

**Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey**  
May 2017. *Provisional data*

**Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increase 5.3%  
in May, as compared with the same month in 2016**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (apartments, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) exceeded 9.2 million in May, 5.3% more than in the same month of 2016. The overnight stays by residents increased by 2.1% and those of non-residents did so by 6.8%.

The average stay stood at 4.4 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first five months of 2017, overnight stays increased by 7.5% as compared with the same period of the previous year.

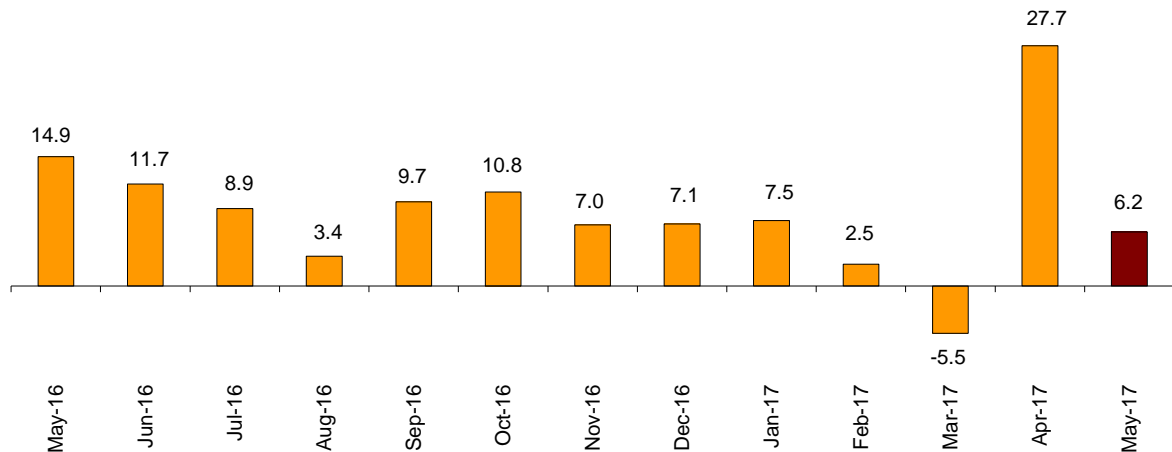
**Holiday Dwellings**

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased by 6.2% in May. The overnight stays by residents increased 0.6%, and non-resident stays increased 7.7%.

The average stay decreased 1.9% as compared with May 2016, and stood at 5.4 overnight stays per traveller.

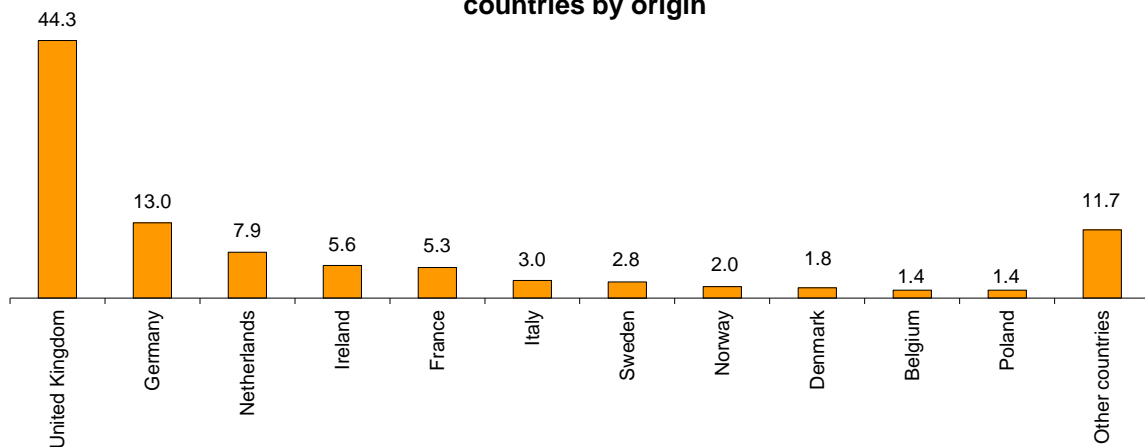
In May, 32.8% of the bedplaces available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 5.2% less than in the same month of 2016. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 37.2%, with a decrease of 5.5%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 80.2% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with more than two million overnight stays, that is, 15.4% more than in May 2016. The following country of origin was Germany, with 610,463 overnight stays, 16.5% less.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.2 million overnight stays, 5.0% more than in May 2016. The Comunidad de Madrid reached the highest occupancy rate, with 75.5% of the bedplaces offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Tenerife was the preferred destination, with 772,530 overnight stays. The island of Lanzarote registered the highest occupancy rate, with 79.8% of the holiday dwellings offered.

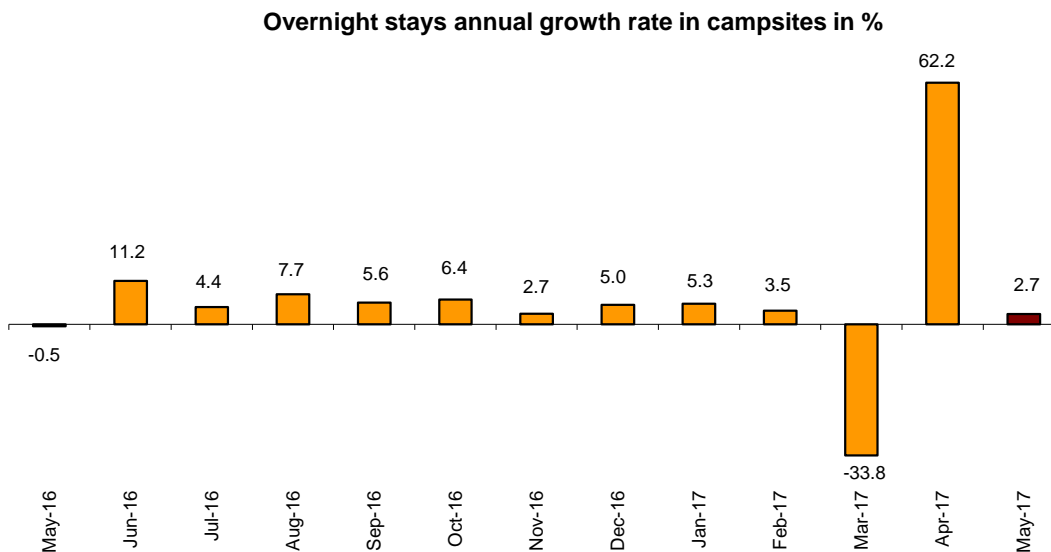
The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in May were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.

## Tourist campsites

Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an annual increase of 2.7% in May as compared to the same month of the previous year. Resident overnight stays grew by 3.2% and non-residents by 2.2%.

During the month of May, 32.2% of the offered parcels were occupied, 0.6% more than in the same month of 2016. The weekend occupancy rate by parcel reached 35.0%, with an annual decrease of 0.8%.

Of overnight stays on tourist campsites 53.8% were by non-residents travellers. The Netherlands was the main country of origin, with 27.5% of the overnight stays by non-, 3.0% more than in May 2016.



Cataluña was the preferred destination for camping, with more than one million overnight stays, 2.3% more in the annual rate. La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate, with 60.2% of the parcels offered.

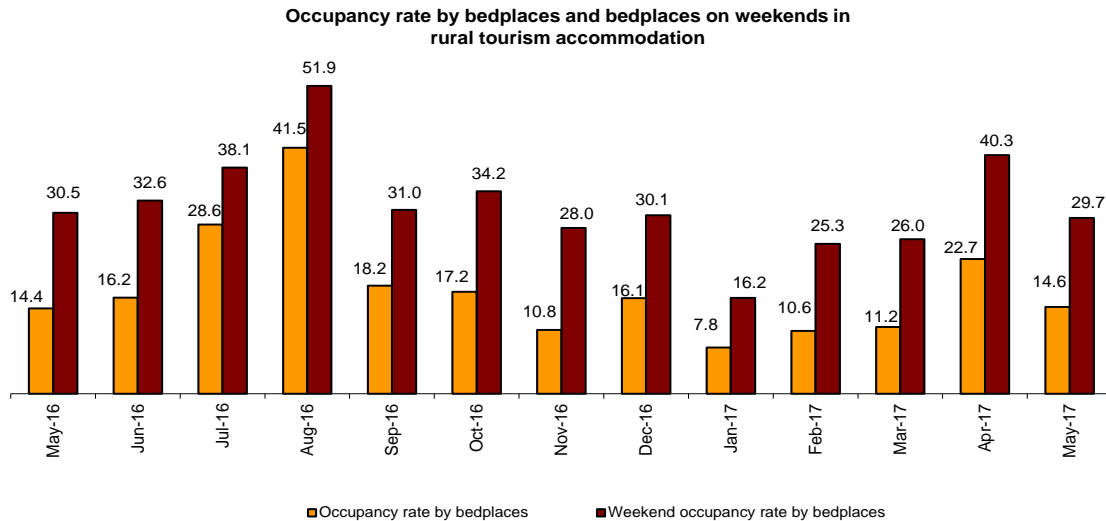
By tourist area, Costa Daurada was the preferred destination for camping, with 419,498 overnight stays. The Costa Blanca reached the highest occupancy rate, with 63.6% of the available lots covered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Benidorm, Mont-Roig Del Camp and Tarragona.

## Rural tourism accommodation

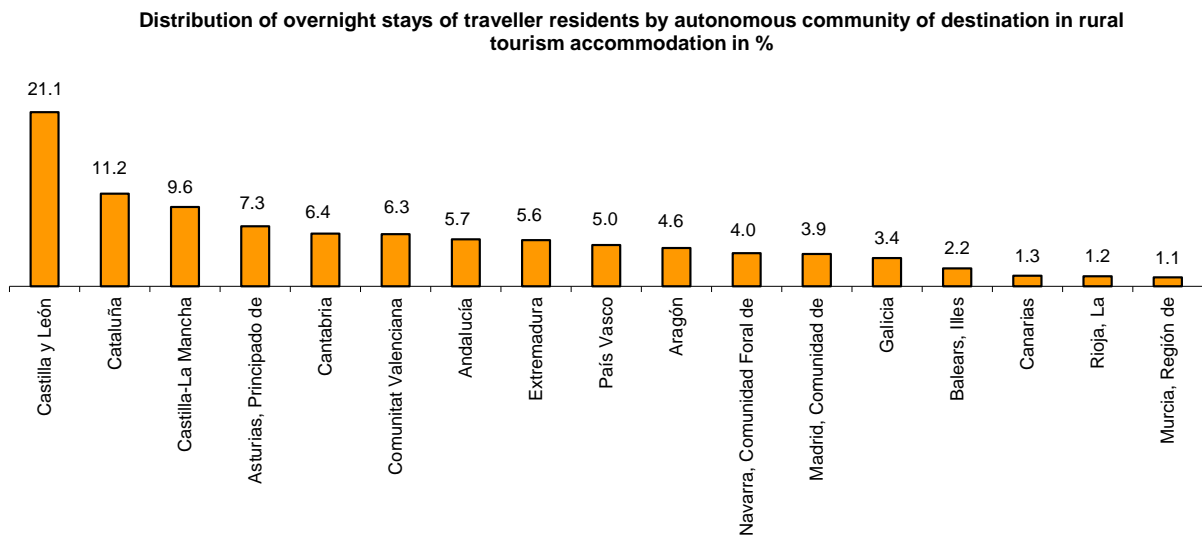
Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 6.6% in May. Resident overnight stays grew by 2.3%, and those of non-residents increased by 14.4%.

In rural tourism accommodation, 14.6% of the bedplaces were occupied, with a 1.7% increase as compared to May 2016. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 29.7%, with an annual decrease of 2.8%.



By Autonomous Community, Illes Balears was the preferred destination, with 120,942 overnight stays, 5.6% more than in May 2016. This community also reached the highest occupancy rate, with 51.4% of the accommodations offered.

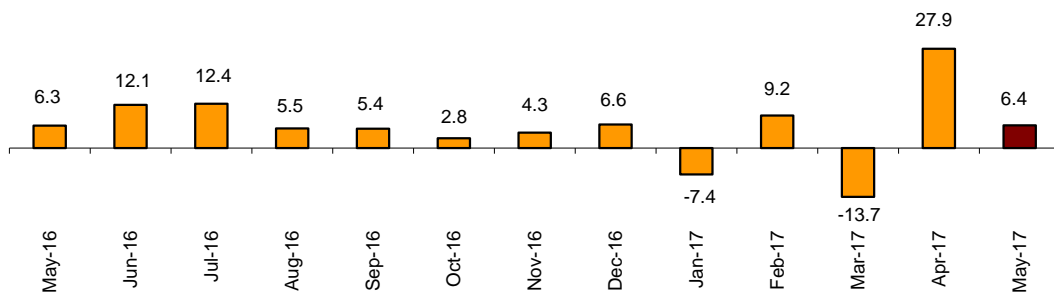
By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 101,931 overnight stays. The island of Ibiza and Formentera registered the highest occupancy rate, with 52.2% of the holiday accommodations offered.



## Youth Hostels

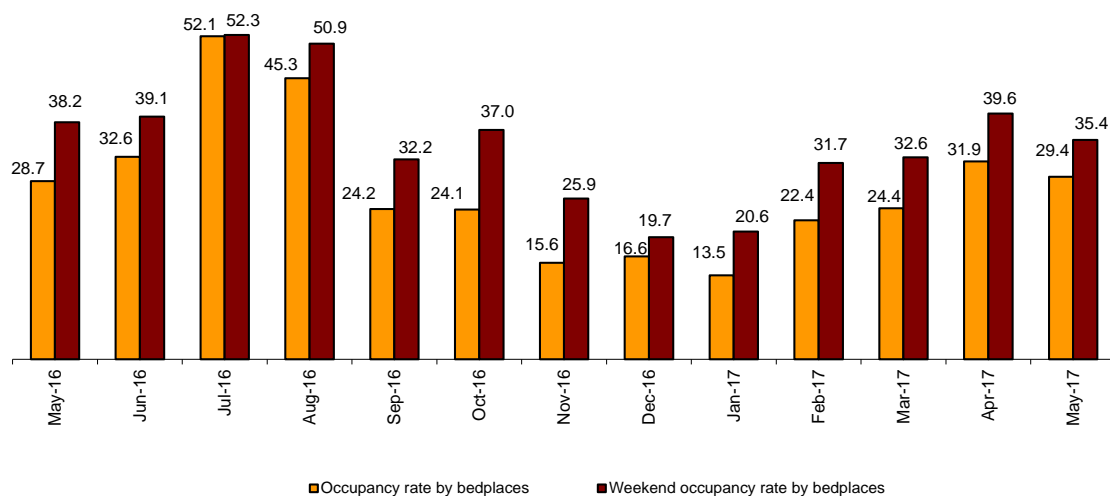
Overnight stays in hostels registered an annual increase of 6.4% in May. Resident overnight stays grew by 6.2% and those of non-residents increased by 6.8%.

Of the available bedplaces 29.4% were occupied, 2.4% more than in May 2016. The weekend occupancy rate reached 35.4%, with a 7.4% decrease.

By Autonomous Community, Cataluña was the preferred destination, with 102,300 overnight stays, 0.9% more than in May 2016. This Community also reached the highest occupancy rate, with 49.5% of the bedplaces offered.

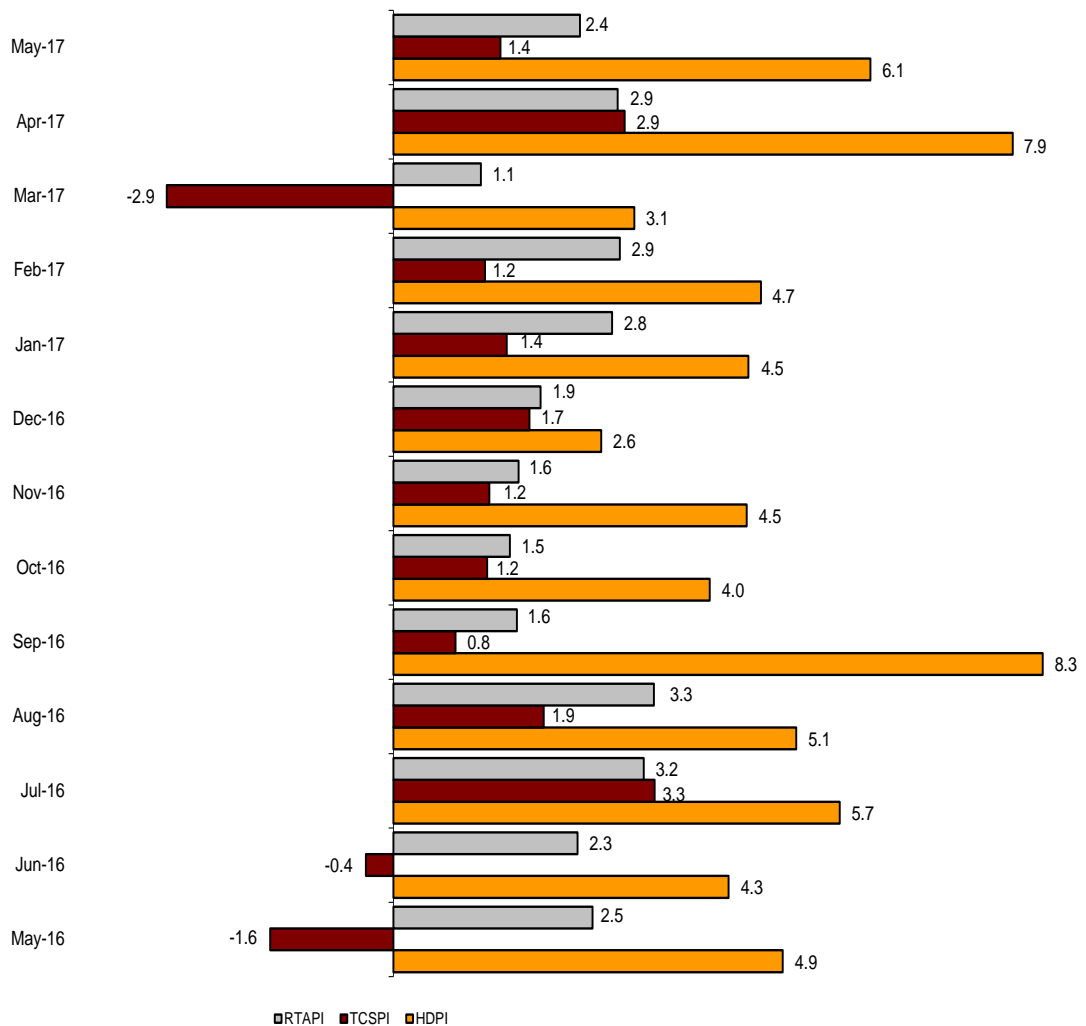
**Price indices**

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) increased 6.1%, as compared to May 2016. The rate for *tour operators and travel agencies*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (49.7%), increased by 7.0%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) increased by 1.4% in the annual rate. The *bungalow* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weightings structure in May (37.2%), decreased by 0.9% as compared with the same month of 2016.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) registered a 2.4% increase in May. The *weekend rate*, which accounted for 59.0% of the total weight, increased by 2.4% in the annual rate.

## Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In May, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels<sup>1</sup>, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) registered a 4.1% increase in the annual rate. Resident overnight stays grew by 1.0% and non-residents 5.5%.

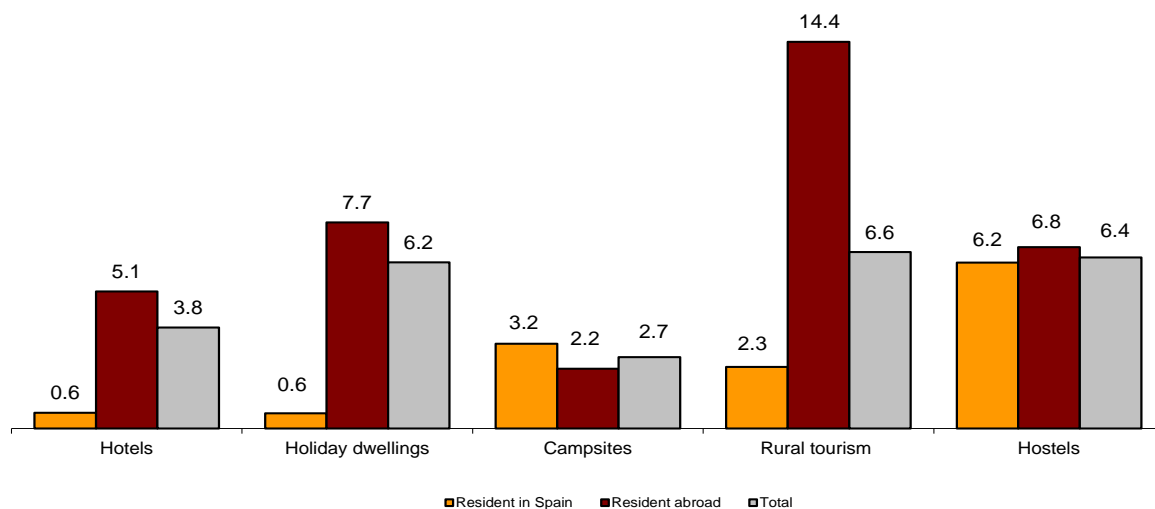
The average stay increased 0.6%, standing at 3.4 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 77% corresponded to hotels, and 23% to non-hotel tourist accommodation.

Overnight stays annual growth rate in collective tourist accommodation



The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were The United Kingdom (with 30.4% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (21.8%) and France (8.3%).

Illes Balears is the preferred destination, with over 8.7 million overnight stays (4.9% more than in May 2016). It was followed by Canarias, with over 7.5 million overnight stays (and an increase of 2.9%) and Cataluña, with over 7.0 million, (and an increase of 2.6%).
