Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
February 2017. *Provisional data*

Overnight stays in Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation increase
3.3% in February as compared with the same month of 2016

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) exceeded 5.8 million in February, 3.3% more than in the same month of 2016. Overnight stays by residents increased by 6.8% and those of non-residents did so by 2.3%.

The average stay stood at 5.8 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first two months of 2017, overnight stays increased by 4.6% as compared with the same period of the previous year.

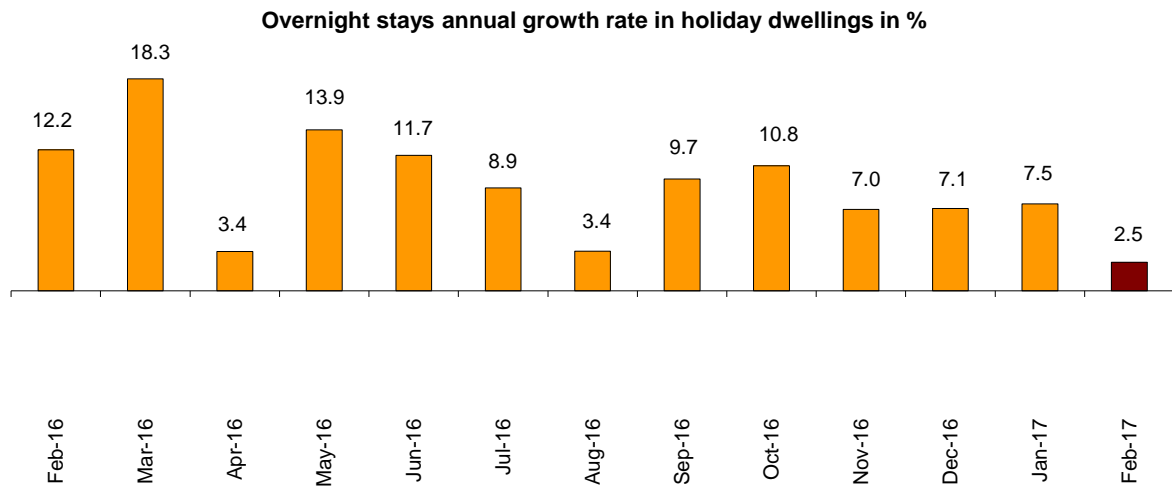

Holiday dwellings

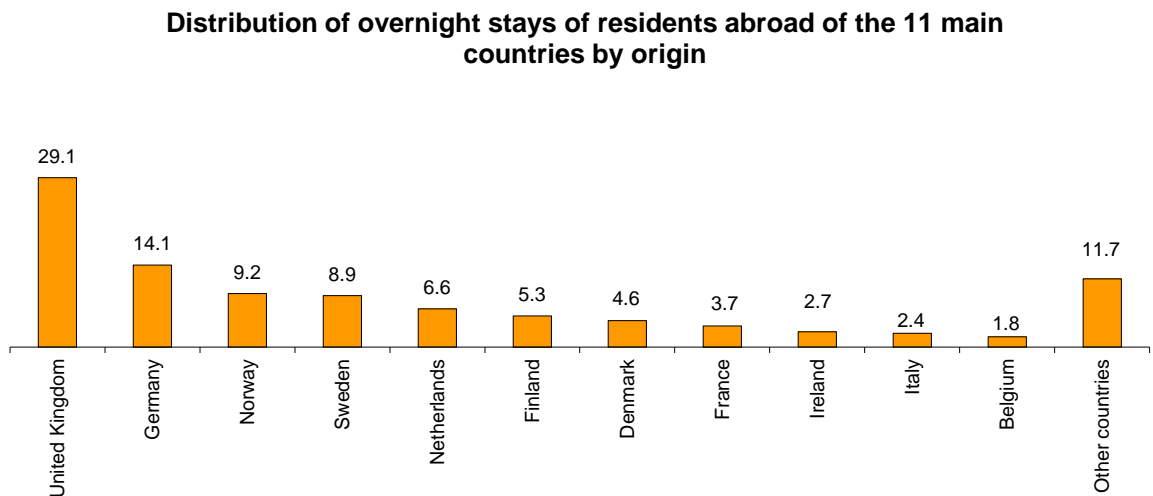
Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased by 2.5% in February. Overnight stays by residents increased 6.2%, and non-resident stays increased 1.9%.

The average stay decreased 4.5% as compared with February 2016, standing at 6.7 overnight stays per traveller.

In February, 37.3% of the bedplaces available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 2.2% less than in the same month of 2016. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 40.2%, with a decrease of 3.3%.



Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 84.8% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with more than one million overnight stays, 5.9% more than in February 2016. The following country of origin was Germany, with 504,437 overnight stays, 5.8% less.



Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.6 million overnight stays, with a decrease of 1.8% as compared to February 2016. This community presented the highest occupancy rate, with 88.1% of holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination, with 913,833 overnight stays and an occupancy of 91.9% of holiday dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays in February were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Mogán.

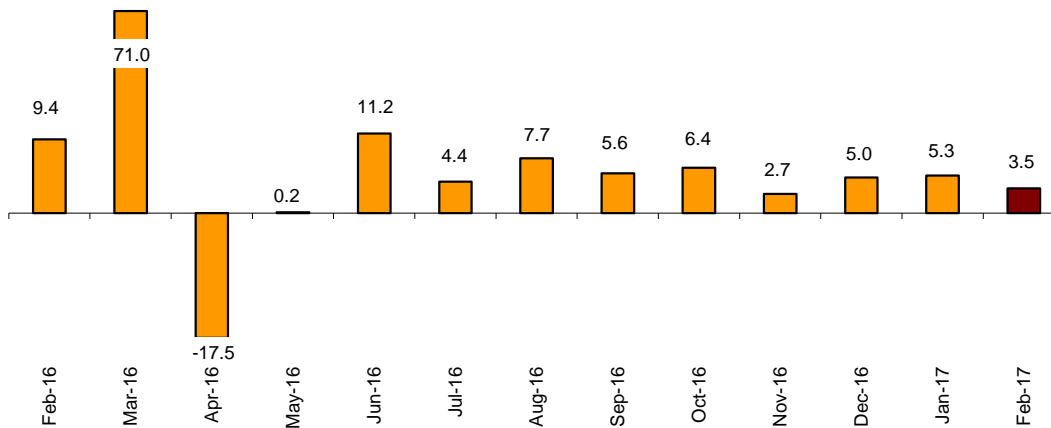
Tourist campsites

Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an annual increase of 3.5% in February as compared to the same month of the previous year. Resident overnight stays grew by 3.9% and non-residents by 3.4%.

During the month of February, 38.3% of the offered pitches were occupied, 1.7% more than the same month of 2016. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 39.4%, with an annual increase of 0.1%.

78.0% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents travellers. The United Kingdom is the main country of origin with 35.2% of overnight stays by non-residents, 2.1% more than February 2016.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred camping destination, with 554,974 overnight stays, 1.3% more in annual rate. This community also presented the highest occupancy rate, with 62.8% of the pitches offered.

By tourist areas, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination, with 307,070 overnight stays and an occupancy of 85.9% of the pitches offered.

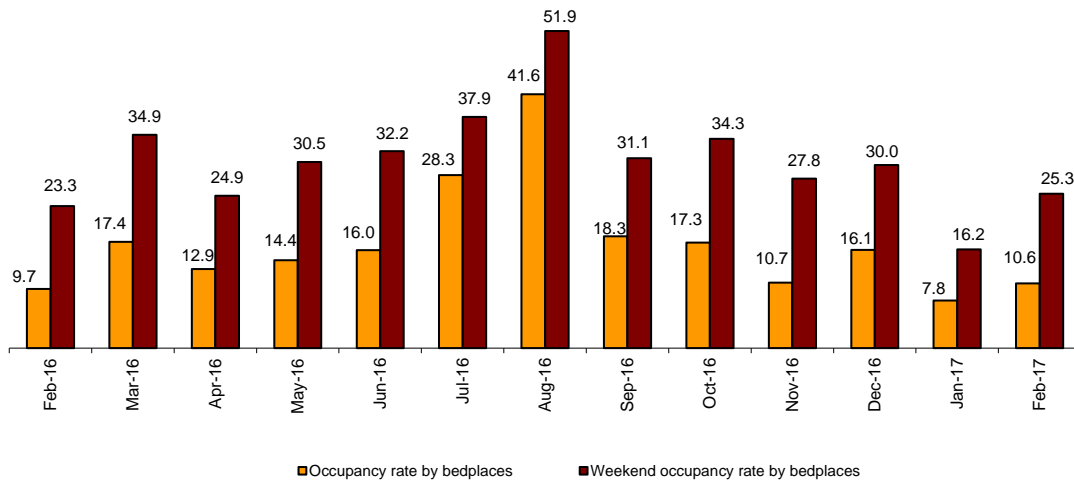
The tourist destinations with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Marbella.

Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 9.4% in February. Resident overnight stays grew by 9.2% and those of non-residents increased by 9.9%.

In rural tourism accommodation, 10.6% of the bedplaces were occupied, with a 9.2% increase as compared to February 2016. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 25.3%, with an annual increase of 8.7%.

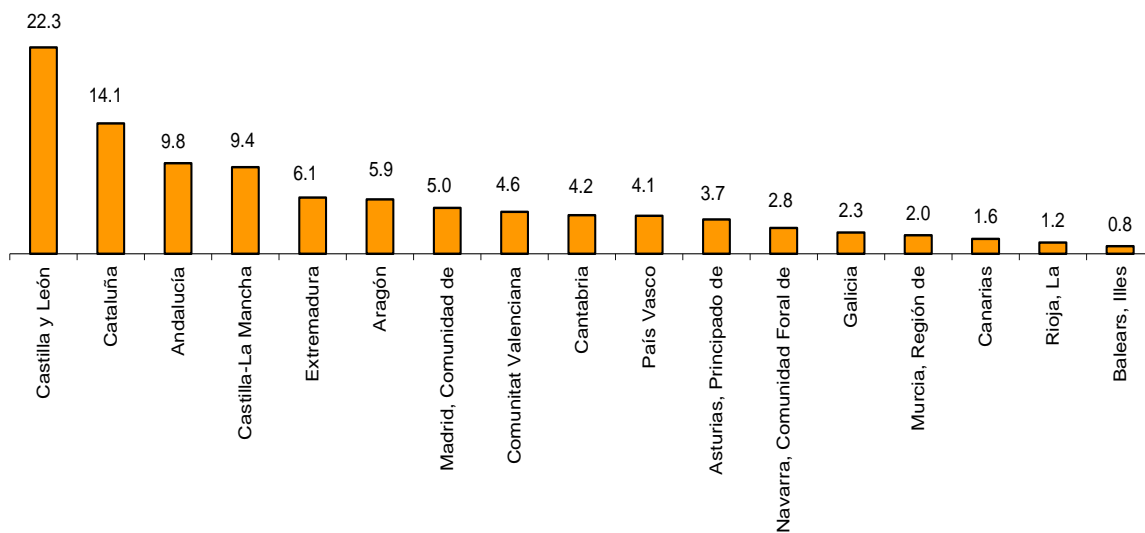
Occupancy rate by bedplaces and bedplaces on weekends in rural tourism accommodation



By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 74,673 overnight stays, 4.7% more than in February 2016. Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 43.1% of the bedplaces offered.

By tourist area, Pirineus was the main destination, with 23,247 overnight stays. The Parque Nacional del Teide reached the highest occupancy rate with 47.8% of the bedplaces offered.

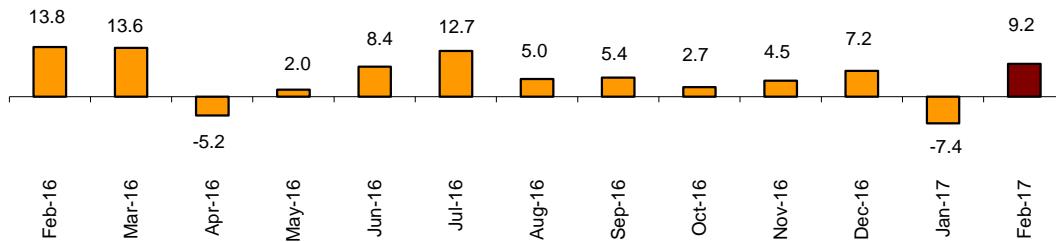
Distribution of overnight stays of traveller residents by autonomous community of destination in rural tourism accommodation in %



Youth Hostels

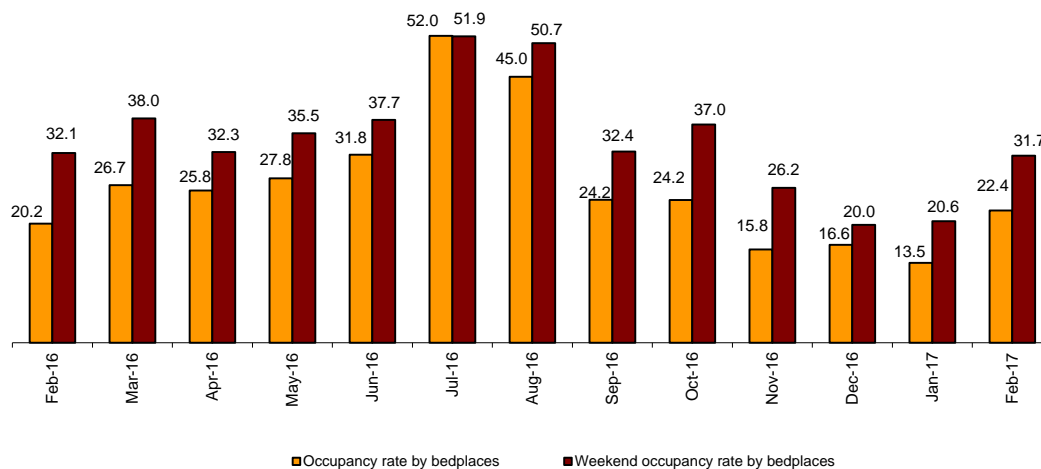
Overnight stays in hostels registered an annual increase of 9.2% in February. Resident overnight stays grew by 10.7% and those of non-residents increased by 6.3%.

This month, 22.4% of the available bedplaces were occupied, 11.0% more than in February 2016. The weekend occupancy rate reached 31.7%, with a 2.1% increase.

By Autonomous Community, Cataluña was the preferred destination, with 50,062 overnight stays, 2.6% more than in February 2016. Andalucía reached the highest occupancy rate, with 35.3% of the bedplaces offered.

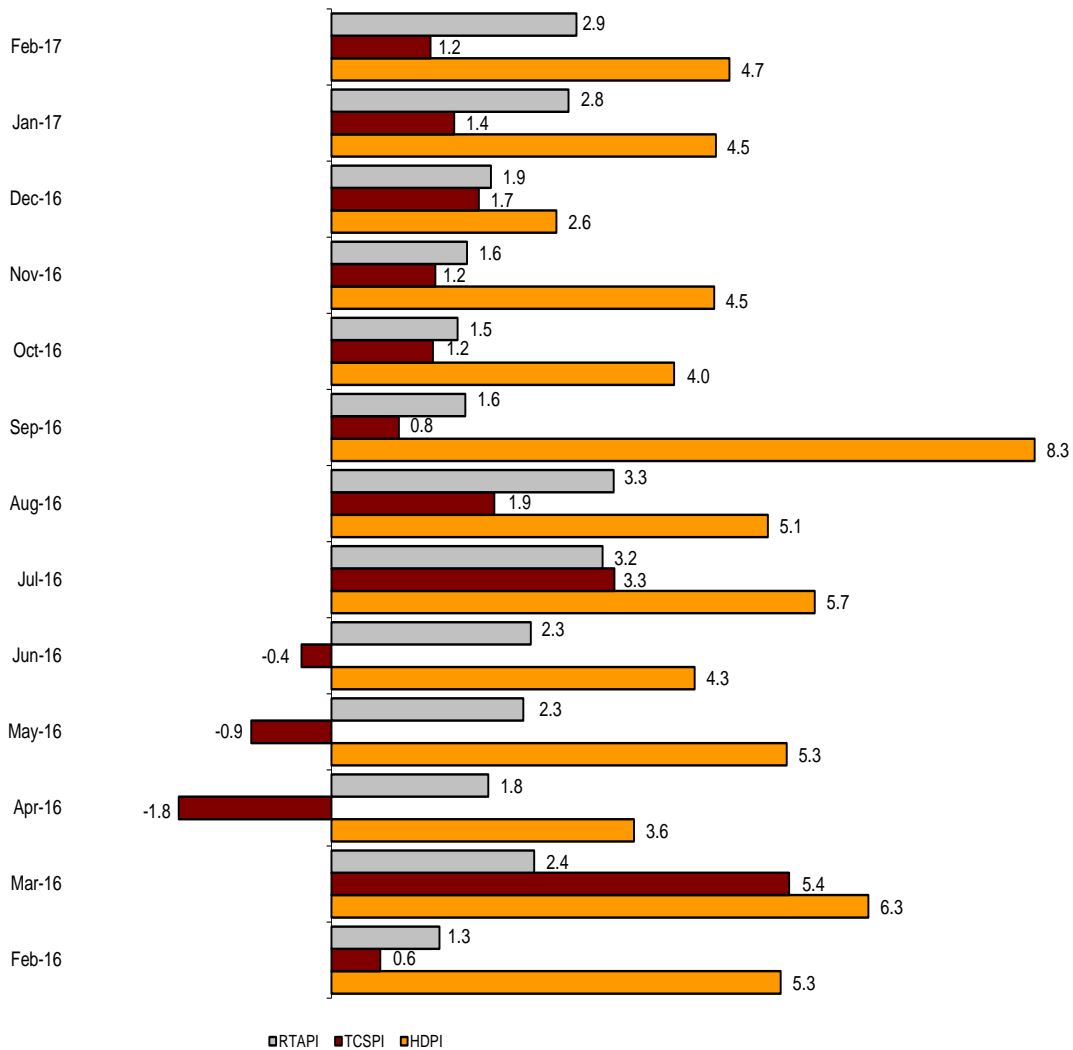
Price indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) increased 4.7%, as compared to February 2016. The rate for *tour-operators and travel agencies*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (57.9%), increased 6.2%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) increased by 1.2% in the annual rate. The *bungalow* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weightings structure in February (35.0%), grew by 0.3% as compared with the same month of 2016.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) registered a 2.9% increase in February. The *weekend rate*, which accounted for 72.5% of the total weight, increased by 2.8% in the annual rate.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

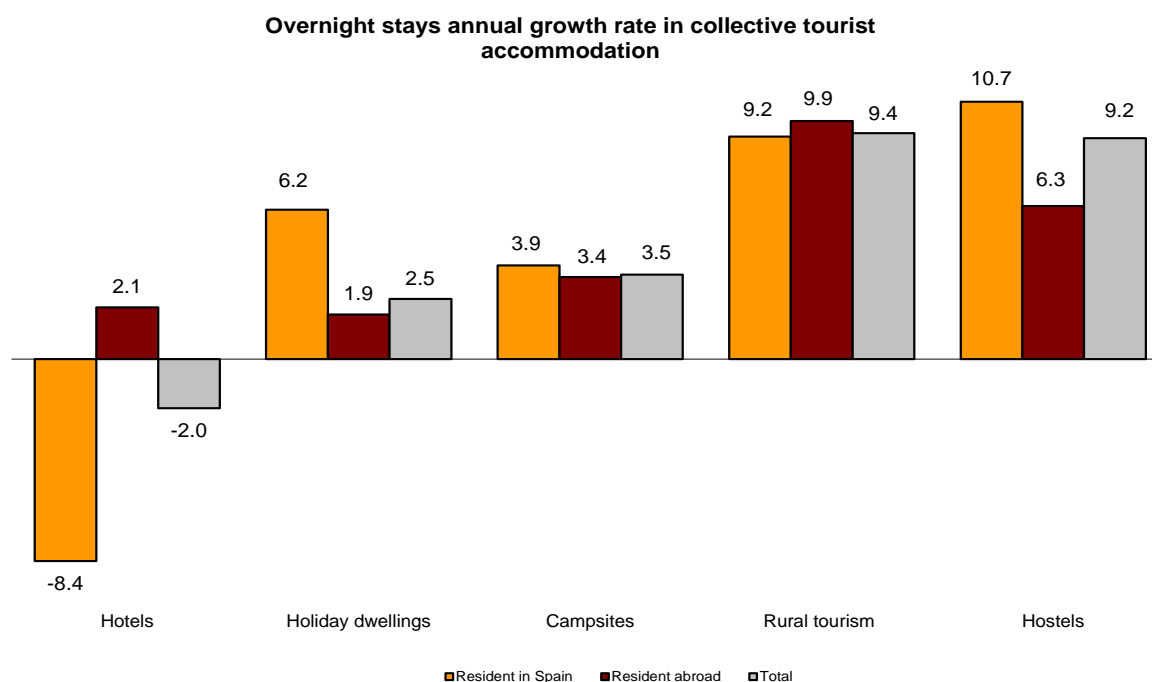
In February, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels¹, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) registered a 0.7% decrease in the annual rate. Overnight stays by residents decreased 6.0%, whilst stays by non-residents increased 2.2%.

The average stay decreased 3.0%, and stood at 3.3 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 73% corresponded to hotels, and 27% to non-hotel tourist accommodation.



The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were The United Kingdom (with 25.5% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (18.3%) and France (6.7%).

Canarias was the preferred destination, with over 8.1 million overnight stays (1.4% less than in February 2016). It was followed by Andalucía, with over 3.2 million overnight stays (and an decrease of 3.8%) and Cataluña, with over 2.6 million, (an increase of 0.9%).
