

**Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey**  
March 2017. *Provisional data*

**Overnight stays in Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation<sup>1</sup> decrease 15.8% in March as compared with the same month of 2016**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) exceeded 6.6 million in March, 15.8% less than in the same month of 2016. Overnight stays by residents decreased 43.3%, whilst those of non-residents increased 0.8%.

The average stay stood at 5.2 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first quarter of 2017, overnight stays decreased 3.8% with respect to the same period the previous year.

**Holiday dwellings**


Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decreased by 5.5% in March. Overnight stays by residents dropped 29.8%, whilst those by non-residents grew 1.1%.

The average stay increased 1.0% as compared with March 2016, standing at 6.4 overnight stays per traveller.

In March, 35.2% of the bedplaces available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 7.7% less than in the same month of 2016. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 38.5%, with a decrease of 9.4%.



**Overnight stays annual growth rate in holiday dwellings in %**



Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 84.2% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with more than 1.1 million overnight stays, that is, 0.2% more than in March 2016. The following country of origin was Germany, with 521,869 overnight stays, 11.9% less.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.8 million overnight stays, with a decrease of 2.7% as compared to March 2016. This Autonomous Community presented the highest occupancy rate, with 87.0% of holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination, with 965,004 overnight stays and an occupancy of 89.7% of holiday dwellings offered.


The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays in March were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Mogán.

## Tourist campsites

Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an annual decrease of 33.8% in March as compared to the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays by residents dropped 61.1%, whilst those by non-residents grew 1.2%.

During the month of March, 35.5% of the offered pitches were occupied, 1.8% more than the same month of 2016. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 37.2%, with an annual decrease of 2.5%.

67.0% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents travellers. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin with 34.6% of overnight stays by non-residents, 6.4% more than in March 2016.



Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred camping destination, with 590,427 overnight stays, 11.2% less in annual rate. La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate, with 60.8% of the pitches offered.


By tourist areas, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination, with 309,503 overnight stays and an occupancy of 78.4% of the pitches offered.

The tourist destinations with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Marbella.

## Rural tourism accommodation


Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual decrease of 34.8% in March. Resident overnight stays decreased by 39.5%, and non-resident overnight stays did so by 11.3%.

In rural tourism accommodation, 11.2% of the bedplaces were occupied, 35.2% less than in March 2016. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 26.0%, with an annual decrease of 25.4%.



By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 99,938 overnight stays, 32.2% less than in March 2016. Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 40.9% of the bedplaces offered.


By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 36,775 overnight stays. The Parque Nacional de Taburiente reached the highest occupancy rate with 45.2% of the bedplaces offered.



## Youth Hostels


Overnight stays in hostels registered an annual decrease of 13.7% in March. Overnight stays by residents dropped 19.8%, whilst those by non-residents grew 3.1%.

In March, 24.4% of the bedplaces were occupied, 8.6% less than in the same month of 2016. The weekend occupancy rate reached 32.6%, with a 14.1% decrease.

By Autonomous Community, Cataluña was the preferred destination, with 69,185 overnight stays, 12.0% less than in March 2016. Comunidad de Madrid reached the highest occupancy rate, with 40.0% of the bedplaces offered.


## Price indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) increased 3.1%, as compared to March 2016. The rate for *tour-operators and travel agencies*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (54.4%), increased 5.0%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) decreased by 2.9% in the annual rate. The *bungalow* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weightings structure in March (37.6%), decreased by 4.0% as compared with the same month of 2016.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) registered a 1.1% increase in March. The *weekend rate*, which accounted for 58.7% of the total weight, increased by 1.0% in the annual rate.

## Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In March, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels<sup>2</sup>, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) registered a 9.6% decrease in the annual rate. Resident overnight stays decreased by 23.0%, and non-resident overnight stays did so by 0.2%.


The average stay decreased 2.8%, and stood at 3.3 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 75% corresponded to hotels, and 25% to non-hotel tourist accommodation.

Overnight stays annual growth rate in collective tourist accommodation



The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were The United Kingdom (with 25.7% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (20.1%) and France (6.0%).

Canarias was the preferred destination, with over 8.7 million overnight stays (2.0% less than in March 2016). It was followed by Andalucía, with over 4.2 million overnight stays (and an annual decrease of 10.6%) and Cataluña, with over 3.6 million, (a decrease of 17.5%).
