Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
May 2013. *Provisional data*

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increased 13.8% in May⁽¹⁾, as compared with the same month of 2012

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) exceeded seven million in May, 13.8% more than in the same month of 2012. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 1.7%, whereas those of non-residents increased 19.5%. The average stay increased 1.9%, standing at 5.0 overnights per traveller.

During the first five months of 2013, the overnight stays increased 2.4% as compared with the same month of the previous year.



Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased 18.6% in May. The increase in overnight stays took place both among residents (with an annual rate of 14.2%) and non-residents (19.7%).

The average stay increased 1.0%, as compared with May 2012, standing at 6.0 overnight stays per traveller.




⁽¹⁾ Due to the update made in the rural tourist accommodation directory in Región de Murcia, the data published cannot be directly compared to those published last year. In order to avoid this break in the series, linking coefficients have been calculated, allowing for comparing the data from different years. The coefficients are published monthly on the INE website, in the section dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled linking coefficient

In May, 30.6% of the total available bedplaces for holiday dwellings were occupied, 15.4% more than in the same month in 2012. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 33.2%, with an annual increase of 13.7%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 80.8% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with over 1.5 million overnight stays, 11.3% more than in May 2012. The following country of origin was Germany, with 683,359 overnight stays, 41.4% more.

Canarias and Illes Balears were the preferred holiday dwelling destinations, with annual rates of overnight stays of 12.8% and 29.1% respectively. Comunidad de Madrid registered the highest occupancy rate with 63.2% of the dwellings offered.

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with more than 745,227 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 65.4%.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.

Campsites

The overnight stays in tourist campsites registered an annual increase of 6.8%. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased by 8.4%, whereas those of non-resident travellers increased by 21.6%.

29.4% of the offered pitches were occupied, 3.8% more. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 32.2%, with an annual increase of 3.9%.


57.7% of the overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. The Netherlands was the main country of origin, with 28.6% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 26.2% more than in May 2012.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for camping, with over one million overnight stays, 12.4% more. La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate on campsites, with 58.8% of the pitches offered.

By tourist area, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for camping, with 397.764 overnight stays. Costa Blanca reached the highest occupancy, with 48.7% of the pitches offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Benidorm, Salou and Mont-Roig del Camp.

Overnight stays annual growth rate in campsites in %




Rural Tourism Accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 0.9%, in May⁽¹⁾. Residents' overnight stays decreased 0.7%, whilst those of non-residents increased by 4.3%.

10.8% of the bedplaces in rural tourism accommodation were occupied, representing a 1.5% annual increase. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 20.4%, with an increase of 2.9%.


Occupancy rate by bedplaces and bedplaces on weekends



By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 88,995 overnight stays, 3.9% more than in May 2012. Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 50.8% of the offered bedplaces.

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the main destination, with 69,741 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 53.1% of the offered bedplaces.

Distribution of overnight stays of traveller residents by autonomous community of destination in %




Price Indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) registered an annual increase of 0.2%. The tour operators and travel agencies rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (50.2%), increased 2.3%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) registered a decrease of 0.6% in the annual rate. The normal rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for May (59.0%), decreased 2.1%.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) registered a decrease of 2.0% in May. The weekend rate, which accounted for 60.2% of the total weight, decreased 1.6%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered an increase of 8.4% in May ⁽¹⁾, as compared with the same month of the last year. Overnight stays by residents increased 3.8%, whereas those of non-residents did so by 10.6%.


The average stay increased 2.2%, standing at 3.5 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of May, 79% were accounted for hotels, and 21% did so for non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 30.1% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (24.0%) and France (8.9%).

Ills Balears was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with over 7.4 million overnight stays (9.6% more than in May 2012). Followed by Cataluña, with over 6.2 million overnight stays (9.2% more) and Canarias, with over six million overnight stays (7.9% more).
