Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
February 2018. *Provisional data*

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation decrease 1.7% in February, as compared to the same month of 2017

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (apartments, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) exceeded 5.7 million in February, 1.7% less than in the same month of 2017. Overnight stays by residents decreased by 2.3% and those by non-residents do so by 1.5%.

The average stay stood at 5.6 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first two months of 2018, overnight stays decreased by 2.1% as compared to the same period of the previous year.


Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decreased by 3.3% in February. Resident overnight stays decreased by 1.7%, and non-resident overnight stays did so by 3.5%.

The average stay decreased by 3.1% as compared to February 2017, standing at 6.5 overnight stays per traveller.


In February, 35.3% of the bed-places offered by holiday dwellings were occupied, 5.0% less than in the same month of 2017. The weekend occupancy rate by bed-places stood at 37.9%, with a decrease of 5.6%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 84.4% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 999,655 overnight stays, 4.8% less than in February 2017. The following country of origin was Germany, with 525,825 overnight stays, 3.9% more.

Canarias was the preferred destination for holiday dwellings, with more than 2.5 million overnight stays and a decrease of 4.3% as compared to February 2017. This Autonomous Community also reached the highest occupancy rate, with 86.9% of the holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination, with 906,980 overnight stays. This area also reached the highest occupancy rate, with 89.9% of the holiday dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays in February were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Mogán.


Tourist campsites

Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an increase of 2.2% in February as compared to the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays by residents decreased by 8.4%, while those by non-residents increased by 5.3%.

During the month of February, 40.0% of the pitches offered were occupied, 4.9% more than in the same month of 2017. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 41.1%, with an annual increase of 4.7%.

79.8% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were made by non-residents. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin with 34.3% of overnight stays by non-residents, 2.3% more than in February 2017.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with 576,130 overnight stays, representing an annual increase of 5.2%. This Autonomous Community also reached the highest occupancy rate, with 64.9% of the pitches offered.

By tourist area, the Costa Blanca was the preferred destination, with 311,087 overnight stays. It also reached the highest occupancy rate, with 86.6% of pitches offered.


The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Marbella.

Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual decrease of 0.8% in February. Overnight stays by residents dropped by 3.0%, whilst those by non-residents increased by 6.9%.

In rural tourism accommodation, 10.4% of the bed-places were occupied, that is, a 2.3% decrease as compared to February 2017. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 23.9%, with an annual decrease of 5.7%.


Occupancy rate and weekend occupancy rate per bed-places in rural tourism accommodation



By Autonomous Communities, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 72,865 overnight stays, 3.3% less than in February 2017. Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 43.1% of the bed-places offered.

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 24,237 overnight stays. The Corona Forestal Natural Park reached the highest occupancy rate, with 49.7% of the bed-places offered.


Distribution of resident overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation by Autonomous Community in %



Youth Hostels


Overnight stays in hostels registered an annual increase of 14.0% in February. Resident overnight stays grew by 13.3%, and those of non-residents by 15.5%.

24.2% of the bed-places were occupied, 7.0% more than in February 2017. The weekend occupancy rate reached 31.9%, with a 2.0% increase.

By Autonomous Community, Cataluña was the preferred destination, with 47,114 overnight stays, 7.9% less than in February 2017. Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 59.3% of the bed-places occupied.


Price indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) increased by 5.3%, as compared to February 2017. The rate for *tour operators and travel agencies*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (61.0%), increased by 6.7%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) increased by 0.1 in the annual rate. The *bungalow* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weightings structure in February (37.5%), decreased by 1.8% as compared to the same month of 2017.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) registered a 2.9% increase in February. The *weekend rate*, which accounted for 72.5% of the total weight, increased by 3.0% in the annual rate.

In February, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels¹, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) registered a 0.3%

increase in the annual rate. Resident overnight stays grew by 0.1%, and those of non-residents by 0.4%.


The average stay decreased 1.7%, standing at 3.3 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays made in collective tourist accommodation, 74% corresponded to hotels and 26% to non-hotel tourist accommodation.

Annual variation rates for overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in %



The main countries of origin for all types of regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 24.8% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (18.6%) and France (6.1%).

Canarias was the preferred destination, with 8.0 million overnight stays (2.1% less than in February 2017). It was followed by Andalucía, with 3.4 million overnight stays (and an increase of 3.4%) and Cataluña, with over 2.6 million, (and an annual decrease of 0.8%).
