Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
June 2013. *Provisional data*

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increased 3.1% in June⁽¹⁾, as compared with the same month of 2012

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) exceeded 9.6 million in June, 3.1% more than in the same month of 2012. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 2.7%, whereas those of non-residents increased 6.8%. The average stay increased 0.1%, standing at 5.0 overnights per traveller.

During the first semester of 2013, the overnight stays increased 2.6% as compared with the same month of the previous year.



Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased 3.2% in June. Overnight stays of residents decreased 2.7% whereas overnight stays of non-residents increased 5.2%.

The average stay increased 0.7%, as compared with June 2012, standing at 6.1 overnight stays per traveller.




⁽¹⁾ Due to the update made in the rural tourist accommodation directory in Región de Murcia, the data published cannot be directly compared to those published last year. In order to avoid this break in the series, linking coefficients have been calculated, allowing for comparing the data from different years. The coefficients are published monthly on the INE website, in the section dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled linking coefficient

In June, 36.8% of the total available bedplaces for holiday dwellings were occupied, 0.6% more than in the same month in 2012. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 40.2%, with an annual increase of 3.7%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 75.4% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with over 1.9 million overnight stays, 6.3% more than in June 2012. The following country of origin was Germany, with 688,480 overnight stays, 2.3% more.

Canarias and Illes Balears were the preferred holiday dwelling destinations, with annual rates of overnight stays of 1.8% and 4.4% respectively. Illes Balears registered the highest occupancy rate with 73.2% of the dwellings offered.

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with more than 918,413 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 78.7%.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays were Arona, San Bartolomé de Tirajana and Tías.

Campsites

The overnight stays in tourist campsites registered an annual increase of 3.1% in June. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased by 4.0%, whereas those of non-resident travellers increased by 13.2%.

32.2% of the offered pitches were occupied, 0.8% more. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 36.2%, with an annual increase of 3.0%.


45.4% of the overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. The Netherlands was the main country of origin, with 27.2% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 24.2% more than in June 2012.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for camping, with over 1.7 million overnight stays, 10.5% more. La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate on campsites, with 60.4% of the pitches offered.

By tourist area, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for camping, with 759.553 overnight stays. Costa Blanca reached the highest occupancy, with 49.2% of the pitches offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Salou, Torroella de Montgri and Mont-Roig del Camp.

Overnight stays annual growth rate in campsites in %




Rural Tourism Accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 2.3%, in June⁽¹⁾. Residents' overnight stays increased 3.1%, whilst those of non-residents increased by 0.5%.

12.6% of the bedplaces in rural tourism accommodation were occupied, representing a 3.2% annual increase. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 24.6%, with an increase of 11.7%.


Occupancy rate by bedplaces and bedplaces on weekends



By Autonomous Community, Illes Balears was the preferred destination, with 92,963 overnight stays, 0.9% more than in June 2012. Illes Balears also reached the highest occupancy rate, with 57.5% of the offered bedplaces.

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the main destination, with 76,389 overnight stays. The islands of Ibiza and Formentera reached the highest occupancy rate with 58.5% of the offered bedplaces.

Distribution of overnight stays of traveller residents by autonomous community of destination in %




Price Indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) registered an annual increase of 0.2%. The tour operators and travel agencies rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (53.7%), increased 3.1%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) registered an increase of 0.9% in the annual rate. The normal rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for June (66.7%), decreased 0.2%.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) registered a decrease of 1.5% in June. The weekend rate, which accounted for 54.8% of the total weight, decreased 1.6%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation


Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered an increase of 2.0% in June ⁽¹⁾, as compared with the same month of the last year. Overnight stays by residents decreased 3.3%, whereas those of non-residents increased by 4.7%.

The average stay increased 0.3%, standing at 3.8 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of June, 76% were accounted for hotels, and 24% did so for non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 30.6% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (22.4%) and France (5.8%).

Ills Balears was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with over 10.2 million overnight stays (0.5% more than in June 2012). Followed by Cataluña, with over 8.1 million overnight stays (3.5% more) and Canarias, with over 6.3 million overnight stays (2.4% more).
