Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
July 2015. *Provisional data*

**Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increase 7.1%
in July as compared to the same month of 2014**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) exceeded 18.5 million in July, that is, 7.1% more than in the same month of 2014. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased by 8.7% and those of non-residents did so by 5.9%.

The average stay stood at 5.7 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first seven months of 2015, overnight stays increased by 4.0% as compared with the same period of the previous year.

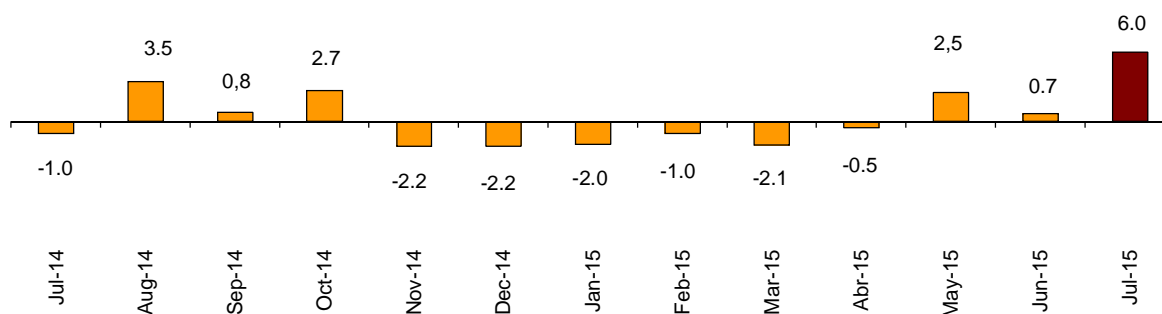
Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased 6.0% in July. Those of residents increased by 9.3% and those of non-residents by 4.6%.

The average stay decreased 1.4% as compared with July 2014, and stood at 6.9 overnight stays per traveller.

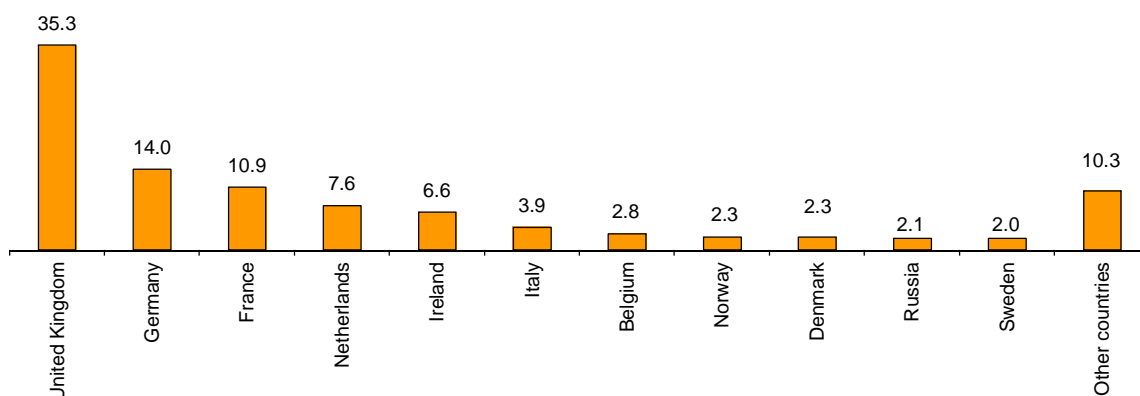
In July, 53.3% of the bedplaces available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 6.2% more than in the same month of 2014. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 54.6%, with an increase of 4.0%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 69.1% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with more than 2.3 million overnight stays, that is, 0.8% more than in July 2014. The following country of origin was Germany, with 932.242 overnight stays, that is, 8.4% more.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.6 million overnight stays, 1.0% less than in July 2014. Illes Balears registered the highest occupancy rate, with 86.0% of the holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 1.1 million overnight stays. The island of Menorca registered the highest occupancy rate, with 90.2% of the holiday dwellings offered.

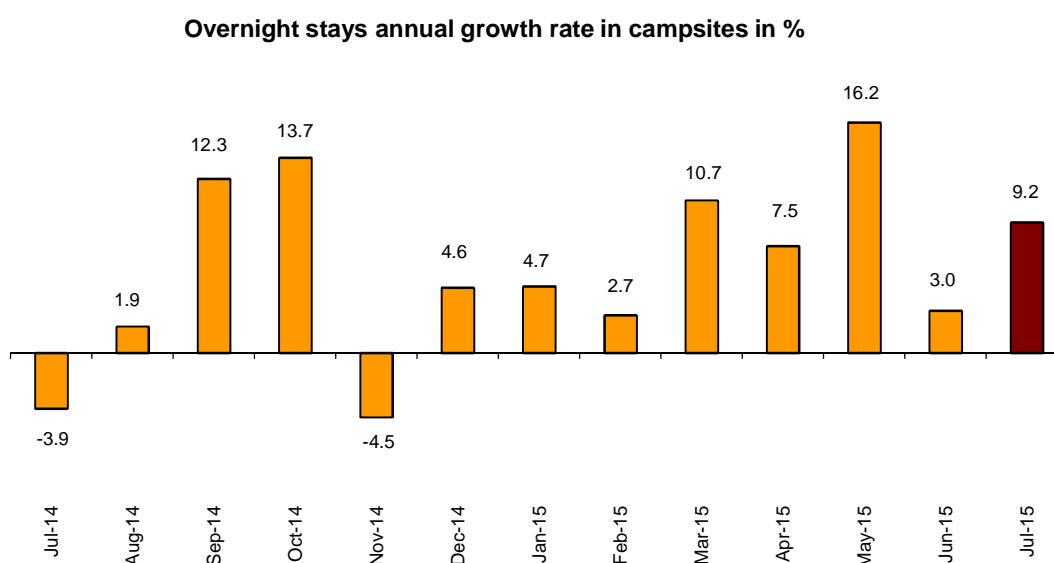
The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in July were San Bartolomé, Tirajana, Arona and Tías.

Tourist campsites

Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an annual increase of 9.2% in July as compared to the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased by 9.8% and those of non-resident travellers did so by 8.5%.

In July, 45.0% of the offered pitches were occupied, that is, 5.5% more. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 48.2%, with a 4.2% annual increase.

45.7% of the overnight stays at tourist campsites were by non-residents. The Netherlands was the main country of origin, with 36.6% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 9.2% more than in July 2014.



Cataluña was the preferred destination regarding tourist campsites, with more than 3.8 million overnight stays, 8.5% more than in July 2014.

La Rioja was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate on tourist campsites, with 61.9% of the pitches offered.

By tourist areas, Costa Brava was the preferred destination, with 1.9 million overnight stays. Costa Blanca reached the highest occupancy rate with 60.0% of the pitches offered.

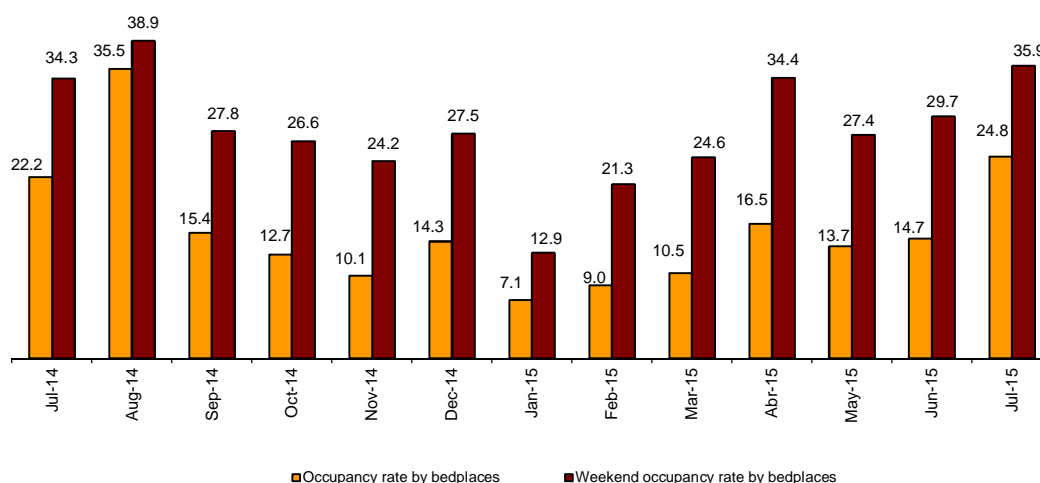
The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Torroella de Montgrí, Mont-Roig Del Camp and Castelló D'Empúries.

Rural Tourism Accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 11.6% in July. Residents' overnight stays increased by 12.2% and those of non-residents did so by 10.3%.

Regarding rural tourism accommodation, 24.8% of the bedplaces were occupied, that is, an 11.4% increase as compared to July 2014. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 35.9%, with a 4.5% increase.

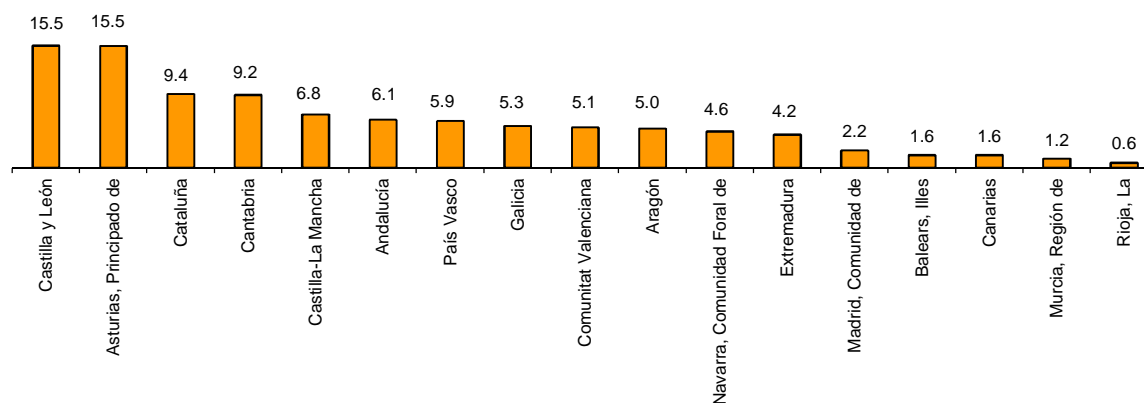
Occupancy rate by bedplaces and bedplaces on weekends



By Autonomous Community, Cataluña was the preferred destination, with 153,445 overnight stays, 9.6% more than in July 2014. Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 64.4% of the bedplaces offered.

By tourist area, Mallorca Island was the main destination, with 101,533 overnight stays. The island of Menorca reached the highest occupancy rate of 67.5% of the bedplaces offered.

Youth Hostels

Overnight stays in hostels registered an annual decrease of 12.5% in July. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased by 15.6% and those of non-resident travellers increased by 2.3%.

In July, 45.4% of the offered bedplaces were occupied, that is, 10.5% less than in the same month of 2014. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces reached 50.1%, with a 9.4% decrease.

By Autonomous Community, Cataluña was the preferred destination, with 132,317 overnight stays, 9.7% less than in July 2014. País Vasco reached the highest occupancy rate with 63.9% of bedplaces offered.

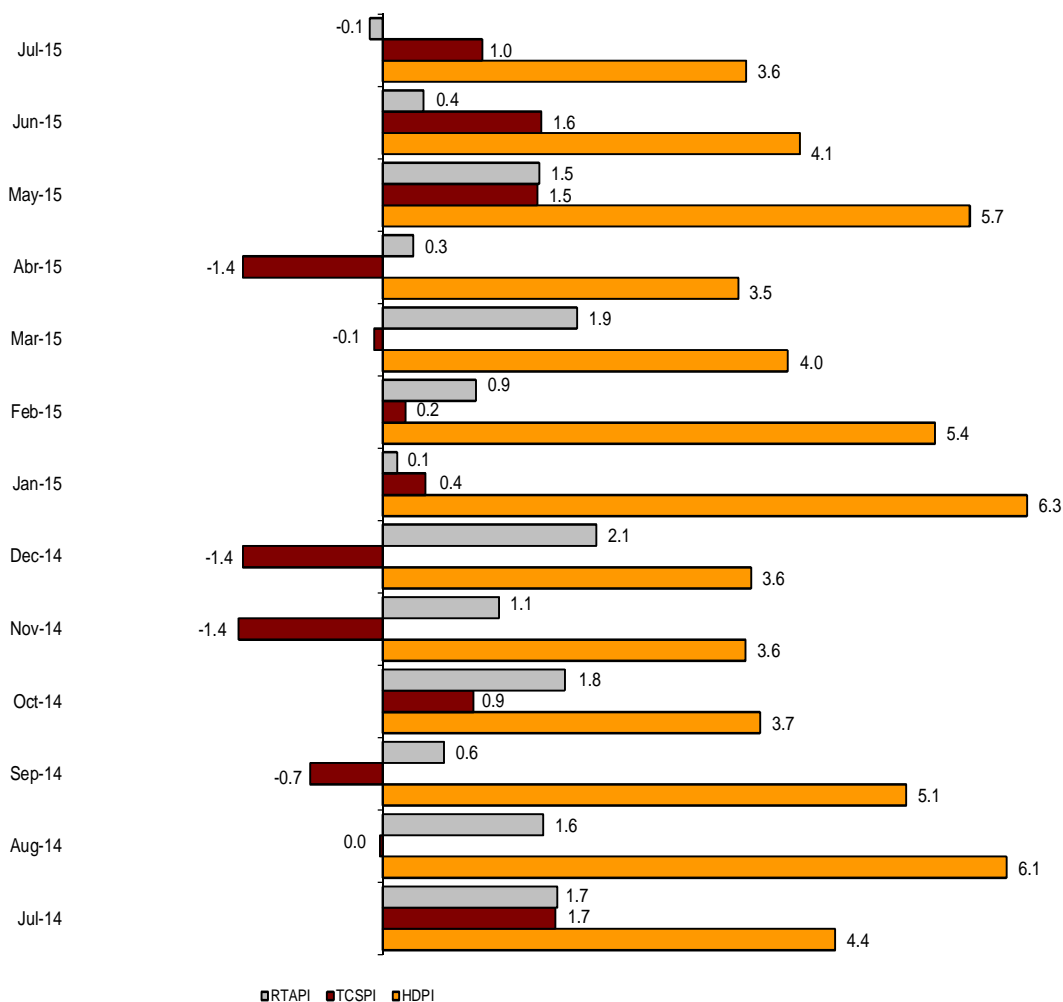
Price Indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) increased 3.6%, as compared to July 2014. The *normal* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (49.8%), increased by 2.5%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) increased by 1.0% in the annual rate. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for July (45.6%), increased by 1.5% as compared with the same month of 2014.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) registered a 0.1% decrease in July. The *normal* rate, which accounted for 55.6% of the total weight, decreased by 0.3% in the annual rate.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

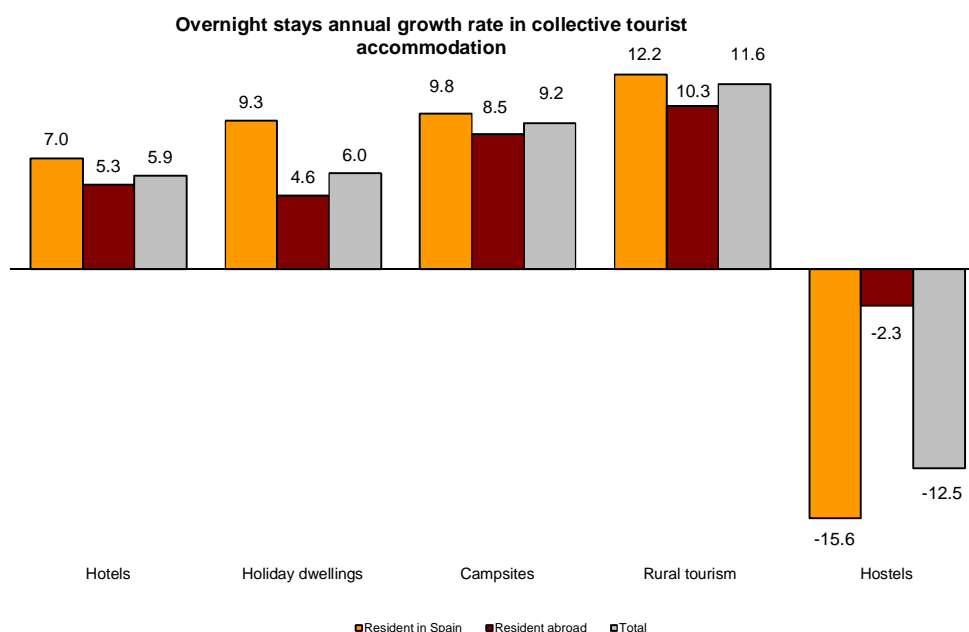
In July, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels¹, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) registered a 6.3% increase in the annual rate. Overnight stays by residents increased by 7.6%, while those of non-residents decreased by 5.5%.

The average stay decreased 1.1%, standing at 4.2 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 68% accounted for hotels, and 32% did so for non-hotel tourist accommodation.



The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 26.6% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (19.2%) and France (10.2%).

Cataluña was the preferred destination, with 12.9 million overnight stays (5.0% more than in July 2014), followed by Illes Balears, with more than 12.4 million overnight stays (and an annual increase of 4.1%), and Canarias, with 8.6 million (and a 2.0% increase).
