Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
April 2014. *Provisional data*

7.0 million overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation¹ are registered in April, that is, 35.1% more as compared with the same month of 2013

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) exceeded 7.0 millions in April, that is, 35.1% more than in the same month of 2013. Overnight stays of resident travellers increased 83.7% and those of non-residents did so by 14.9%. The average stay stands at 4.7 overnights per traveller.

In the first quarter 2014, overnight stays increased by 7.7% as compared with the same period of the previous year.

Since Easter holidays took place in April this year, and in 2013 they took place in March, it is desirable to analyse **the data of March and April together**. During this period of time overnights increased by 8.8% as compared with the same both months of 2013. Those of residents increased by 7.2% and those of non-residents did so by 9.5%.

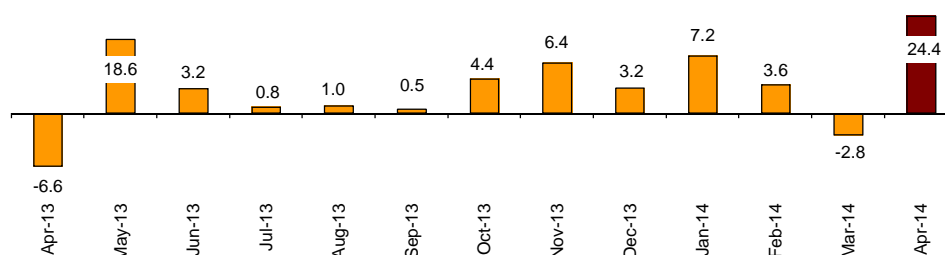

Holiday Dwellings¹

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased 24.4% in April. Those of residents increased 61.4%, whereas overnight stays of non-residents increased 16.2%. Considering **the data of March and April together**, overnight stays increased by 9.4%.

Overnight stays annual growth rate in holiday dwellings in %

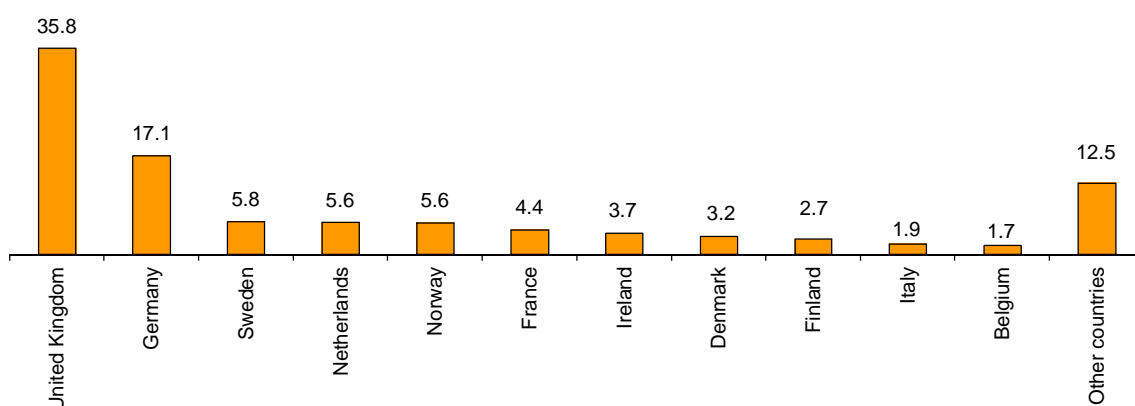


¹ Since in 2014 Easter holidays took place in April, and in 2013 they took place in March, it is desirable to wait for the data of this survey in April, since then it will be possible to analyse the data of both months together.

In April, 34.1% of the bedplaces available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 22.3% more than in the same month of 2013. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 38.5%, with an annual increase of 28.0%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 76.4% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 1.1 million overnight stays, 10.5% more than in April 2013. The following country of origin was Germany, with 574,206 overnight stays, 25.1% more.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.4 million overnight stays, 18.1% more than in April 2013. This Autonomous Community registered the highest occupancy rate with 65.5% of the dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Tenerife was the preferred destination, with 779,634 overnight stays. Catalunya Central reached the highest occupancy rate with 87.7% of the dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in April were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.

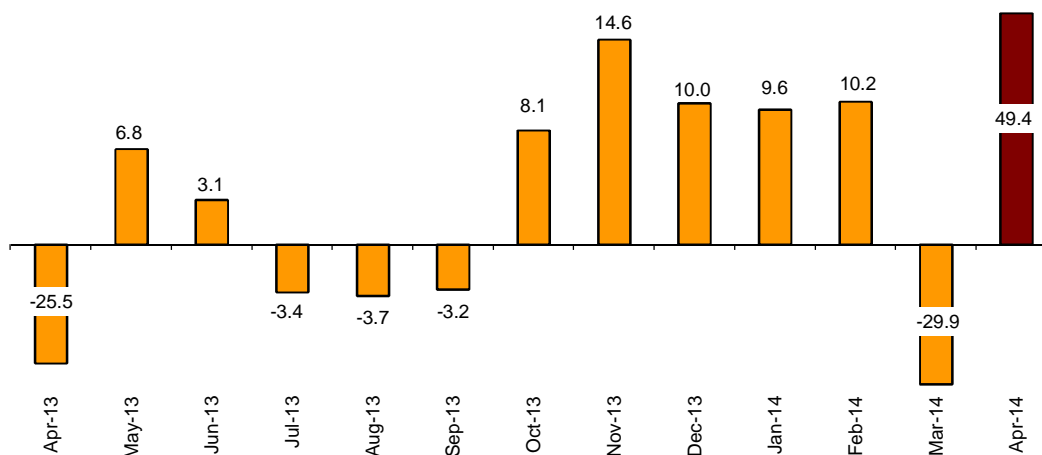
Campsites¹

The overnight stays in tourist campsites registered an annual increase of 49.4% in April. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 94.0% and those of non-resident travellers did so by 8.9%. During the period **March-April**, overnight stays increased by 7.3%.

In April, 31.5% of the offered pitches were occupied, that is, a 14.3% increase. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 34.7%, with an annual increase of 18.3%.

38.2% of the overnight stays in tourist campsites were by non-residents. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 26.5% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 0.2% more than in April 2013.

Cataluña was the preferred destination regarding campsites, with 810,182 overnight stays, 51.4% more than in April 2013.

La Rioja was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate on campsites, with 60.5% of the pitches offered.

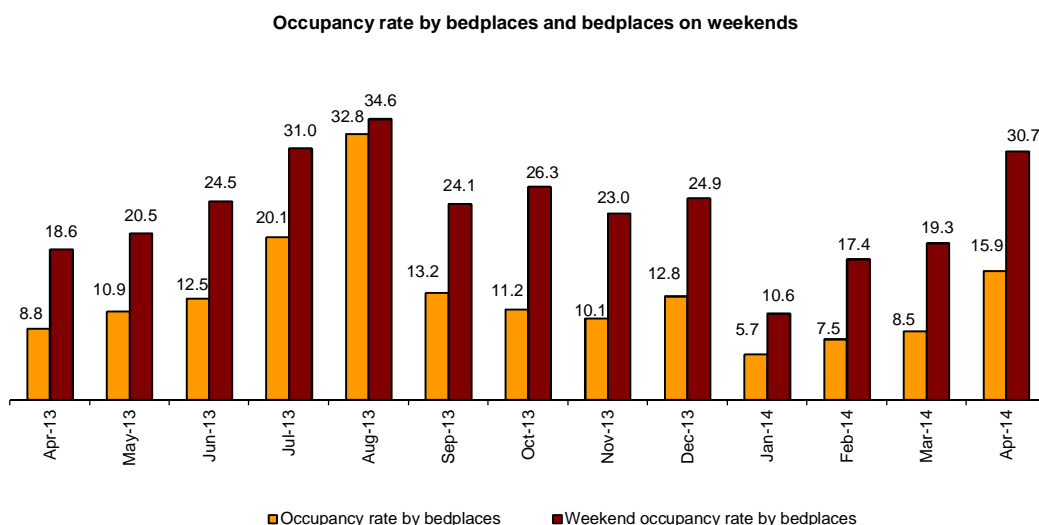
By tourist areas, Costa Daurada was the preferred destination for camping, with 299,153 overnight stays. The Parque Natural Delta de l'Ebre reached the highest occupancy rate, with 58.1% of the pitches offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Benidorm, MOnT-Roig del Camp and Salou.

Rural Tourism Accommodation¹

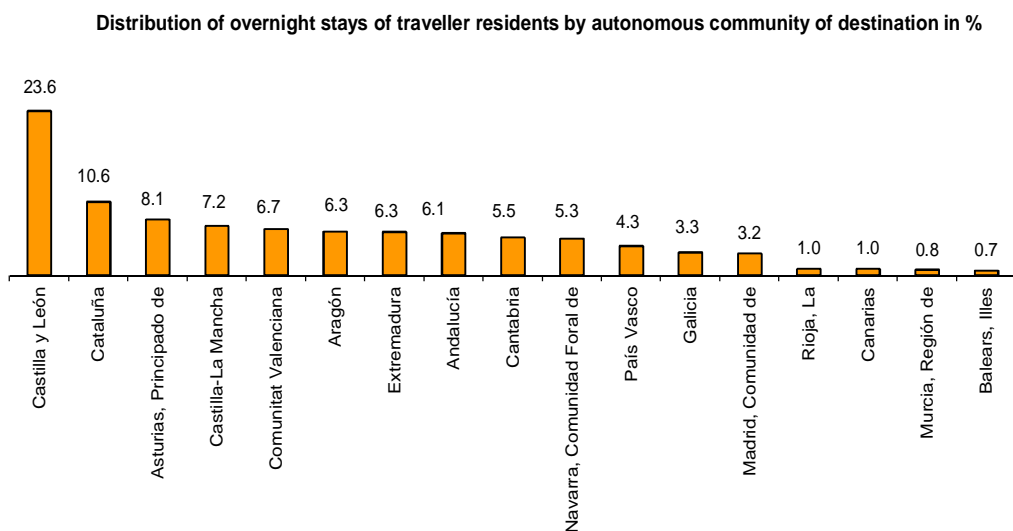
Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 83.8% in April. Residents' overnight stays increased 113.6% while those of non-residents did so by 19.3%. During the period **March-April**, overnight stays increased by 7.6%.

Regarding the rural tourism accommodation, 15.9% of the bedplaces were occupied, that is, 80.9% increase as compared to April 2013. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 30.7%, with an increase of 65.4%.



By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 136,759 overnight stays, 86.7% more than in April 2013. Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 41.5% of the bedplaces offered.

By tourist area, the island of Majorca was the main destination, with 51,480 overnight stays and the greatest occupancy rate, with 43.8% of the bedplaces offered.



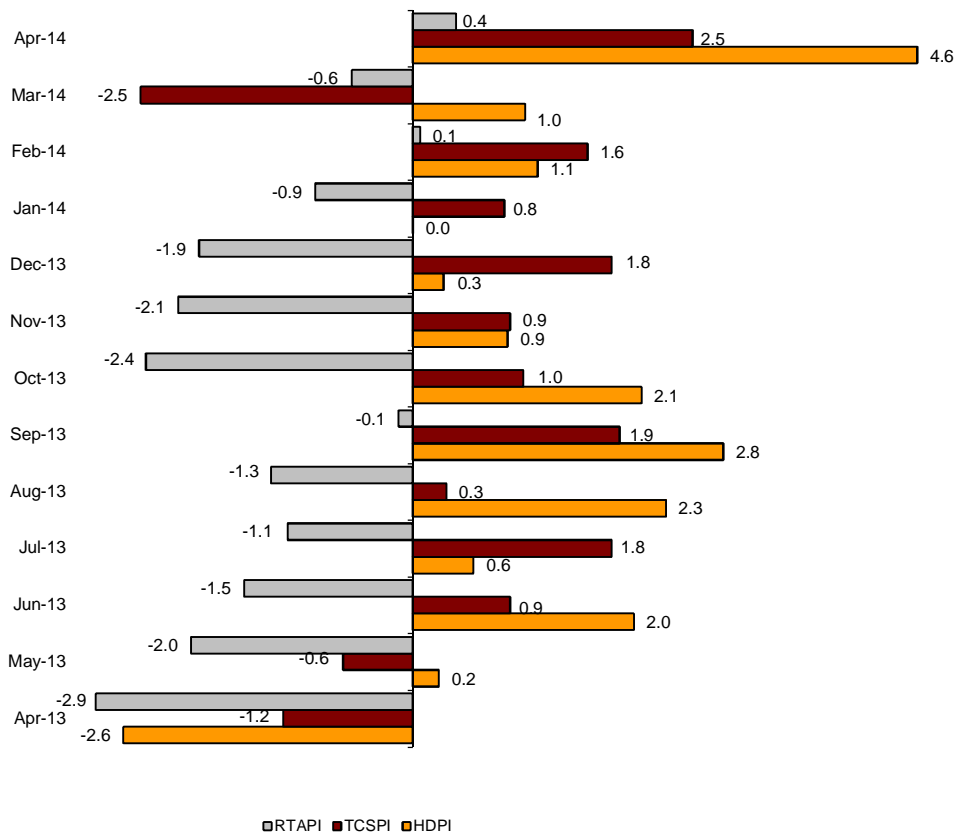
Price Indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) increased 4.6%, as compared to April 2013. The *tour operators and travel agencies* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (51.4%), increased 5.3%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) increased 2.5% in the annual rate. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for April (54.6%), increased by 1.9%.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) registered a 0.4% increase in April. The *weekend* rate, which accounted for 61.3% of the total weight, increased 0.7%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

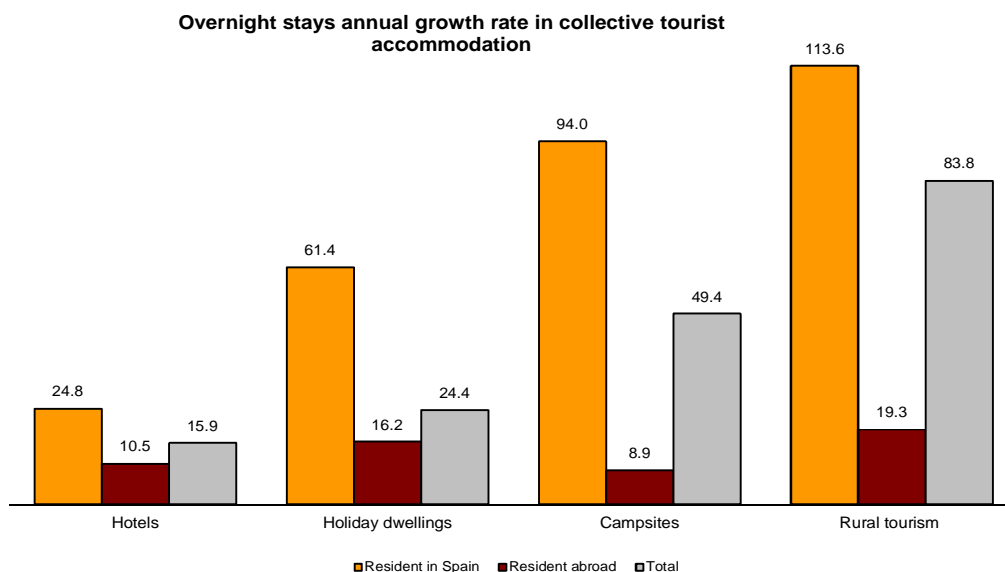
Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered a 20.0% increase in April, as compared with the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays of residents increased 35.2%, whereas those of non-residents did so by 11.6%. During the period **March-April**, overnight stays increased by 5.8%.

The average stay increased 0.3% in April 2014 as compared to the same month of the previous year, standing at 3.3 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 76% accounted for hotels, and 24% did so for non-hotel tourist accommodation.



The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 24.2% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (23.1%) and France (8.7%).

Canarias was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 7.3 million overnight stays (that is, 16.6% more than that registered in April 2013), followed by Cataluña, with over 4.9 million overnight stays (that is, 22.7% more than that registered in the same month of the previous year) and Andalucía, with over 4.8 million overnight stays (20.7% more than in the same month of 2013).
