

**Encuestas de ocupación en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros**  
Agosto 2016. *Datos provisionales*

**Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros aumentan un 5,8% en agosto respecto al mismo mes de 2015**

Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros (apartamentos, campings, alojamientos de turismo rural y albergues) superan los 24,8 millones en agosto, un 5,8% más que en el mismo mes de 2015. Las pernoctaciones de residentes aumentan un 5,4% y las de no residentes un 6,3%.

La estancia media es de 5,9 pernoctaciones por viajero.

En el periodo agregado de julio y agosto, las pernoctaciones crecen un 6,7% respecto al mismo periodo de 2015. Las de residentes suben un 7,6% y las de no residentes un 5,8%.

Durante los ocho primeros meses de 2016, las pernoctaciones aumentan un 8,7% respecto al mismo periodo del año anterior.


**Apartamentos turísticos**

Las pernoctaciones en apartamentos turísticos aumentan un 3,4% en agosto. Las de residentes suben un 0,6% y las de no residentes un 5,1%.


La estancia media baja un 0,3% respecto a agosto de 2015, situándose en 7,2 pernoctaciones por viajero.

En el conjunto de los meses de julio y agosto las pernoctaciones en apartamentos turísticos aumentan un 5,9% respecto al mismo bimestre de 2015.

En agosto se ocupan el 63,1% de las plazas ofertadas por los apartamentos turísticos, un 2,7% más que en el mismo mes de 2015. El grado de ocupación por plazas en fin de semana se sitúa en el 65,3%, con un incremento del 5,1%.



Las pernoctaciones de no residentes en apartamentos turísticos representan el 64,9% del total, Reino Unido es el principal mercado emisor, con 2,7 millones de pernoctaciones, un 7,8% más que en agosto de 2015. El siguiente mercado emisor es Francia, con 1,2 millones de pernoctaciones, un 2,6% menos.



Canarias es el destino preferido en apartamentos, con más de 3,3 millones de pernoctaciones, un 7,7% más que en agosto de 2015. Illes Balears alcanza la mayor ocupación, con el 89,7% de los apartamentos ofertados.

Por zonas turísticas, Costa Blanca es el destino preferido, con más de 1,2 millones de pernoctaciones. La isla de Mallorca alcanza la mayor ocupación, del 92,3% de los apartamentos ofertados.

Los puntos turísticos con mayor número de pernoctaciones en agosto son San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona y Tías.


## Campings

Las pernoctaciones en campings registran en agosto un incremento anual del 7,7% respecto al mismo mes del año anterior. Las de residentes aumentan un 7,5% y las de no residentes un 7,9%. En el periodo julio-agosto las pernoctaciones suben un 6,3%.

Durante el mes de agosto se ocupan el 56,7% de las parcelas ofertadas, un 5,7% más que en el mismo mes de 2015. El grado de ocupación por parcelas en fin de semana alcanza el 60,7%, con un aumento anual del 9,9%.

El 38,6% de las pernoctaciones en campings las realizan viajeros no residentes. Francia es el principal mercado emisor, con el 33,8% de las pernoctaciones de no residentes, un 1,4% menos que en agosto de 2015.

Cataluña es el destino preferido en campings, con 5,1 millones de pernoctaciones, un 5,0% más que en agosto de 2015. País Vasco alcanza el mayor grado de ocupación, con el 74,5% de las parcelas ofertadas.

Por zonas turísticas, la Costa Brava es el destino preferido, con más de 2,5 millones de pernoctaciones. Costa Blanca alcanza la mayor ocupación, del 75,3% de las parcelas ofertadas.


Los puntos turísticos con más pernoctaciones son Torroella De Montgrí, Mont-Roig Del Camp y Calonge.

## Alojamientos de turismo rural

Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos de turismo rural presentan un aumento anual del 11,4% en agosto. Las de residentes suben un 9,9% y las de no residentes un 16,6%. En el periodo julio-agosto las pernoctaciones se incrementan un 13,0%.

En los alojamientos de turismo rural se ocupan el 41,6% de las plazas, con un crecimiento del 8,2% respecto a agosto de 2015. El grado de ocupación en fin de semana se sitúa en el 51,9%, con un incremento del 16,4%.


Occupancy rate by bedplaces and bedplaces on weekends



Por comunidades, Cataluña es el destino preferido, con 278.883 pernoctaciones, un 7,4% más que en agosto de 2015. Illes Balears alcanza el mayor grado de ocupación, con el 74,3% de las plazas ofertadas.

Por zonas turísticas, la Isla de Mallorca es el principal destino, con 128.447 pernoctaciones. Costa de Gipuzkoa alcanza la mayor ocupación, del 80,2% de las plazas ofertadas.

## Albergues

Las pernoctaciones en albergues registran en agosto un aumento anual del 5,0%. Las de residentes suben un 8,1%, mientras que las de no residentes bajan un 1,7%. En el periodo julio-agosto las pernoctaciones aumentan un 9,2%.

Se ocupan el 45,0% de las plazas, un 6,1% más que en agosto de 2015. El grado de ocupación en fin de semana alcanza el 50,7%, con un aumento del 14,7%.

Por comunidades, Cataluña es el destino preferido, con 133.610 pernoctaciones, un 4,6% más que en agosto de 2015. Galicia alcanza la mayor ocupación, con el 69,1% de las plazas ofertadas.


## Índices de precios

El Índice de Precios de Apartamentos Turísticos (IPAP) aumenta un 5,1% respecto a agosto de 2015. La tarifa *normal*, que tiene el mayor peso en la estructura de ponderaciones este mes (50,9%), sube un 5,2%.

El Índice de Precios de Campings (IPAC) aumenta un 1,9% en tasa anual. La tarifa *normal*, que tiene el mayor peso en la estructura de ponderaciones en agosto (49,4%), sube un 3,4% respecto al mismo mes de 2015.

El Índice de Precios de Alojamientos de Turismo Rural (IPTR) registra un aumento del 3,3% en agosto. La tarifa *normal*, que supone el 63,0% del peso total, sube un 3,6% en tasa anual.

## Evolución de los viajeros y las pernoctaciones en todos los alojamientos turísticos colectivos españoles

Las pernoctaciones en el conjunto de alojamientos turísticos colectivos españoles (hoteles<sup>1</sup>, apartamentos, campings, alojamientos de turismo rural y albergues) aumentan un 4,5% en agosto en tasa anual. Las de residentes suben un 2,0% y las de no residentes un 6,3%. En el periodo julio-agosto las pernoctaciones crecen un 5,8%.


La estancia media permanece invariable respecto a agosto de 2015, situándose en 4,4 pernoctaciones por viajero.

Del total de pernoctaciones realizadas en alojamientos turísticos colectivos, un 65% corresponde a hoteles y un 35% a alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros.

Los principales mercados emisores en el conjunto de alojamientos turísticos reglados son el británico (con el 27,2% del total de pernoctaciones de no residentes), el alemán (18,6%) y el francés (14,6%).

Cataluña es el destino preferido, con más de 16,2 millones de pernoctaciones (un 2,9% más que en agosto de 2015). Le siguen Illes Balears, con más de 13,3 millones (y un aumento anual del 1,4%) y Canarias, con 10,3 millones (y un incremento del 7,5%).
