Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
June 2017. Provisional data

**Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increase 9.9%
in June, as compared with the same month of 2016**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) exceeded 12.7 million in June, 9.9% more than in the same month of 2016. Overnight stays by residents increased by 11.0% and those of non-residents did so by 9.3%.

The average stay stood at 4.5 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first semester of 2017, overnight stays increased 8.1% with respect to the same period of the previous year.

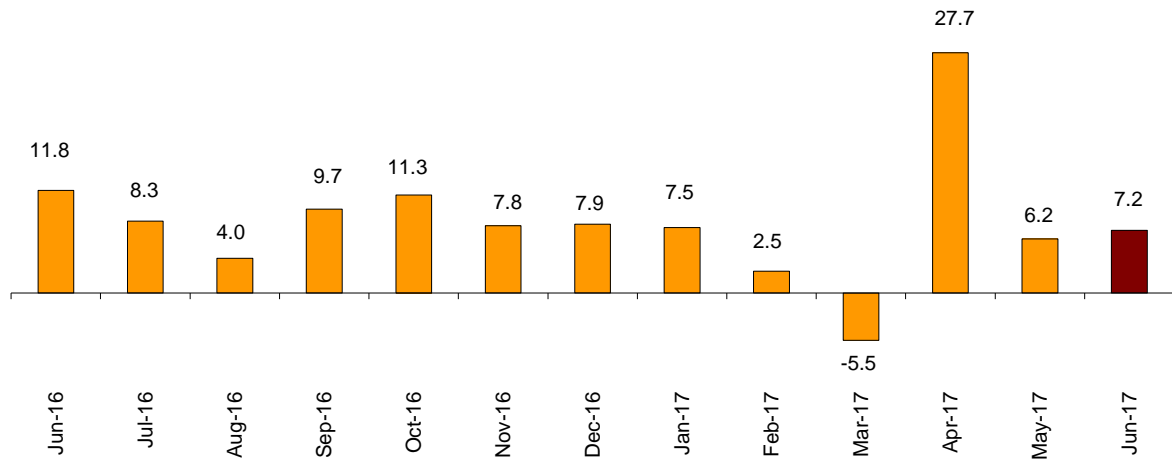
Holiday dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased by 7.2% in June. Resident overnight stays grew by 6.6% and those of non-residents increased by 7.4%.

The average stay decreased 5.5% as compared with June 2016, standing at 5.6 overnight stays per traveller.

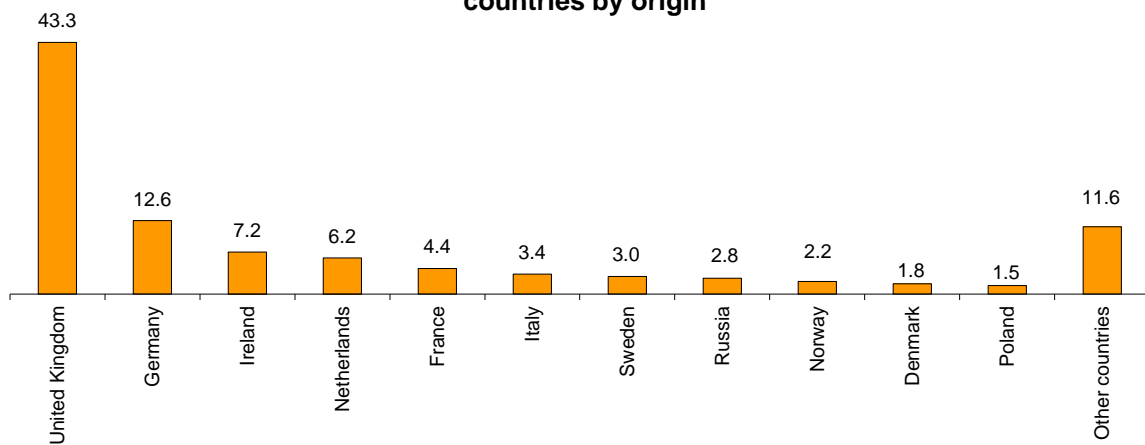
In June, 40.7% of the bedplaces available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 3.2% less than in the same month of 2016. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 43.7%, with a decrease of 3.8%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 74.3% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with more than 2.4 million overnight stays, that is, 8.1% more than in June 2016. The following country of origin was Germany, with 718,965 overnight stays, 1.7% less.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with 2.4 million overnight stays and an increase of 6.1% as compared with June 2016. Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 82.6% of holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 962,244 overnight stays. This island also registered the highest occupancy rate, with 86.7% of the holiday dwellings offered.

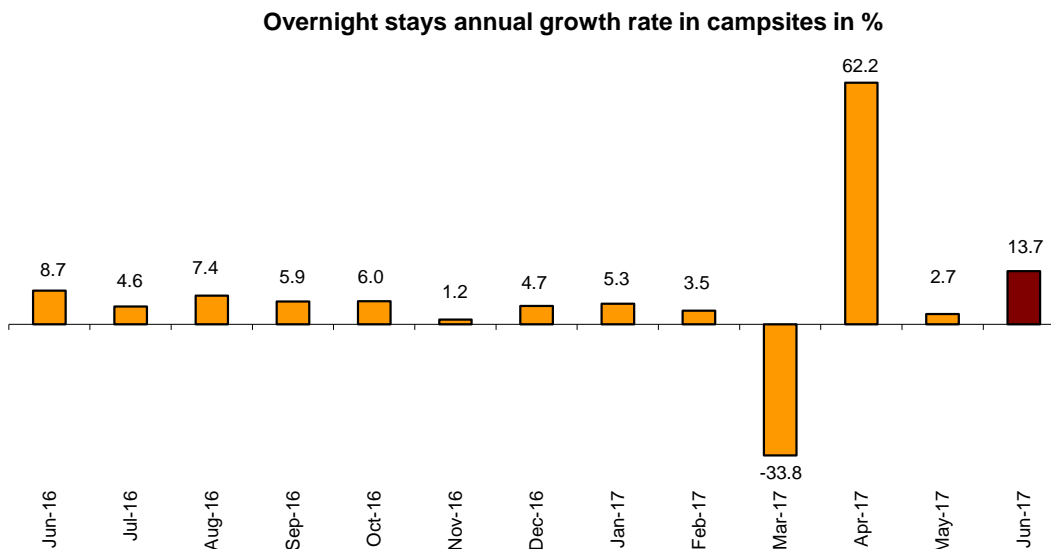
The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in June were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.

Tourist campsites

Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an increase of 13.7% in June as compared to the same month of the previous year. Resident overnight stays grew by 14.4% and non-residents by 12.8%.

During the month of June, 37.5% of the offered pitches were occupied, 5.5% more than in the same month of 2016. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 41.3%, with an annual increase of 4.2%.

44.7% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents travellers. The Netherlands was the main country of origin, with 24.1% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 11.1% more than in June 2016.



Cataluña was the preferred destination regarding tourist campsites, with more than two million overnight stays, which is an increase of 15.5% in the annual rate. La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate, with 67.2% of the pitches offered.

By tourist area, the Costa Brava was the preferred destination, with 938,222 overnight stays. The Costa Blanca reached the highest occupancy rate, with 62.8% of pitches offered.

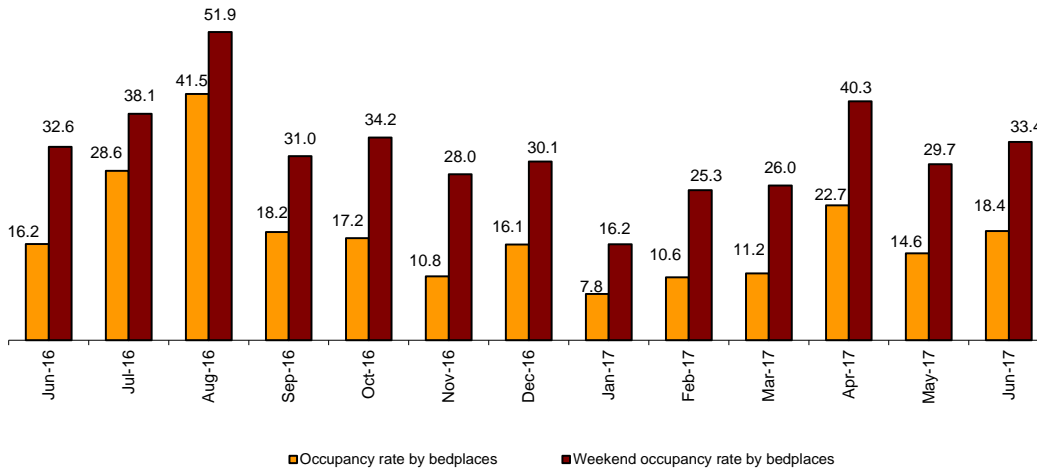
The tourist sites with more overnight stays were Torroella De Montgrí, Benidorm and Mont-Roig del Camp.

Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 20.3% in June. Resident overnight stays grew by 14.5% and those of non-residents increased by 32.9%.

In rural tourism accommodation, 18.4% of the bedplaces were occupied, with a 13.7% increase as compared to June 2016. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 33.4%, with an annual increase of 2.6%.

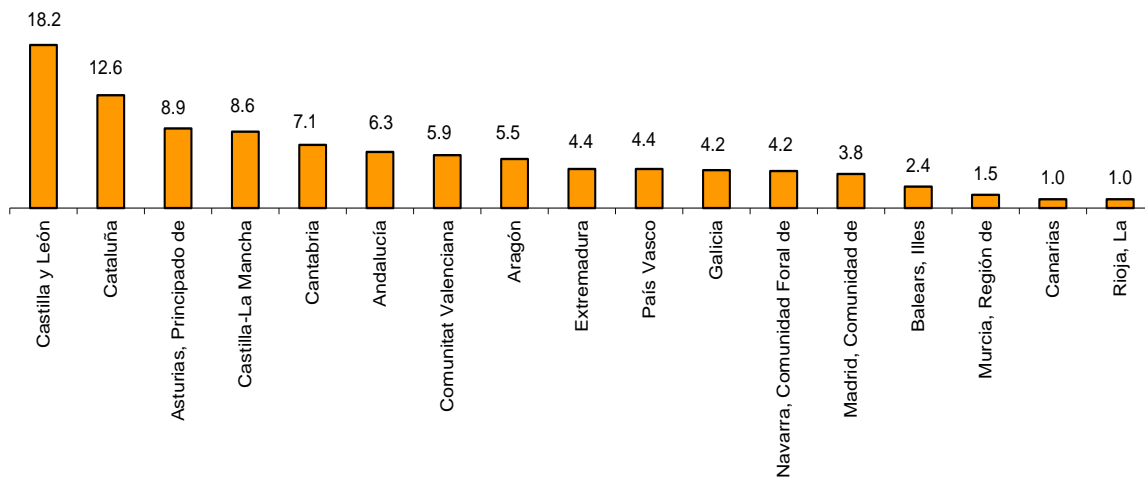
Occupancy rate by bedplaces and bedplaces on weekends in rural tourism accommodation



By Autonomous Community, Illes Balears was the preferred destination, with 144,399 overnight stays, 16.0% more than in June 2016. This community also reached the highest occupancy rate, with 60.6% of the accommodations offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 118,384 overnight stays. The island of Ibiza and Formentera registered the highest occupancy rate, with 68.6% of the bedplaces offered.

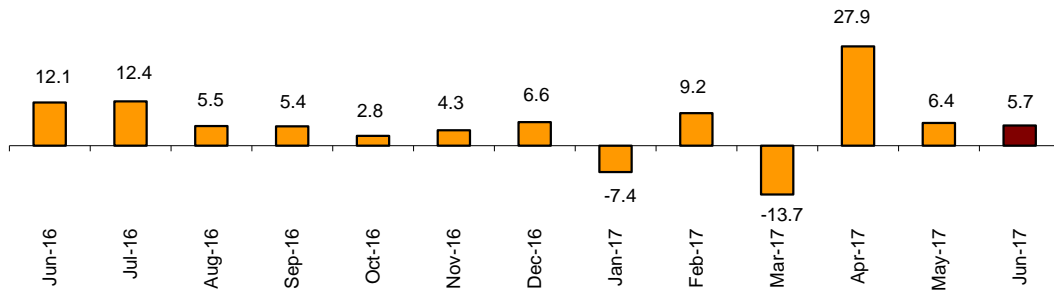
Distribution of overnight stays of traveller residents by autonomous community of destination in rural tourism accommodation in %



Youth Hostels

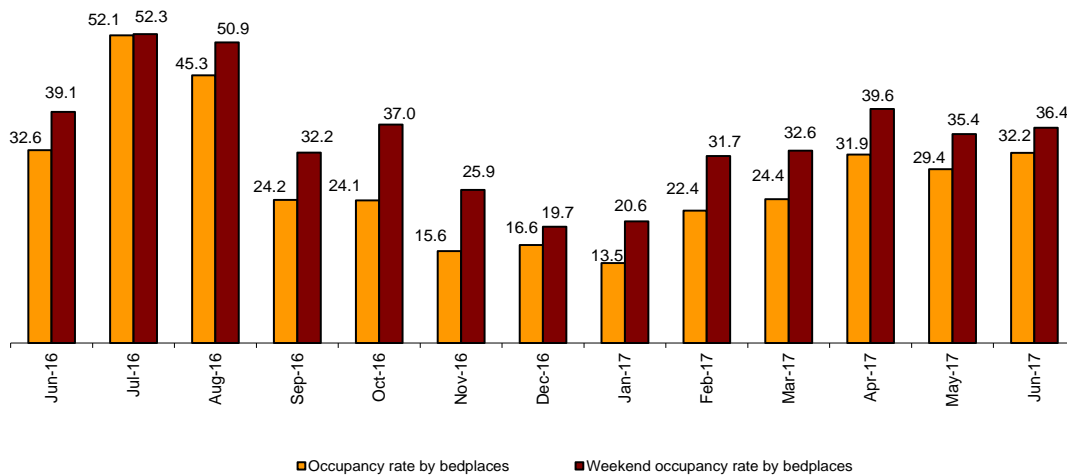
Overnight stays in hostels registered an annual increase of 5.7% in June. Overnight stays by residents increased 9.3%, while those by non-residents decreased 3.1%.

In June, 32.2% of the available bedplaces were occupied, 1.4% less than in June 2016. The weekend occupancy rate reached 36.4%, with a 6.8% decrease.

By Autonomous Community, Cataluña was the preferred destination, with 95,849 overnight stays, 6.3% less than in June 2016. Comunitat Valenciana reached the highest occupancy rate, with 47.1% of the bedplaces offered.

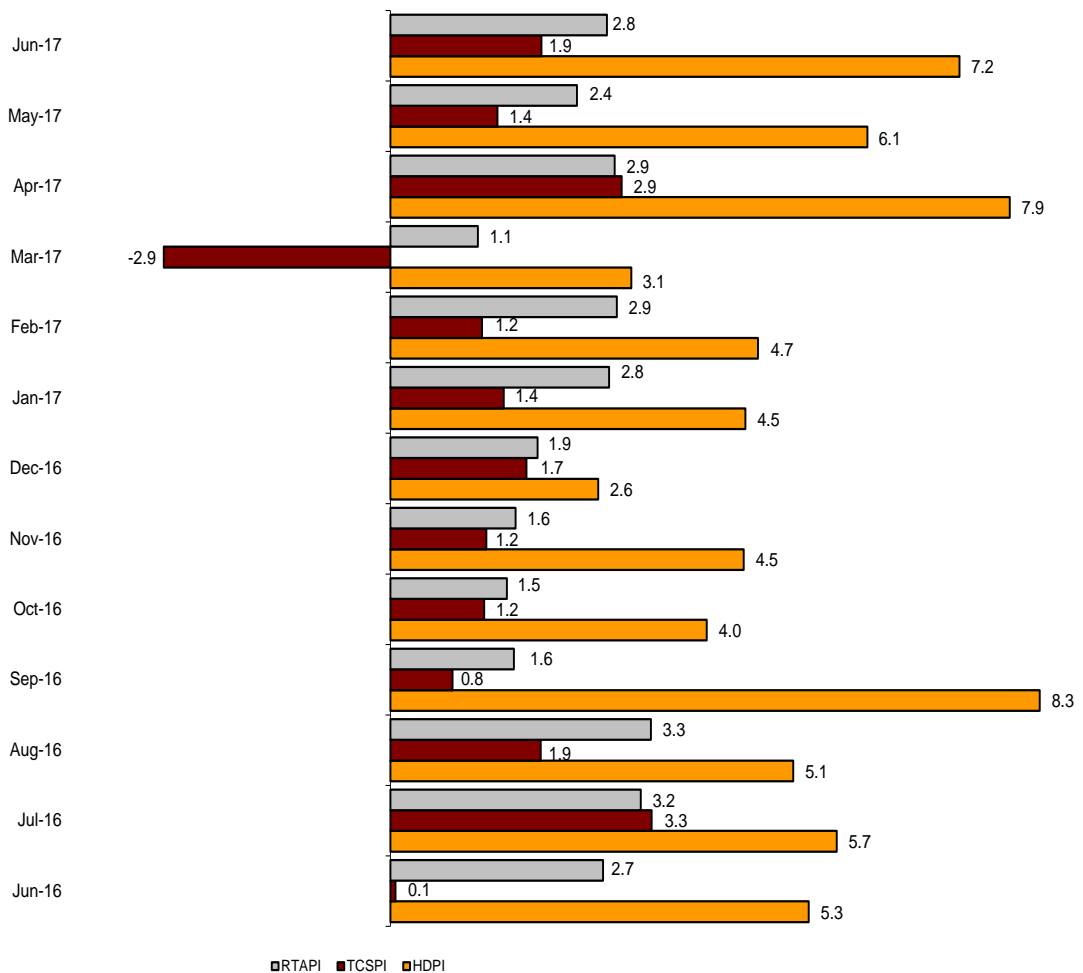
Price indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) increased 7.2%, as compared to June 2016. The rate for *tour operators and travel agencies*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (47.4%), increased by 9.7%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) increased by 1.9% in the annual rate. The *bungalow* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weightings structure in June (42.7%), grew by 2.1% as compared with the same month of 2016.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) registered a 2.8% increase in June. The *weekend rate*, which accounted for 56.6% of the total weight, increased by 2.7% in the annual rate.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In June, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels¹, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) increased by 7.1% in the annual rate. Resident overnight stays grew by 6.5% and non-residents 7.4%.

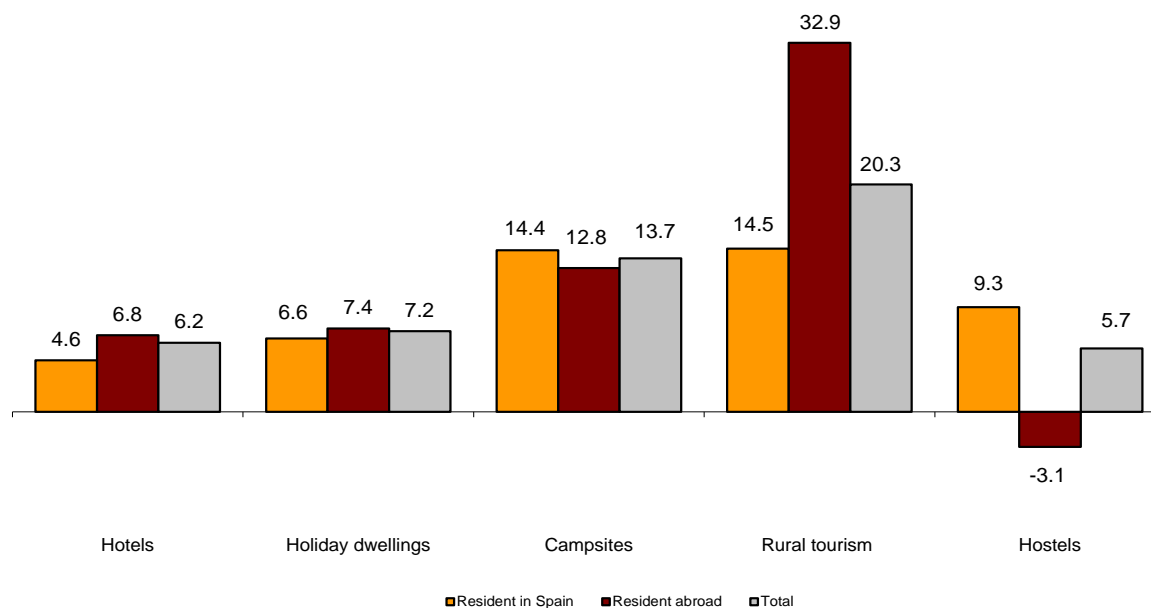
The average stay increased 0.7%, standing at 3.7 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 74% corresponded to hotels and 26% to non-hotel tourist accommodation.

Overnight stays annual growth rate in collective tourist accommodation



The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were The United Kingdom (with 30.0% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (22.1%) and France (6.3%).

Illes Balears was the preferred destination, with over 11.2 million overnight stays (3.1% more than in June 2016). It was followed by Cataluña, with over 9.7 million overnight stays (and an increase of 13.0%) and Canarias, with 8.1 million, (an annual increase of 4.7%).
