Encuestas de ocupación en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros Agosto 2011. *Datos provisionales*

Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros aumentan un 4,3%¹ en agosto respecto al mismo mes de 2010

Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros (apartamentos, campings y alojamientos de turismo rural) superan los 22,4 millones en agosto, un 4,3% más que en el mismo mes de 2010. Las pernoctaciones de residentes suben un 1,6% y las de no residentes un 7,4%. La estancia media crece un 0,6% respecto a agosto de 2010, situándose en 6,4 pernoctaciones por viajero.

En el periodo agregado de julio y agosto, las pernoctaciones aumentan un 4,7% respecto al mismo bimestre de 2010. Las de residentes crecen un 2,7% y las de no residentes un 6,6%. En los ocho primeros meses del año, las pernoctaciones aumentan un 4,8% respecto al mismo periodo del año anterior.

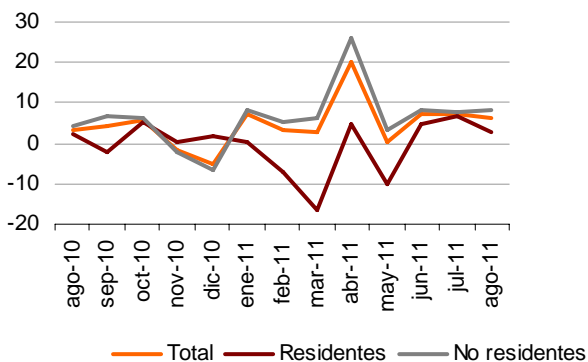

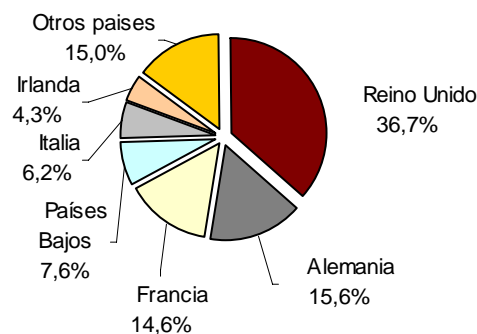
Apartamentos Turísticos

Las pernoctaciones en apartamentos turísticos superan los 10,9 millones en agosto, con un aumento interanual del 6,0%¹. Las de residentes crecen un 2,9% y las de no residentes un 8,1%. La estancia media baja un 2,8%, situándose en 8,0 pernoctaciones por viajero.

¹ Debido a la actualización en el directorio de alojamientos turísticos en la Comunidad Foral de Navarra, los datos publicados no son directamente comparables con los publicados el año pasado. Para salvar esta ruptura en las series se han calculado coeficientes de enlace que permiten comparar los datos entre distintos años. Los coeficientes se publican cada mes en la página web del INE, en la sección dedicada a esta operación estadística, en un apartado específico denominado coeficientes de enlace.

En el conjunto de julio y agosto las pernoctaciones aumentan un 6,6%, respecto al mismo bimestre de 2010.

Los apartamentos turísticos ofrecen 569.396 plazas, un 0,7% más que en agosto de 2010. Este mes se ocupan el 61,1% del total de plazas ofertadas, un 5,3% más. El grado de ocupación por plazas en fin de semana se sitúa en el 63,6%, con un aumento del 5,6% en tasa interanual. Por su parte, del total de apartamentos turísticos ofertados se ocupan el 74,8%, lo que supone un 7,1% más.

Las pernoctaciones de no residentes en apartamentos suponen el 62,0% del total. Reino Unido es el principal mercado emisor, con 2,4 millones de pernoctaciones, un 12,0% más que en agosto del año pasado. El siguiente mercado emisor es Alemania, con un millón de pernoctaciones, un 6,0% más.

Canarias es el destino preferido en apartamentos, con más de 3,2 millones de pernoctaciones, un 4,5% más que en agosto de 2010. El segundo destino es Illes Balears, con 2,3 millones de pernoctaciones, un 2,5% más.

Entre los no residentes, los destinos preferidos son Canarias, Illes Balears y Cataluña. Por su parte, los destinos con más pernoctaciones de viajeros residentes son Comunitat Valenciana, Canarias y Cataluña.

Illes Balears presenta el mayor grado de ocupación, con el 88,3% de los apartamentos ofertados. Le siguen Cataluña (74,9%) y Canarias (74,6%).

Por zonas turísticas, la isla de Mallorca es el destino preferido en apartamentos con 1,2 millones de pernoctaciones y una ocupación del 89,1% de los apartamentos ofertados.

Los puntos turísticos con mayor número de pernoctaciones son San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Tías y Arona.

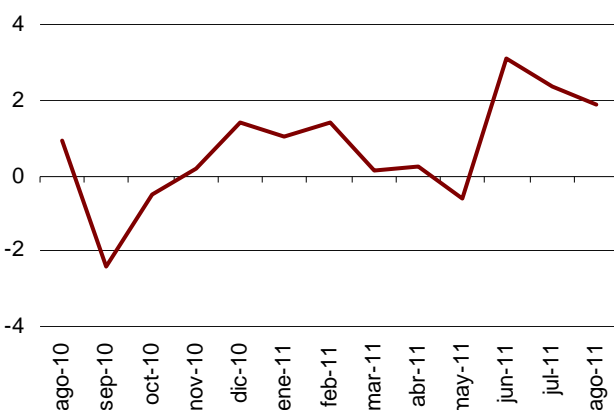
Evolución del Índice de Precios en Apartamentos Turísticos

El Índice de Precios en Apartamentos Turísticos registra una subida del 1,9% en agosto, tasa inferior en 0,5 puntos a la del mes precedente.

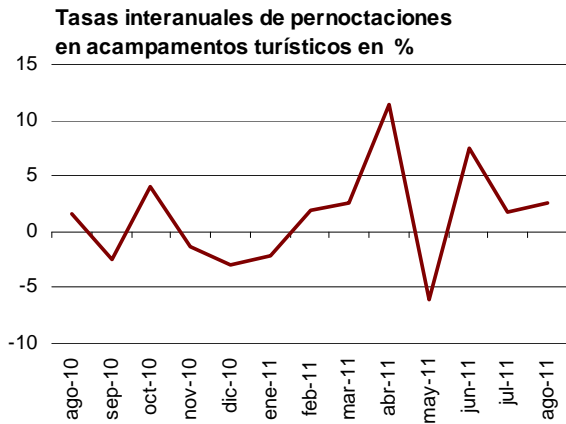
La tarifa *Normal*, que tiene el mayor peso en la estructura de ponderaciones este mes (48,3%), registra un aumento del 1,4% respecto al mismo mes del año anterior.

Por modalidades, los apartamentos de 2/4 plazas, cuya ponderación es del 59,2%, aumentan sus precios un 2,2%.

Acampamentos Turísticos



Los acampamentos turísticos superan los 9,7 millones de pernoctaciones en el mes de agosto, lo que supone un aumento interanual del 2,6%. Las pernoctaciones de viajeros residentes suben un 1,1% y las de no residentes un 5,4%. En el periodo **julio-agosto** las pernoctaciones aumentan un 2,3%.

Los acampamentos turísticos ofrecen 742.631 plazas, un 1,1% menos que en agosto de 2010. Se ocupan el 52,6% de las parcelas ofertadas, un 0,3% menos. El grado de ocupación por parcelas en fin de semana alcanza el 57,3%, con un aumento del 1,0%.

El 37,1% de las pernoctaciones en acampamentos turísticos las realizan no residentes. Francia es el principal mercado emisor, con el 33,4% de las pernoctaciones de no residentes (un 10,4% más que en agosto de 2010). El siguiente mercado emisor es el holandés.

Cataluña es el destino preferido en acampamentos, con 4,9 millones de pernoctaciones, un 6,2% más. Comunitat Valenciana es el segundo destino elegido, con 995.651 pernoctaciones, lo que supone un descenso interanual del 1,5%.

Entre los residentes, los destinos preferidos son Cataluña, Andalucía y Comunitat Valenciana. Por su parte, los destinos con más pernoctaciones de viajeros no residentes son Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana y Andalucía.

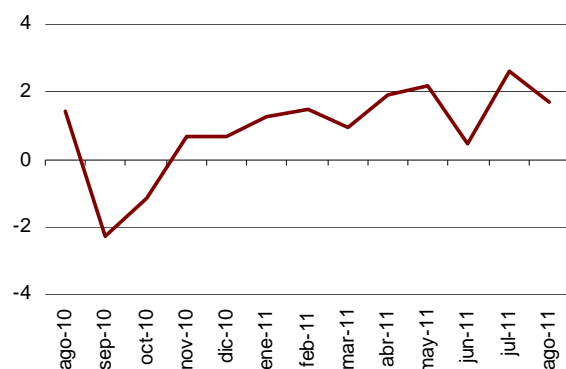
La Rioja alcanza el mayor grado de ocupación en acampamentos, con el 75,1% de las parcelas ofertadas. Le siguen País Vaco (66,1%) e Illes Balears (64,2%).

Por zonas turísticas, la Costa Brava es el destino preferido en acampamentos, con 2,5 millones de pernoctaciones. La Costa Barcelona-Maresme alcanza la mayor ocupación (70,1%).

Los puntos turísticos con más pernoctaciones en agosto son Torroella de Montgrí, Salou y Castelló d'Empúries.

El Índice de Precios de Acampamentos Turísticos experimenta un aumento interanual del 1,7% en agosto. La tarifa *normal*, que tiene el mayor peso en la estructura de ponderaciones este mes (85,3%), presenta una subida del 1,3%.

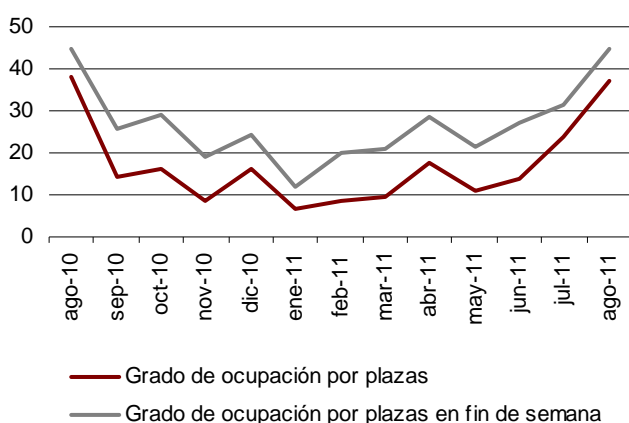
En cuanto a las categorías, la de *lujo y primera*, que tiene una ponderación del 53,7% este mes, registra un aumento interanual del 1,6%.

Alojamientos de Turismo Rural

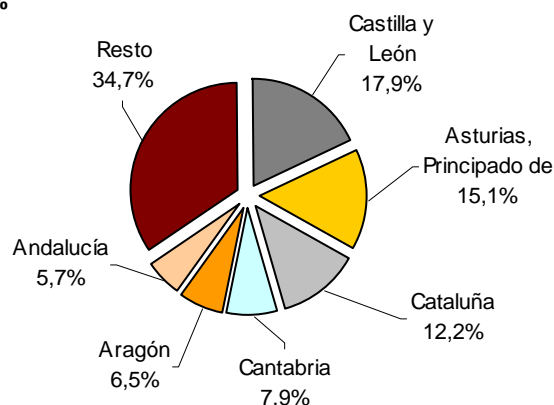
Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos de turismo rural superan 1,7 millones en agosto, con un aumento interanual del 2,5%¹. Las de residentes bajan un 0,1% y las de no residentes crecen un 17,0%. En el periodo **julio-agosto** las pernoctaciones aumentan un 6,0%.

Los alojamientos de turismo rural ofrecen 145.054 plazas, un 5,5% más que en agosto de 2010. De estas plazas, se ocupan el 37,3%, lo que supone un descenso del 2,7%. El grado de ocupación en fin de semana se sitúa en el 44,8%, mismo valor que el año anterior.

Castilla y León es el destino preferido en alojamientos de turismo rural, con 274.666 pernoctaciones, un 6,8% más que en agosto de 2010. Le sigue Principado de Asturias, con 229.904 pernoctaciones, un 4,2% menos.

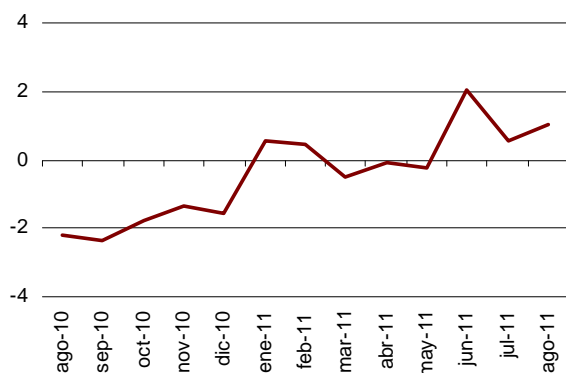
Entre los no residentes, el destino preferido es Illes Balears. Por su parte, los destinos con más pernoctaciones de residentes son Castilla y León, Principado de Asturias y Cataluña.

Illes Balears alcanza el mayor grado de ocupación con el 71,5% de las plazas ofertadas. Le siguen País Vasco (56,0%) y Principado de Asturias (55,5%).

Por zonas turísticas, Costa Verde es el principal destino con 98.827 pernoctaciones. Costa de Gipuzkoa alcanza la mayor ocupación, el 78,6% de las plazas ofertadas.

IPTR Tasa de variación interanual



El Índice de Precios de Alojamiento de Turismo Rural experimenta un aumento interanual del 1,0% en agosto. La tarifa *normal*, que supone el 65,8% del peso total, sube un 0,7%. Por modalidad de alquiler, la de *uso completo*, cuya ponderación es del 63,1%, crece un 0,8%.

Por comunidades autónomas, Principado de Asturias, Castilla y León e Illes Balears, que suponen el 41,0% de peso total del índice en el mes de agosto, registran tasas interanuales del 0,3%, 0,2% y 5,9%, respectivamente.

Evolución de los viajeros y las pernoctaciones en todos los alojamientos turísticos colectivos españoles

Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos turísticos colectivos españoles (hoteles, apartamentos, campings y alojamientos de turismo rural) registran un **aumento interanual del 5,5% en agosto**. Las de residentes bajan un 0,2% y las de no residentes crecen un 10,7%. En el **periodo julio-agosto las pernoctaciones aumentan un 6,5%**.

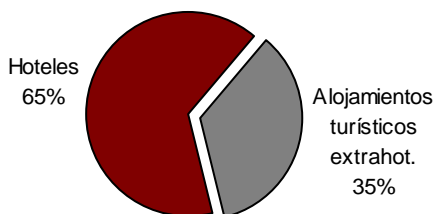
En agosto la estancia media aumenta un 0,3% y se sitúa en 4,5 pernoctaciones por viajero.

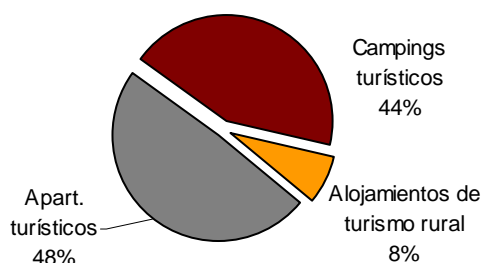

Del total de las pernoctaciones realizadas en alojamientos turísticos colectivos en el mes de agosto, un 65% corresponde a hoteles y un 35% a alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros.

Los principales mercados emisores en el conjunto de alojamientos turísticos reglados son el británico (con el 24,1% del total de pernoctaciones de no residentes), el alemán (22,2%) y el francés (12,7%).

Cataluña es el destino preferido en el conjunto de alojamientos turísticos, con más de 14,9 millones de pernoctaciones (un 7,2% más que en agosto de 2010). Le siguen Illes Balears, con 13,2 millones de pernoctaciones (un 7,7% más) y Canarias, con más de 9,6 millones de pernoctaciones (un 12,8% más).

Los destinos preferidos por los no residentes son Illes Balears, Cataluña y Canarias. Por su parte, los destinos con más pernoctaciones de residentes son Cataluña, Andalucía, y Comunitat Valenciana.
