Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
July 2013. *Provisional data*

**Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation decreased
1.4% in July⁽¹⁾, as compared with the same month of 2012**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) exceeded 16.9 millions in July, 1.4% less than in the same month of 2012. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 5.3%, whereas those of non-residents increased 1.4%. The average stay decreased 0.7%, standing at 6.0 overnights per traveller.

During the first seven months of 2013, the overnight stays increased 1.3%, as compared with the same month of the previous year.



Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased 0.8% in July. Overnight stays of residents decreased 4.0% whereas overnight stays of non-residents increased 2.9%.

The average stay decreased 1.1%, as compared with July 2012, standing at 7.2 overnight stays per traveller.

Overnight stays annual growth rate in holiday dwellings in %




⁽¹⁾ Due to the update made in the rural tourist accommodation directory in Región de Murcia, the data published cannot be directly compared to those published last year. In order to avoid this break in the series, linking coefficients have been calculated, allowing for comparing the data from different years. The coefficients are published monthly on the INE website, in the section dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled linking coefficient

In July, 50.3% of the bedplaces available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 2.1% less than in the same month of 2012. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 53.4%, with an annual decrease of 2.4%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 71.1% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with over 2.2 million overnight stays, 0.8% more than in July 2012. The following country of origin was Germany, with over one million overnight stays, 8.5% more.

Canarias and Illes Balears were the preferred holiday dwelling destinations, with annual rates of overnight stays of -1.3% and 2.8%, respectively. Illes Balears registered the highest occupancy rate with 83.4% of the dwellings offered.

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with more than 1.2 million overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 87.1%.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.

Campsites

The overnight stays in tourist campsites registered a 3.4% annual decrease in July. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 5.8%, whereas those of non-resident travellers did so by 0.9%.

43.4% of the offered pitches were occupied, 0.7% more. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 47.5%, with an annual decrease of 1.9%.


48.9% of the overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. The Netherlands was the main country of origin, with 41.6% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 0.9% more than in July 2012.

Cataluña was the preferred destination regarding campsites, with over 3.7 million overnight stays, 3.3% less. La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate on campsites, with 65.0% of the pitches offered.

By tourist area, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for camping, with more than 2 million overnight stays. Parque Natural de Aiguamolls de L'Empordá reached the highest occupancy, with 57.9% of the pitches offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Torroella de Montgrí, Mont-Roig del Camp and Salou.

Overnight stays annual growth rate in campsites in %




Rural Tourism Accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual decrease of 7.2%, in July⁽¹⁾. Residents' overnight stays decreased 8.2%, whilst those of non-residents did so by 4.8%.

20.0% of the bedplaces in rural tourism accommodation were occupied, representing a 6.9% annual decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 30.8%, with an increase of 0.1%.


Occupancy rate by bedplaces and bedplaces on weekends



By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 133,320 overnight stays, 13.4% less than in July 2012. Illes Balears is the Autonomous Community that reached the highest occupancy rate, with 63.9% of the offered bedplaces.

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the main destination, with 86,422 overnight stays. The islands of Ibiza and Formentera reached the highest occupancy rate with 71.9% of the offered bedplaces.

Distribution of overnight stays of traveller residents by autonomous community of destination in %




Price Indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) registered an annual increase of 0.6%. The tour operators and travel agencies rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (50.6%), increased 2.1%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) registered an increase of 1.8% in the annual rate. The normal rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for July (83.7%), increased 1.5%.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) registered a 1.1 % decrease in July. The normal rate, which accounted for 54.9% of the total weight, decreased 0.3%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered a 0.1% decrease in July ⁽¹⁾, as compared with the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays of residents decreased 2.8%, whereas those of non-residents increased 1.4%.


The average stay stood the same than in July 2012, standing at 4.4 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of July, 69% were accounted for hotels, and 31% did so for non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 26.1% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (20.3%) and The Netherlands (8.6%).

Illes Balears was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with over 12.6 million overnight stays (1.0% less than in July 2012). Followed by Cataluña, with over 12.4 million overnight stays (1.5% less) and Canarias, with over eight million overnight stays (0.3% more).
