**Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey**  
July 2014. *Provisional data*

**Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation decrease 1.8%  
in July as compared with the same month of 2013**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) exceeded 16.7 millions in July, that is, 1.8% less than in the same month of 2013. Overnight stays of resident travellers increased by 0.7% while those of non-residents decreased by 3.5%. The average stay stood at 5.8 overnights per traveller.

During the first seven months of 2014, overnight stays increased by 3.5% as compared with the same period of the previous year.

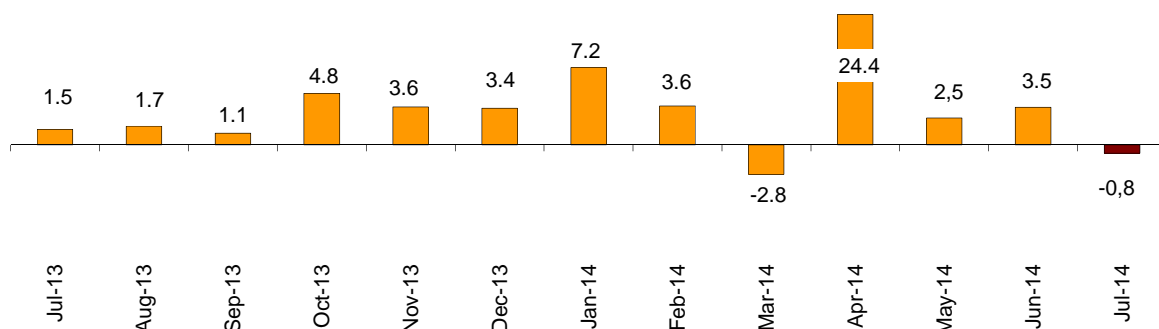

**Holiday Dwellings**

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decreased 0.8% in July. Those of residents decreased by 2.7%, whereas overnight stays of non-residents remained the same. The average stay decreased by 1.4%, standing at 7.0 overnight stays per traveller.

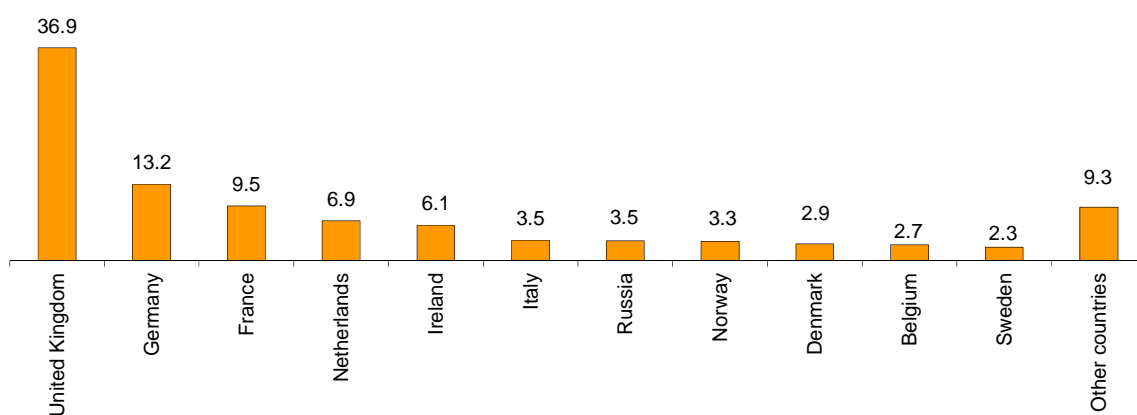
**Overnight stays annual growth rate in holiday dwellings in %**



In July, 49.8% of the bedplaces available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 1.2% less than in the same month of 2013. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 52.1%, with a decrease of 2.5%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 71.0% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with more than 2.3 million overnight stays, 3.5% more than in July 2013. The following country of origin was Germany, with 856,457 overnight stays, 13.4% less.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.6 million overnight stays, 0.7% more than in July 2013. Illes Balears registered the highest occupancy rate with 81.7% of the dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with more than 1.1 million overnight stays. The islands of Ibiza and Formentera reached the highest occupancy rate, with 84.7% of the dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in July were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.

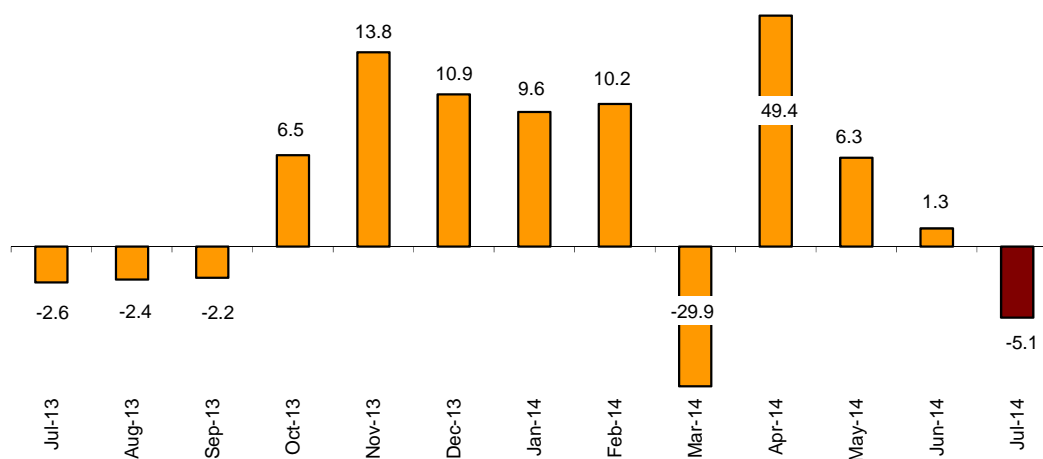
## Campsites

The overnight stays in tourist campsites registered an annual decrease of 5.1% in July. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased by 0.9%, while those of non-resident travellers decreased by 11.3%.

In July, 42.4% of the offered pitches were occupied, that is, a 3.2% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 45.8%, with an annual decrease of 4.1%.

45.5% of the overnight stays in tourist campsites were by non-residents. The Netherlands was the main country of origin, with 36.9% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 21.8% less than in July 2013.

Cataluña was the preferred destination regarding campsites, with over 3.5 million overnight stays, 7.3% less than in July 2013.

La Rioja was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate on campsites, with 60.2% of the pitches offered.

By tourist areas, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for camping, with more than 1.8 million overnight stays. The Parque Natural Aiguamolls de l'Empordà reached the highest occupancy rate, with 57.8% of the pitches offered.

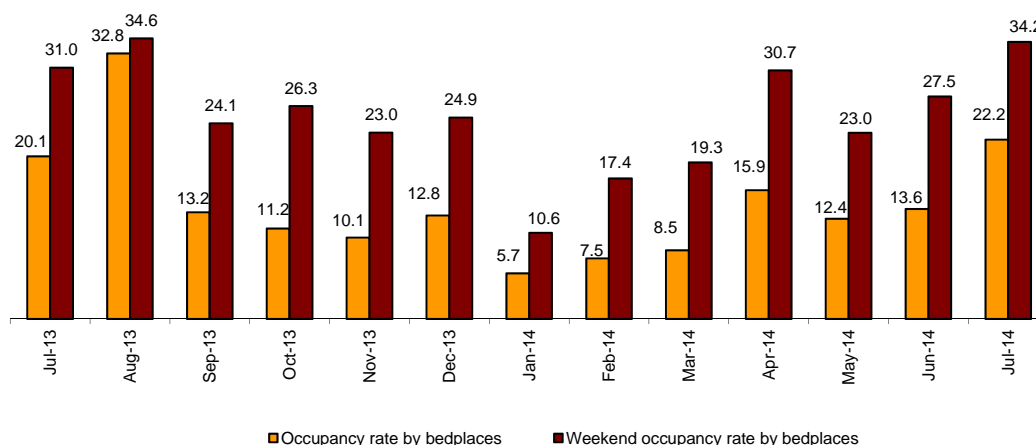
The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Mont-Roig del Camp, Torroella de Montgrí and Castelló D'Empúries.

### Rural Tourism Accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 12.1% in July. Residents' overnight stays increased by 13.9% while those of non-residents did so by 8.1%.

Regarding the rural tourism accommodation, 22.2% of the bedplaces were occupied, that is, a 10.5% increase as compared to July 2013. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 34.2%, with an increase of 10.3%.

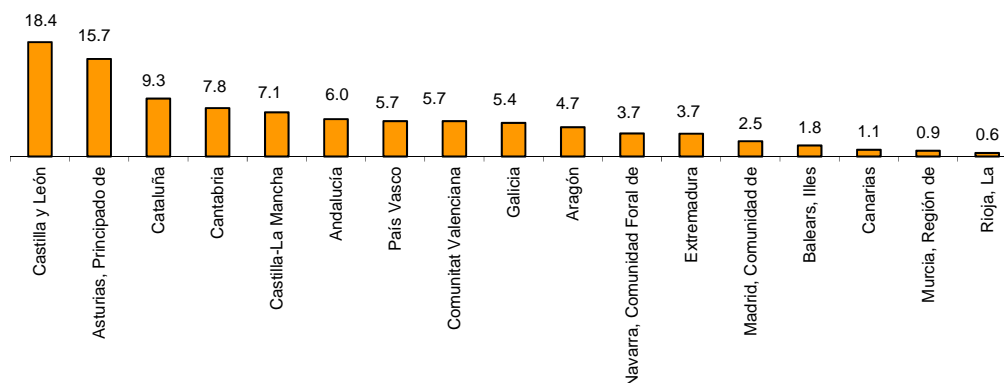
Occupancy rate by bedplaces and bedplaces on weekends



By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 150,912 overnight stays, 11.0% more than in July 2013. Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 63.1% of the bedplaces offered.

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the main destination, with 89,501 overnight stays. The islands of Ibiza and Formentera reached the greatest occupancy rates, with 69.8% of the bedplaces offered.

Distribution of overnight stays of traveller residents by autonomous community of destination in %



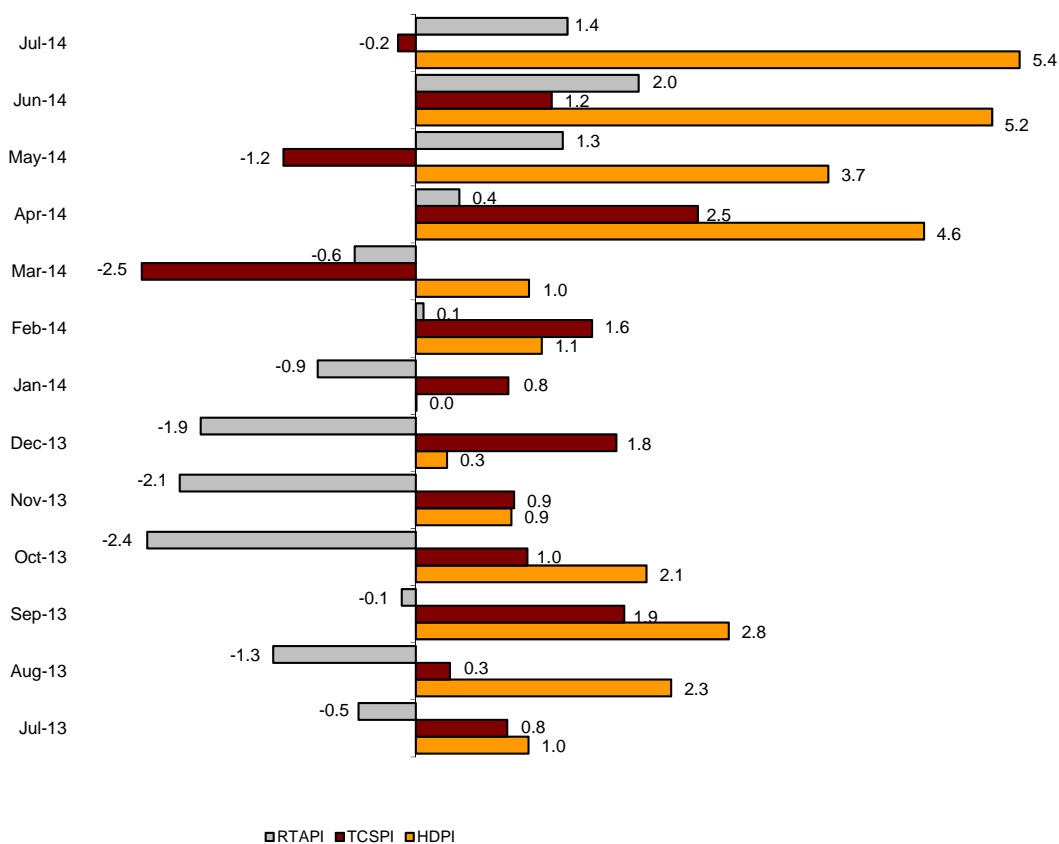
**Price Indices**

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) increased 5.4%, as compared to July 2013. The *tour operators and travel agencies* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (50.0%), increased by 6.3%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) decreased 0.2% in the annual rate. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for July (83.8%), decreased by 0.6%.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) registered a 1.4% increase in July. The *normal* rate, which accounted for 56.4% of the total weight, increased 1.6%.

## Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

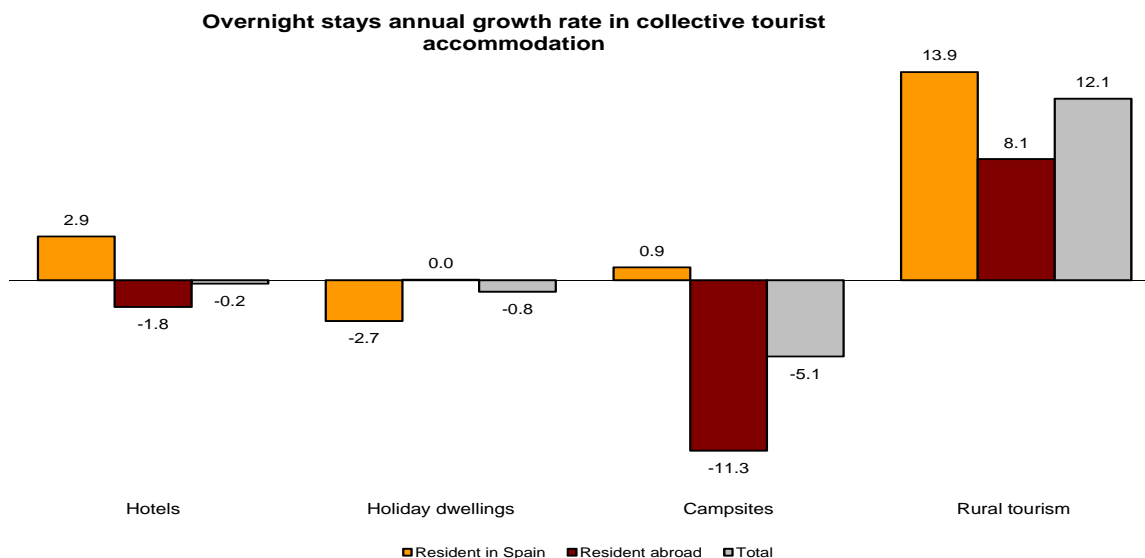
In June, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels<sup>1</sup>, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered a 0.7% decrease in its annual rate. Overnight stays of residents increased 2.1%, while of non-residents decreased by 2.3%.

The average stay decreased 2.7% as compared to the same month of the previous year, standing at 4.3 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 69% accounted for hotels, and 31% did so for non-hotel tourist accommodation.



The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 26.1% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (18.9%) and France (9.0%).

Cataluña was the preferred destination, with more than 12.1 million overnight stays (3.9% less than that registered in July 2013), followed by Illes Balears, with over 11.9 million overnight stays (5.2% less), and Canarias, with over 8.5 million overnight stays (5.3% more).
