

**Encuestas de ocupación en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros**  
Octubre 2016. *Datos provisionales*

**Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros  
aumentan un 9,6% en octubre respecto al mismo mes de 2015**

Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros (apartamentos, campings, alojamientos de turismo rural y albergues) superan los 8,7 millones en octubre, un 9,6% más que en el mismo mes de 2015. Las pernoctaciones de residentes aumentan un 5,7% y las de no residentes un 11,1%.

La estancia media es de 5,0 pernoctaciones por viajero.

Durante los 10 primeros meses de 2016, las pernoctaciones aumentan un 8,7% respecto al mismo periodo del año anterior.

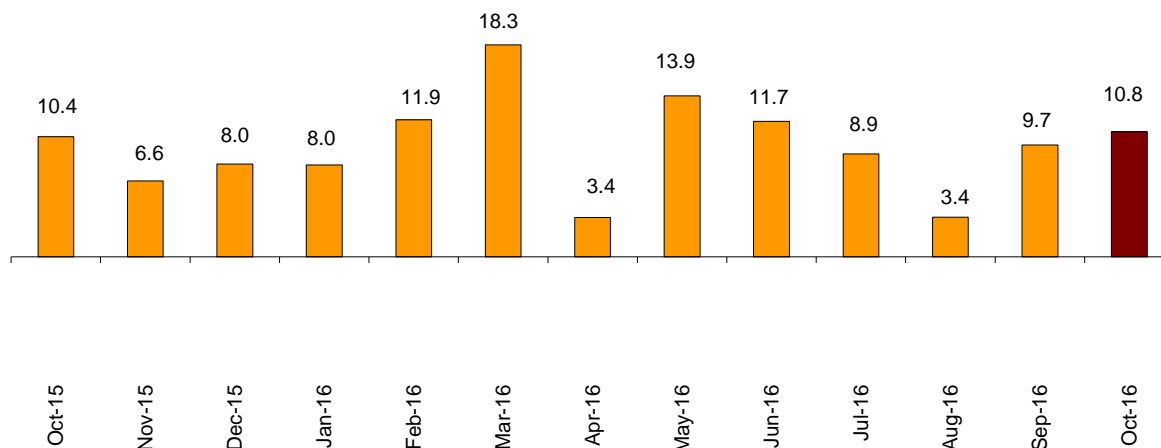
**Apartamentos turísticos**

Las pernoctaciones en apartamentos turísticos aumentan un 10,8% en octubre. Las pernoctaciones de residentes suben un 7,5% y las de no residentes un 11,6%.

La estancia media baja un 1,5% respecto a octubre de 2015, situándose en 6,1 pernoctaciones por viajero.

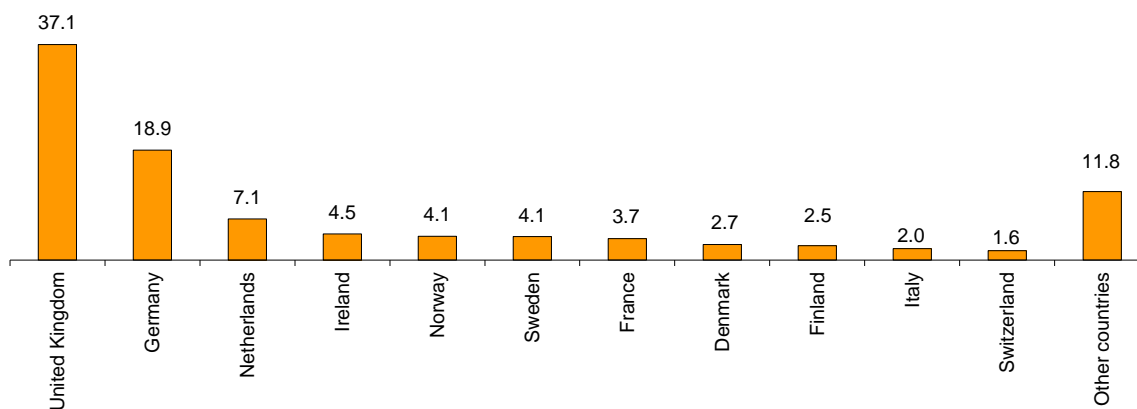
En octubre se ocupan el 39,0% de las plazas ofertadas por los apartamentos turísticos, un 5,1% más que en el mismo mes de 2015. El grado de ocupación por plazas en fin de semana se sitúa en el 41,2%, con un incremento del 3,1%.

Las pernoctaciones de no residentes en apartamentos turísticos representan el 82,9% del total. Reino Unido es el principal mercado emisor, con más de 1,8 millones de pernoctaciones, un 9,8% más que en octubre de 2015. El siguiente mercado emisor es Alemania, con 952.334 pernoctaciones, un 12,1% más.

Canarias es el destino preferido en apartamentos, con más de 2,7 millones de pernoctaciones, y un aumento del 7,2% respecto a octubre de 2015. Esta comunidad también alcanza la mayor ocupación, con el 81,6% de los apartamentos ofertados.

Por zonas turísticas, la isla de Tenerife es el destino preferido, con 924.714 pernoctaciones. La isla de Lanzarote alcanza la mayor ocupación, del 87,8% de los apartamentos ofertados.

Los puntos turísticos con mayor número de pernoctaciones en octubre son San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona y Tías.

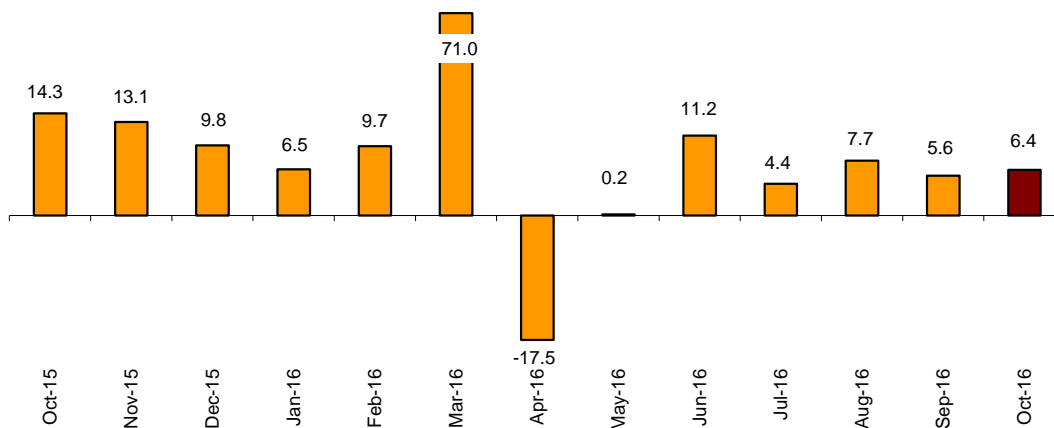
## Campings

Las pernoctaciones en campings registran en octubre un incremento anual del 6,4% respecto al mismo mes del año anterior. Las de residentes aumentan un 4,5% y las de no residentes un 7,6%.

Durante el mes de octubre se ocupan el 35,5% de las parcelas ofertadas, un 1,6% más que en el mismo mes de 2015. El grado de ocupación por parcelas en fin de semana alcanza el 39,0%, con un aumento anual del 5,5%.

El 60,9% de las pernoctaciones en campings las realizan viajeros no residentes. Reino Unido es el principal mercado emisor, con el 27,8% de las pernoctaciones de no residentes, un 3,2% más que en octubre de 2015.

Comunitat Valenciana es el destino preferido en campings, con 621.730 pernoctaciones, un 9,0% más que en octubre de 2015. La Rioja alcanza el mayor grado de ocupación, con el 59,6% de las parcelas ofertadas.

Por zonas turísticas, la Costa Blanca es el destino preferido, con 328.287 pernoctaciones y una ocupación del 75,0% de las parcelas ofertadas.

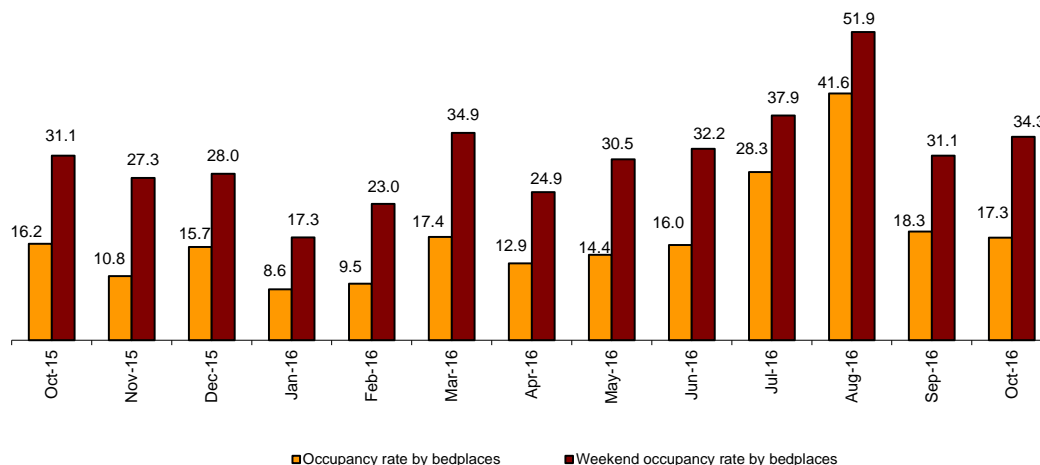
Los puntos turísticos con más pernoctaciones son Benidorm, Mont-Roig Del Camp y Cartagena.

## Alojamientos de turismo rural

Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos de turismo rural presentan un aumento anual del 8,9% en octubre. Las de residentes suben un 4,9% y las de no residentes un 21,4%.

En los alojamientos de turismo rural se ocupan el 17,3% de las plazas, con un crecimiento del 6,4% respecto a octubre de 2015. El grado de ocupación en fin de semana se sitúa en el 34,3%, con un aumento del 10,3%.

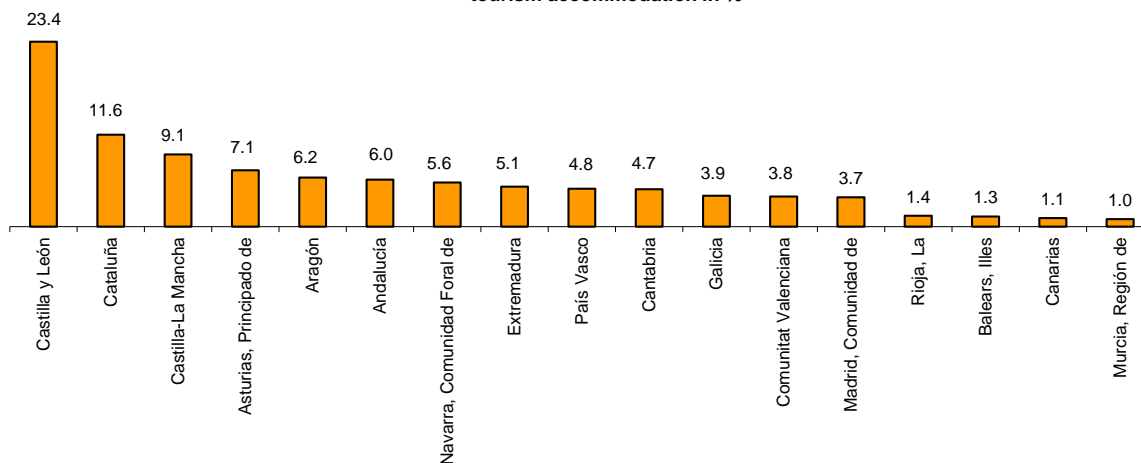
Occupancy rate by bedplaces and bedplaces on weekends in rural tourism accommodation



Por comunidades, Castilla y León es el destino preferido, con 148.335 pernотaciones, un 10,2% más que en octubre de 2015. Illes Balears alcanza el mayor grado de ocupación, con el 51,5% de las plazas ofertadas.

Por zonas turísticas, la Isla de Mallorca es el principal destino, con 90.455 pernотaciones y una ocupación del 53,0% de las plazas ofertadas.

## Albergues

Las pernотaciones en albergues registran en octubre un aumento anual del 2,7%. Las de residentes suben un 0,2% y las de no residentes un 6,4%.

Se ocupan el 24,2% de las plazas, un 0,6% menos que en octubre de 2015. El grado de ocupación en fin de semana alcanza el 37,0%, con un aumento del 9,4%.

Por comunidades, Cataluña es el destino preferido, con 83.973 pernотaciones, un 5,3% más que en octubre de 2015. Esta comunidad también alcanza la mayor ocupación, con el 45,5% de las plazas ofertadas.

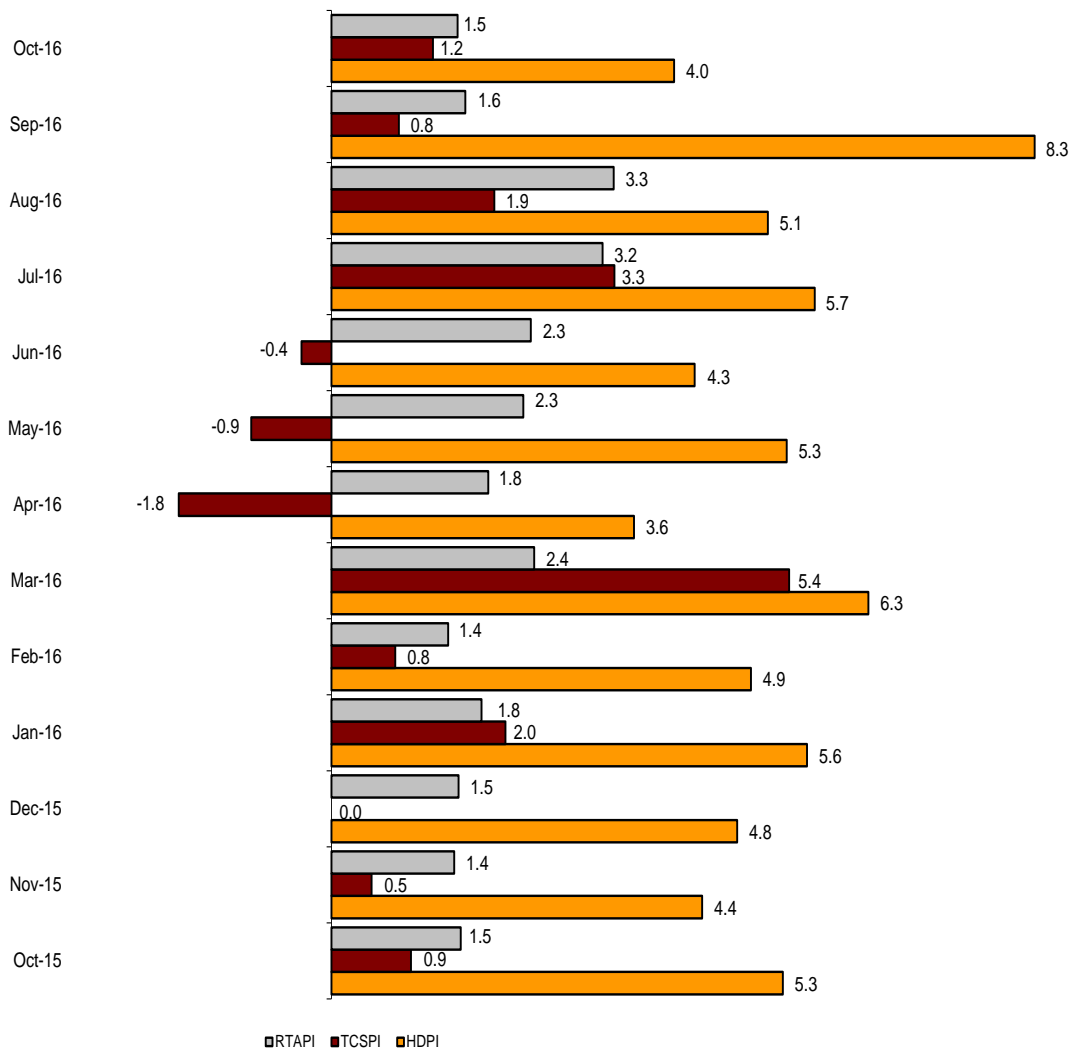
### Índices de precios

El Índice de Precios de Apartamentos Turísticos (IPAP) aumenta un 4,0% respecto a octubre de 2015. La tarifa *tour-operadores y agencias de viajes*, que tiene el mayor peso en la estructura de ponderaciones este mes (53,1%), sube un 4,4%.

El Índice de Precios de Campings (IPAC) se incrementa un 1,2% en tasa anual. La tarifa *bungalow*, que tiene el mayor peso en la estructura de ponderaciones en octubre (41,4%), sube un 2,4% respecto al mismo mes de 2015.

El Índice de Precios de Alojamientos de Turismo Rural (IPTR) registra un aumento del 1,5% en octubre. La tarifa *fin de semana*, que supone el 66,8% del peso total, sube un 1,1% en tasa anual.

## Evolución de los viajeros y las pernoctaciones en todos los alojamientos turísticos colectivos españoles

Las pernoctaciones en el conjunto de alojamientos turísticos colectivos españoles (hoteles<sup>1</sup>, apartamentos, campings, alojamientos de turismo rural y albergues) aumentan un 7,2% en octubre en tasa anual. Las de residentes suben un 5,0% y las de no residentes un 8,1%.

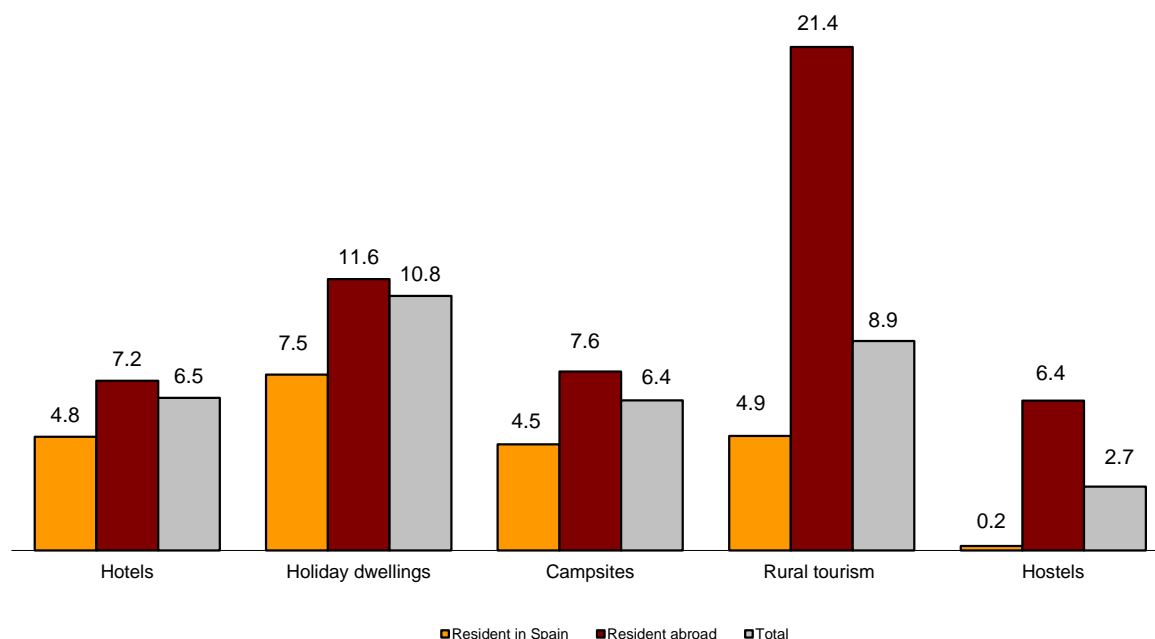
La estancia media asciende un 0,1% respecto a octubre de 2015, situándose en 3,5 pernoctaciones por viajero.

Del total de pernoctaciones realizadas en alojamientos turísticos colectivos, un 77% corresponde a hoteles y un 23% a alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros.

Los principales mercados emisores en el conjunto de alojamientos turísticos reglados son el británico (con el 28,5% del total de pernoctaciones de no residentes), el alemán (25,2%) y el francés (7,3%).

Canarias es el destino preferido, con más de 8,8 millones de pernoctaciones (un 6,8% más que en octubre de 2015). Le siguen Illes Balears, con más de 6,8 millones (y un aumento anual del 9,3%) y Andalucía, con 5,9 millones (y un incremento del 10,5%).
