

**Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey**  
August 2017. *Provisional data*

**Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increase 2.9% in August, as compared with the same month of 2016**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations (holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) exceeded 25.6 million in August, 2.9% more than in the same month of 2016. Overnight stays by residents increased by 3.9% and those of non-residents did so by 1.9%.

The average stay stood at 5.9 overnight stays per traveller.

During the aggregate July-August period, the number of overnight stays increased 4.0% as compared with the same period in 2016. Resident overnight stays grew by 4.8%, and those of non-residents did so by 3.3%.

During the first eight months of 2017, overnight stays increased by 6.1% as compared with the same period of the previous year.

### Holiday dwellings


Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased by 3.2% in August. Resident overnight stays grew by 5.5%, and those of non-residents did so by 1.9%.

The average stay decreased 2.5% as compared with August 2016, standing at 7.0 overnight stays per traveller.

During the months of July and August, the number of overnight stays increased 3.6% as compared with the same period in 2016.


In August, 59.6% of the bedplaces available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 4.0% less than in the same month of 2016. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 62.0%, with a decrease of 3.6%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 63.5% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with more than 2.8 million overnight stays, that is, 4.8% more than in August 2016. The following country of origin was France, with 1.2 overnight stays, 1.6% less.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 3.2 million overnight stays, and a decrease of 1.2% as compared to August 2016. Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 89.8% of holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist area, the Costa Blanca was the preferred destination, with 1.4 million overnight stays. The island of Mallorca registered the highest occupancy rate, with 91.1% of the holiday dwellings offered.


The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in July were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.

## Tourist campsites

Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an increase of 1.9% in August as compared with the same month of the previous year. Resident overnight stays grew by 2.6% and non-residents by 1.0%. During the July-August period, overnight stays increased by 4.0%.

During the month of August, 57.3% of the offered pitches were occupied, 1.9% more than in the same month of 2016. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 61.9%, with an annual increase of 3.4%.

38.3% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents travellers. France was the main country of origin, with 34.0% of overnight stays by non-residents, 3.9% more than in August 2016.



Cataluña was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with more than 5.3 million overnight stays, representing an increase of 5.2% in annual rate. La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate, with 79.7% of the pitches offered.


By tourist area, the Costa Brava was the preferred destination, with 2.7 million overnight stays. Costa de Gipuzkoa reached the highest occupancy rate, with 75.4% of pitches offered.

The tourist sites with more overnight stays were Torroella De Montgrí, Calonge and Castelló D'Empúries.

## Rural tourism accommodation


Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 6.6% in August. Resident overnight stays grew by 5.6%, and those of non-residents did so by 9.5%. During the July-August period, overnight stays increased by 7.0%.

In rural tourism accommodation, 42.3% of the bedplaces were occupied, with a 1.9% increase as compared to August 2016. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 53.2%, with an annual increase of 2.4%.



By Autonomous Community, Principado de Asturias was the preferred destination, with 303,981 overnight stays, 12.5% more than in July 2016. Illes Balears was the Autonomous Community that reached the highest occupancy rate, with 69.2% of the bedplaces offered.


By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 152,275 overnight stays. Costa de Gipuzkoa registered the highest occupancy rate, with 82.0% of the bedplaces offered.



## Youth Hostels


Overnight stays in hostels registered an annual increase of 2.7% in August. Resident overnight stays grew by 1.6%, and those of non-residents did so by 5.5%. During the July-August period, overnight stays increased by 4.4%.

43.7% of the available bedplaces were occupied, 3.5% less than in August 2016. The weekend occupancy rate reached 48.6%, with a 4.4% decrease.

By Autonomous Community, Cataluña was the preferred destination, with 118,446 overnight stays, 8.9% less than in August 2016. Galicia reached the highest occupancy rate, with 70.0% of the bedplaces offered.


## Price indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) increased 5.1%, as compared to August 2016. The *normal* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure this month (51.5%), rose 5.1%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) increased by 3.9% in the annual rate. The *normal* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weightings structure in August (48.1%), grew by 2.1% as compared with the same month of 2016.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) registered a 3.0% increase in August. The *normal* rate, which accounted for 64.5% of the total weight, increased by 3.2% in the annual rate.

## Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation


In August, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodations (hotels<sup>1</sup>, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) increased by 1.3% in the annual rate. Resident overnight stays grew by 0.9% and non-residents 1.6%. During the July-August period, overnight stays increased by 2.0%.

The average stay decreased 0.2%, and stood at 4.3 overnight stays per traveller.

65% of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation corresponded to hotels and 35% to non-hotel tourist accommodation.



The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 26.3% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (17.3%) and France (13.9%).

Cataluña was the preferred destination, with over 16.4 million overnight stays (1.5% more than in August 2016). It was followed by Illes Balears, with 13.2 million overnight stays (a decrease of 1.1%) and Canarias, with more than 10.3 million, (an annual increase of 0.1%).
