Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
July 2011. *Provisional data*

**Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increase 5.3%¹
in July, as compared with the same month of 2010**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 17.3 million in July, 5.3% more than in the same month of 2010. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 4.6%, and those made by non-residents in Spain increased 5.8%.

The average stay decreased 0.6%, as compared with July 2010, and stood at 5.8 nights per traveller.

During the first seven months of the year, overnight stays increased 5.0%, with regard to the same period the previous year.

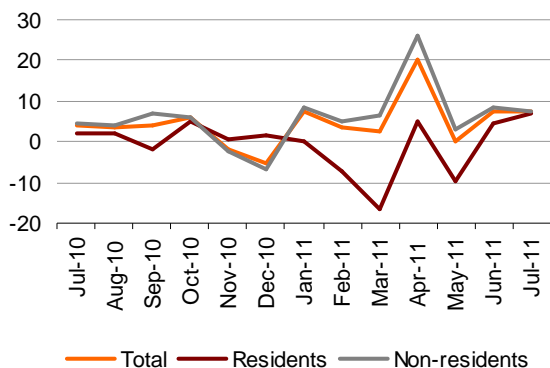

Holiday Dwellings

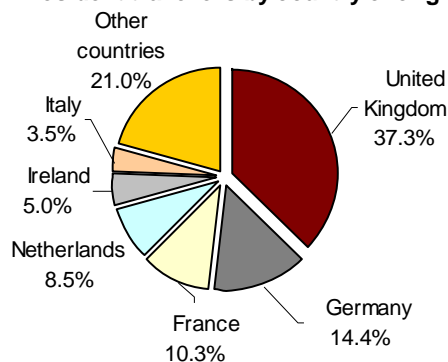
Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 9.1 million in July, representing an increase of 7.4%¹, as compared with the same month the previous year. Overnight stays of residents experienced an increase of 6.9%, and those of non-residents increased 7.6%.

The average stay decreased 3.1%, as compared with July 2010, standing at 7.3 nights per traveller.

¹ Due to the update made in the tourist accommodation directory in Comunidad Foral de Navarra, the data published cannot be directly compared to that published last year. In order to avoid this break in the series, linking coefficients have been calculated, allowing for comparing the data from different years. The coefficients are published monthly on the INE website, in the section dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled linking coefficients.

Holiday dwellings offered 553,193 bedplaces, 0.4% less than in July 2010. This month, 52.7% of the total available bedplaces were occupied, 7.8% more than one year ago. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 54.1%, with an increase of 8.9% in the interannual rate. In turn, 66.4% of the total available holiday dwellings were occupied, for an interannual increase of 9.2%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 67.5% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 2.3 million overnight stays, 16.3% more than in July last year. The following country of origin was Germany, with 893,146 overnight stays, 6.1% less.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.6 million overnight stays, 2.8% more than in July 2010. The second destination of choice was Illes Balears, with 2.2 million overnight stays, 11.3% more.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Illes Balears and Cataluña were the main destinations of choice. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Comunitat Valenciana, Canarias and Andalucía.

Illes Balears showed the highest occupancy rate, with 84.4% of the available holiday dwellings. It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (65.4%) and Canarias (64.6%).

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination in holiday dwellings, with 1.3 million overnight stays, and an occupancy of 87.1% of the dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Alcúdia and Arona.

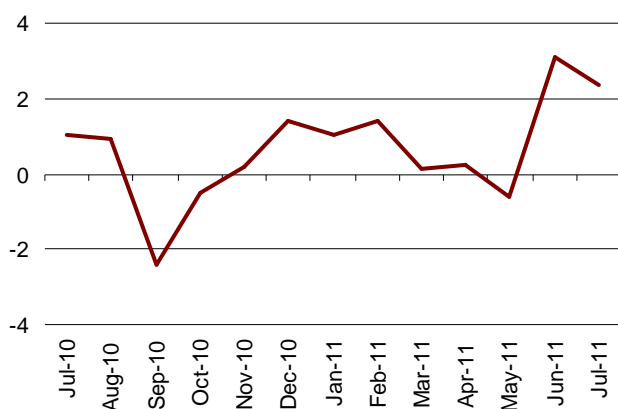
Holiday Dwelling Price Index Evolution

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered an increase of 2.4% in July, a rate 0.8 points lower than that recorded the previous month.

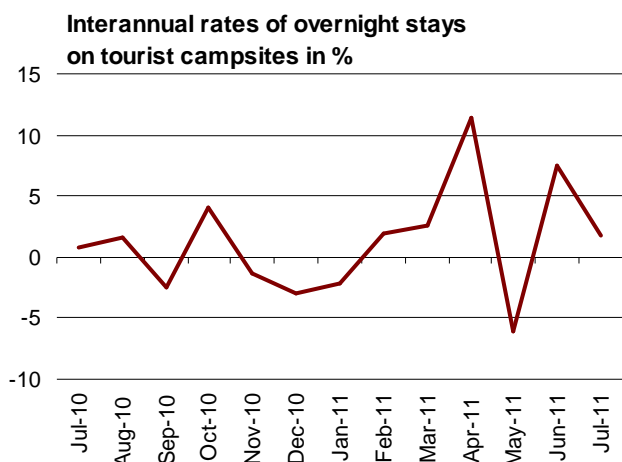
The rate for *Tour-operators and travel agencies*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (49.3%), registered an increase of 3.3%, as compared with the same month the previous year.

By modality, 2/4-bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 59.6%, increased their prices 2.2%.

Tourist Campsites



Tourist campsites exceeded seven million overnight stays in July, indicating an interannual increase of 1.7%. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 2.0%, and those of non-resident travellers increased 1.4%.

Tourist campsites offered 738,984 bedplaces, 1.1% less than in July 2010. 45.0% of the available lots were occupied, 3.2% more. The weekend occupancy rate by lot reached 49.3%, with an interannual increase of 3.2%.

44.7% of the overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. The Netherlands was the main country of origin, with 37.7% of the overnight stays by non-residents (5.9% more than in July 2010). The following country of origin was France.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for camping, with 3.6 million overnight stays, 2.8% more. Comunitat Valenciana was the second destination of choice, with 722,356 overnight stays, indicating an interannual increase of 1.1%.

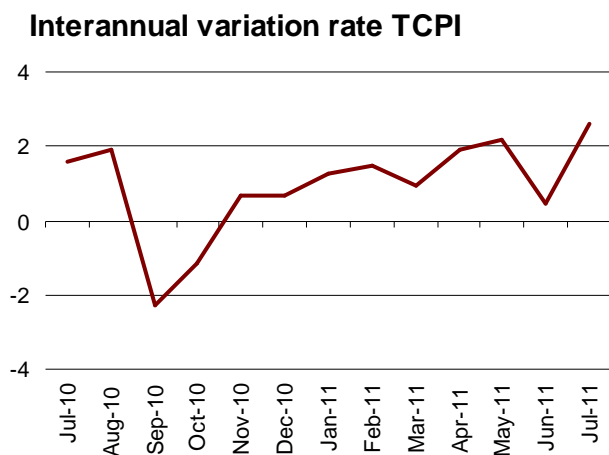
For both residents and non-residents, in the same order, the preferred destinations were Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía.

La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate on campsites, with 69.0% of the available lots occupied. It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (55.1%) and País Vasco (53.1%).

By tourist area, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for camping, with 1.9 million overnight stays. Costa Barcelona-Maresme reached the highest occupancy (67.6%).

The tourist sites with the most overnight stays in July were Torroella de Montgrí, Salou and Sant Pere Pescador.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced an interannual increase of 2.6% in July. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (83.1%), presented an increase of 2.4%.

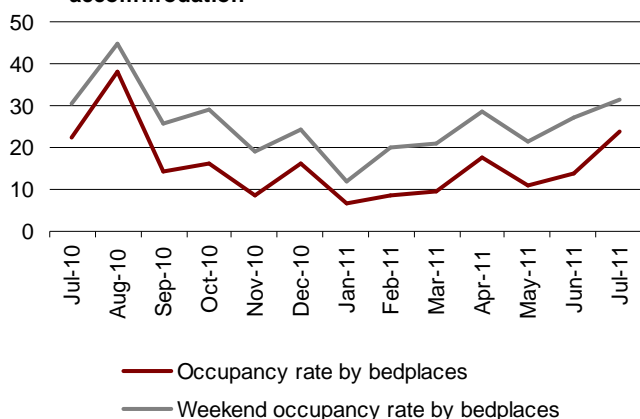
Regarding category, *luxury and first class*, with a weighting of 52.7% this month, registered an interannual increase of 2.9%.

Rural Tourism Accommodation

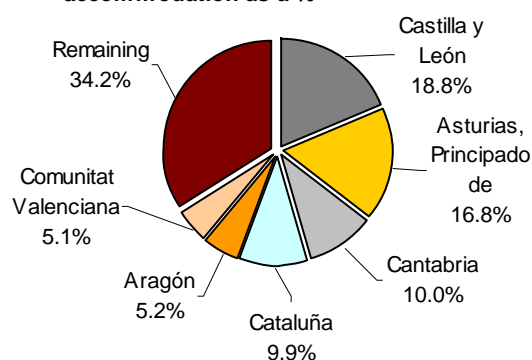
Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation exceeded one million in July, indicating an interannual increase of 12.2%¹. Resident overnight stays increased 8.8%, and those by non-residents grew 24.5%.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 143,921 bedplaces, 5.3% more than in July 2010. 23.8% of these bedplaces were occupied, representing a 6.3% increase. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 31.4%, that is, 3.1% more in the interannual rate.

Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 168,754 overnight stays, 17.3% more than in July 2010. It was followed by Principado de Asturias, with 159,385 overnight stays, 28.6% more.

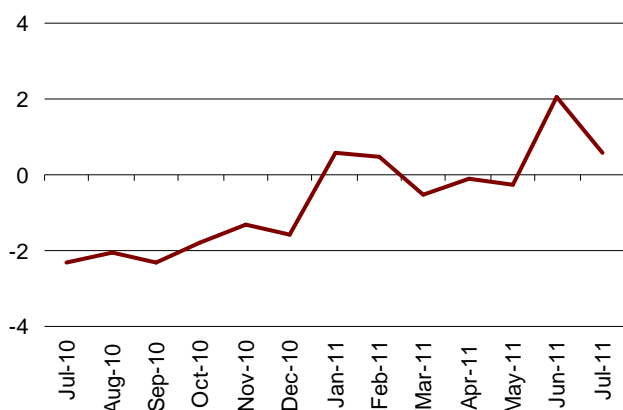
Among non-residents, Illes Balears was the preferred destination. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents were Castilla y León, Principado de Asturias and Cantabria.

Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 61.7% of the available bedplaces. It was followed by Principado de Asturias (39.4%) and Cantabria (37.9%).

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the main destination, with 78,468 overnight stays. Gipuzkoa Coast reached the highest occupancy, with 64.9% of the available bedplaces.

Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index Evolution

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index experienced an interannual increase of 0.6% in July. The *normal* rate, which accounted for 54.3% of the total weight, increased 0.3%. By rent modality, *complete use*, whose weighting was 59.5%, increased 0.7%.

By Autonomous Community, Illes Balears, Castilla y León and Cataluña, which accounted for 43.2% of the total weight in the month of July, registered interannual rates of 1.3%, -0.1% and 5.0%, respectively.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered an **interannual increase of 7.8%¹ in July**. Overnight stays by residents increased 2.4%, and non-resident stays increased 11.6%.

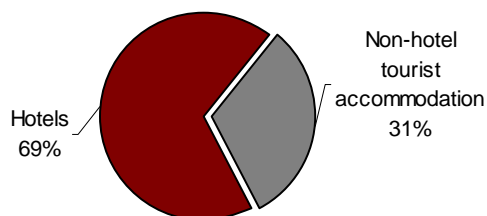
In July, the average stay increased 0.8%, standing at 4.2 nights per traveller.

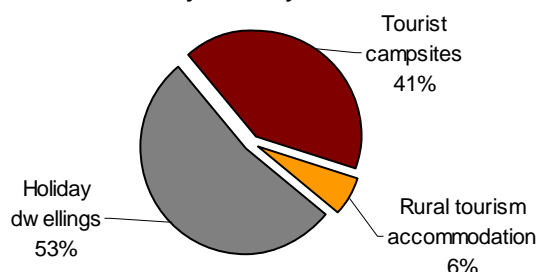

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of July, 69% were accounted for at hotels, and 31% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 24.5% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (21.0%) and France (9.0%).

Illes Balears was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 12.6 million overnight stays (11.8% more than in July 2010). It was followed by Cataluña, with 12.4 million overnight stays (6.7% more) and Canarias, with more than 8.4 million overnight stays (15.1% more).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Illes Balears, Cataluña and Canarias. In turn, Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
