The normal rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for February (52.8%), increased by 1.6%.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) registered a 0.1% decrease in February. The weekend rate, which accounted for 70.8% of the total weight, decreased 0.2%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation


Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered a 5.4% increase in February, as compared with the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays of residents increased 3.3%, whereas those of non-residents increased 6.5%.

The average stay decreased 0.9% as compared to February 2013, standing at 3.5 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 74% were accounted for hotels, and 26% did so for non-hotel tourist accommodation.



The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 23.9% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (22.4%) and France (5.3%).

Canarias was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 7.7 million overnight stays (6.0% more than in February 2013), followed by Andalucía, with over 2.6 million overnight stays (7.4% more) and Cataluña, with over 2 million overnight stays (6.1% more).
