**Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey**  
September 2015. *Provisional data*

**Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increase 5.0%  
in September as compared to the same month of 2014**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) exceeded 11 million in September, that is, 5.0% more than in the same month of 2014. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased by 6.1% and those of non-residents did so by 4.4%.

The average stay stood at 5.4 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first nine months of 2015, overnight stays increased by 3.8% as compared with the same period of the previous year.


### Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased 4.3% in September. Those of residents increased by 7.3% and those of non-residents did so by 3.3%.

The average stay increased 0.6% as compared with September 2014, and stood at 6.6 overnight stays per traveller.


In September, 40.8% of the bedplaces available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 0.1% more than in the same month of 2014. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 44.1%, with an increase of 1.0%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 74.7% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with more than 2.1 million overnight stays, that is, 0.3% less than in September 2014. The following country of origin was Germany, with 921,484 overnight stays, that is, 0.9% more.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.3 million overnight stays, 2.1% more than in September 2014. Illes Balears registered the highest occupancy rate, with 82.2% of the holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 906,589 overnight stays. The island of Lanzarote registered the highest occupancy rate, with 87.6% of the holiday dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in September were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Tías and Arona.


## Tourist campsites

Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an annual increase of 4.7% in September as compared to the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased by 2.6% and those of non-resident travellers did so by 7.0%.

In September, 35.6% of the offered pitches were occupied, that is, 2.7% more. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 38.2%, with a 3.1% annual increase.

48.6% of the overnight stays at tourist campsites were by non-residents. Germany was the main country of origin, with 23.5% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 7.2% more than in September 2014.

Cataluña was the preferred destination regarding tourist campsites, with more than 1.6 million overnight stays, 2.6% more than in September 2014.

La Rioja was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate on tourist campsites, with 61.2% of the pitches offered.

By tourist areas, Costa Brava was the preferred destination, with 646,862 overnight stays. Costa Blanca reached the highest occupancy rate with 60.7% of the pitches offered.


The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Benidorm, Mont-Roig Del Camp, and Torroella de Montgrí.

## Rural Tourism Accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 13.0% in September. Residents' overnight stays increased by 14.9% and those of non-residents did so by 9.3%.

Regarding rural tourism accommodation, 17.0% of the bedplaces were occupied, that is, a 10.3% increase as compared to September 2014. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 31.3%, with a 12.3% increase.


Occupancy rate by bedplaces and bedplaces on weekends



By Autonomous Community, Illes Balears was the preferred destination, with 124,673 overnight stays, 6.5% more than in September 2014. Illes Balears also reached the highest occupancy rate, with 65.6% of the bedplaces offered.

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the main destination, with 120,366 overnight stays, and an occupancy rate of 66.5% of the bedplaces offered.

## Youth Hostels

Overnight stays in hostels registered an annual increase of 5.5% in September. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased by 0.4% and those of non-resident travellers increased by 13.8%.

22.6% of the offered bedplaces were occupied, 8.7% more than in September 2014. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces reached 33.2%, with a 6.4% increase.

By Autonomous Community, Cataluña was the preferred destination, with 73,690 overnight stays, 10.2% more than in September 2014. Cataluña also reached the highest occupancy rate with 40.5% of bedplaces offered.


## Price Indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) increased 3.5%, as compared to September 2014. The *tour operators and travel agencies* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (48.7%), increased by 4.4%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) decreased by 0.1% in the annual rate. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for September (40.3%), decreased by 0.4% as compared with the same month of 2014.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) registered a 2.1% increase in September. The *weekend* rate, which accounted for 51.1% of the total weight, increased by 1.9% in the annual rate.

## Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation


In September, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels<sup>1</sup>, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) registered a 3.2% increase in the annual rate. Overnight stays by residents increased by 4.3%, while those of non-residents did so by 2.7%.

The average stay decreased 1.0%, standing at 3.9 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 76% accounted for hotels, and 24% did so for non-hotel tourist accommodation.



The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 30.2% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (23.7%) and France (7.4%).

Illes Balears was the preferred destination, with 10.3 million overnight stays (0.5% more than in September 2014), followed by Cataluña, with more than 8.5 million overnight stays (and an annual increase of 1.5%), and Canarias, with 7.6 million (and a 1.9% increase).
