Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey

October 2011. *Provisional data*

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increase 1.9%¹ in October, as compared with the same month of 2010

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 6.3 million in October, 1.9% more than in the same month of 2010. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 9.1% and by non-residents in Spain increased 6.8%.

The average stay increased 3.5%, as compared with October 2010, standing at 5.5 overnights per traveller.

In the first ten months of the year, overnight stays increased 5.2% as compared with the same period the previous year.



Holiday Dwellings


Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 4.5 million in October, with an interannual increase of 5.7%¹, as compared with the same period the previous year. Overnight stays of residents decreased 1.5%, whereas those of non-residents increased 7.3%.

The average stay increased 3.0%, as compared with October 2010, standing at 6.9 overnights stays per traveller.

¹ Due to the update made in the tourist accommodation directory in Comunidad Foral de Navarra, the data published cannot be directly compared to that published last year. In order to avoid this break in the series, linking coefficients have been calculated, allowing for comparing the data from different years. The coefficients are published monthly on the INE website, in the section dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled linking coefficients.

Holiday dwellings offered 426,778 bedplaces, 1.8% less than in October 2010. This month, 34.4% of the total available bedplaces were occupied, 7.5% more. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 36.6%, with an increase of 7.8% in the interannual rate. In turn, 51.7% of the total available holiday dwellings were occupied, for an interannual increase of 8.7%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 83.3% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 1.5 million overnight stays, 8.3% more than in October last year. The following country of origin was Germany, with 756,093 overnight stays, 0.8% more.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.5 million overnight stays, 11.0% more than in October 2010. The second destination of choice was Illes Balears, with 626,415 overnight stays, 5.2% less.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Illes Balears and Comunitat Valenciana were the main destinations of choice. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Canarias, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana.

Comunida de Madrid showed the highest occupancy rate, with 73.0% of the available holiday dwellings. It was followed by Canarias (67.0%) and País Vasco (49.7%).

By tourist area, the island of Tenerife was the preferred destination in holiday dwellings, with 810,559 overnight stays, and an occupancy of 72.2% of the dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.


Holiday Dwelling Price Index Evolution

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered an increase of 1.0% in October, the same rate than that recorded the previous month.


The *Tour-operators and travel agencies* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (53.2%), registered an increase of 2.8%, as compared with the same month the previous year.

By modality, 2/4-bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 65.4%, increased their prices 1.3%.

Tourist Campsites



Tourist campsites exceeded 1.2 million overnight stays in October, indicating an interannual decrease of 2.7%. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 8.7%, whereas those of non-resident travellers increased 1.8%.

Tourist campsites offered 374,956 bedplaces, 2.2% less than in October 2010. 33.2% of the available lots were occupied, 1.9% more. The weekend occupancy rate by lot reached 34.5%, with an interannual increase of 0.2%.

59.8% of the overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 30.1% of the overnight stays by non-residents (3.8% less than in October 2010). The following country of origin was Germany.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for camping, with 404,520 overnight stays, 3.9% more. Cataluña was the second destination of choice, with 350,917 overnight stays, indicating an interannual decrease of 4.8%.


Among residents, the preferred destinations were Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by non-resident travellers were Comunitat Valenciana, Cataluña and Andalucía.

La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate on campsites, with 60.1% of the available lots occupied. It was followed by Comunitat Valenciana (49.5%) and Comunidad de Madrid (48.4%).

By tourist area, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination for camping, with 235,719 overnight stays, with an occupancy of 59.2% of the lots offered.

The tourist sites with the most overnight stays in October were Benidorm, Cartagena and Oliva.

Tourist Campsite Price Index Evolution





The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced an interannual increase of 2.3% in October. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (51.1%), presented an increase of 1.8%.

Regarding category, *second class*, with a weighting of 53.3% this month, registered an interannual increase of 1.5%.

Rural Tourism Accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation reached 599,987 in October, indicating an interannual decrease of 13.2%¹. Resident overnight stays decreased 19.5%, and those by non-residents grew 23.7%.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 141,828 bedplaces, 4.5% more than in October 2010. 13.6% of these bedplaces were occupied, representing a 16.8% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 24.9%, 14.4% less.




Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 132,883 overnight stays, 11.7% less than in October 2010. It was followed by Cataluña, with 62,884 overnight stays, 15.3% less.

Among non-residents, Illes Balears was the preferred destination. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Castilla-La Mancha.

Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 43.2% of the available bedplaces. It was followed by Canarias (25.3%) and La Rioja (20.0%).

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the main destination, with 52,570 overnight stays, with an occupancy of 45.6% of the available bedplaces.

Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index Evolution



The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index experienced an interannual increase of 1.0% in October. The weekend rate, which accounted for 66.4% of the total weight, increased 0.7%. By rent modality, complete use, whose weighting was 64.3%, increased 0.4%.

By Autonomous Community Castilla y León, Illes Balears and Cataluña, which accounted for 47.9% of the total weight in the month of October, registered interannual rates of 0.1%, 7.4% and 3.3%, respectively.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered an **interannual increase of 3.0%¹ in October**. Overnight stays by residents decreased 9.2%, and non-resident stays increased 10.1%.


The average stay increased 3.3%, standing at 3.5 nights per traveller.



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of October, 80% were accounted for at hotels, and 20% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were Germany (with 28.4% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), the United Kingdom (27.0%) and France (6.3%).

Canarias was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 7.5 million overnight stays (10.0% more than in October 2010). It was followed by Illes Balears, with 5.4 million overnight stays (9.5% more) and Cataluña, with more than 4.5 million overnight stays (0.3% more).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Canarias, Illes Balears and Cataluña. In turn, Andalucía, Cataluña, and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
