

Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
November 2017. *Provisional data*

**Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increase 2.9%
in November, as compared with the same month of 2016**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations (holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) exceeded 5.8 million in November, 2.9% more than in the same month of 2016. Overnight stays by residents increased by 7.0% and those of non-residents did so by 1.6%.

The average stay stood at 5.4 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first 11 months of 2017, overnight stays increased 5.9%, as compared with the same period of the previous year.

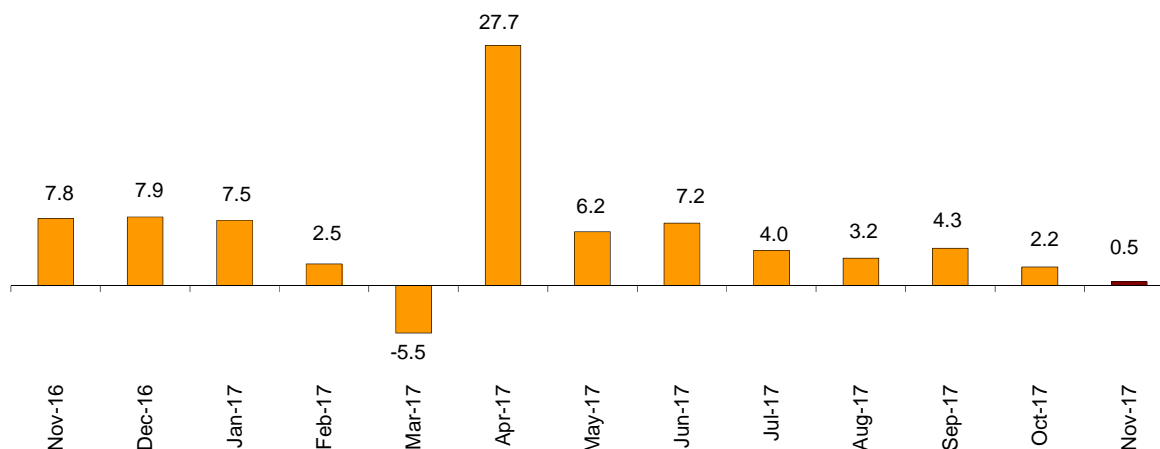
Holiday dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased 0.5% in November. Overnight stays by residents increased 4.5%, while those by non-residents decreased 0.3%.

The average stay decreased 4.1% as compared with November 2016, standing at 6.5 overnight stays per traveller.

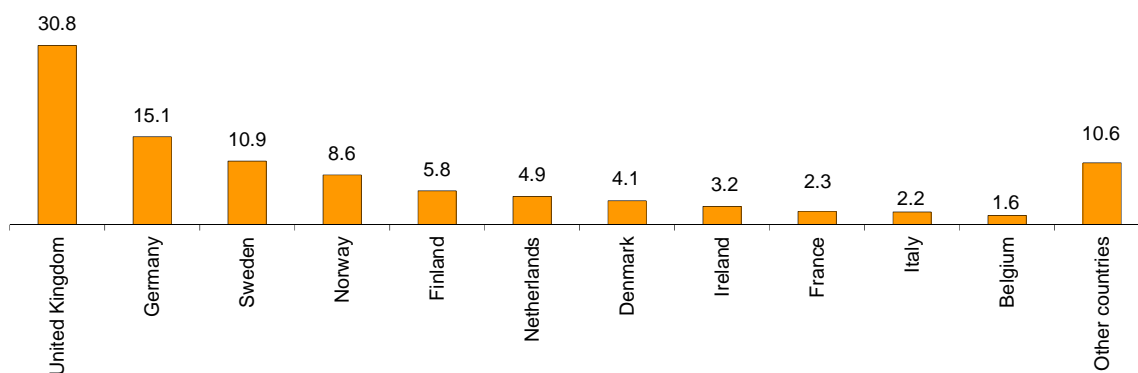
In November, 33.9% of the bedplaces available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 3.1% less than in the same month of 2016. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 37.2%, with a decrease of 1.8%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 84.1% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with more than one million overnight stays, and with no change compared to November 2016. The following country of origin was Germany, with 536,479 overnight stays, 1.7% less.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.6 million overnight stays, and a decrease of 1.8% as compared with November 2016. This Autonomous Community also presented the highest occupancy rate, with 86.8% of holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist area, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination, with 961,057 overnight stays, also reaching the largest occupation, with 90.2% of holiday dwellings offered.

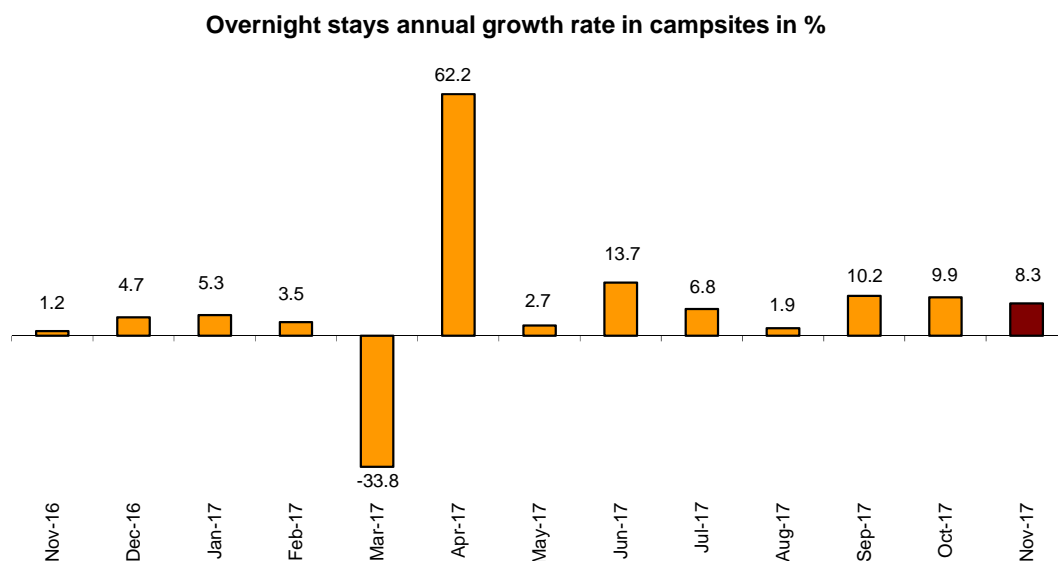
The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays in November were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Mogán.

Tourist campsites

Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an increase of 8.3% in November as compared with the same month of the previous year. Resident overnight stays grew by 9.1% and non-residents did so by 8.0%.

In November, 35.8% of the offered pitches were occupied, that is, 5.7% more than in the same month of 2016. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 37.2%, with an annual increase of 2.4%.

71.4% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents travellers. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 34.9% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 8.2% more than in November 2016.



Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with 514,816 overnight stays, representing an annual increase of 10.0%. La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate, with 60.2% of the pitches offered.

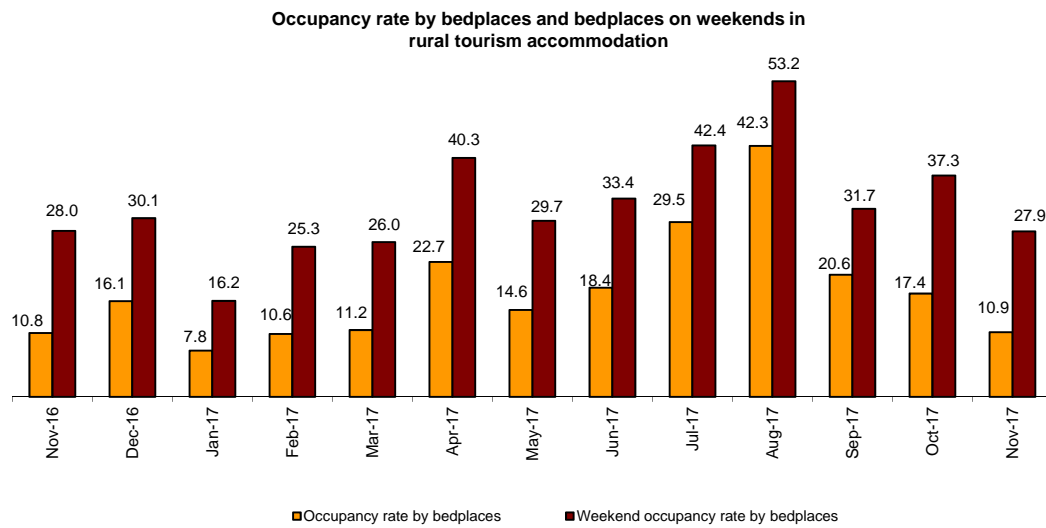
By tourist area, the Costa Blanca was the preferred destination, with 303,827 overnight stays. It also reached the highest occupancy rate, with 76.5% of pitches offered.

The tourist destinations with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Marbella.

Rural tourism accommodation

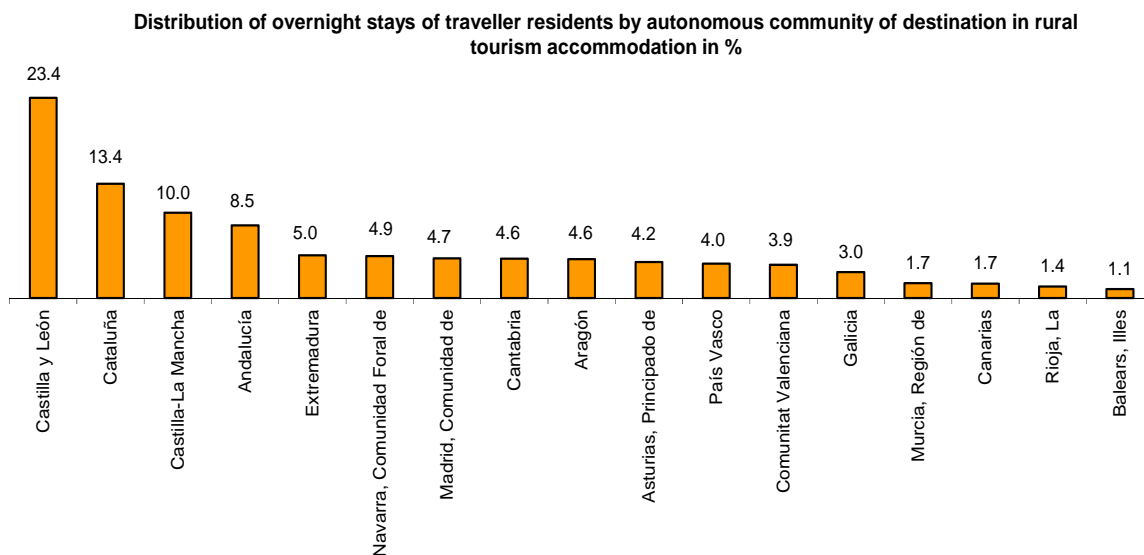
Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodations presented an annual increase of 5.1% in November. Resident overnight stays grew by 3.3%, and those of non-residents did so by 12.8%.

In rural tourism accommodations, 10.9% of the bedplaces were occupied, a 0.8% increase as compared with November 2016. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 27.9%, with an annual decrease of 0.3%.



By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 94,356 overnight stays, 2.8% less than in November 2016. Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 37.3% of the bedplaces offered.

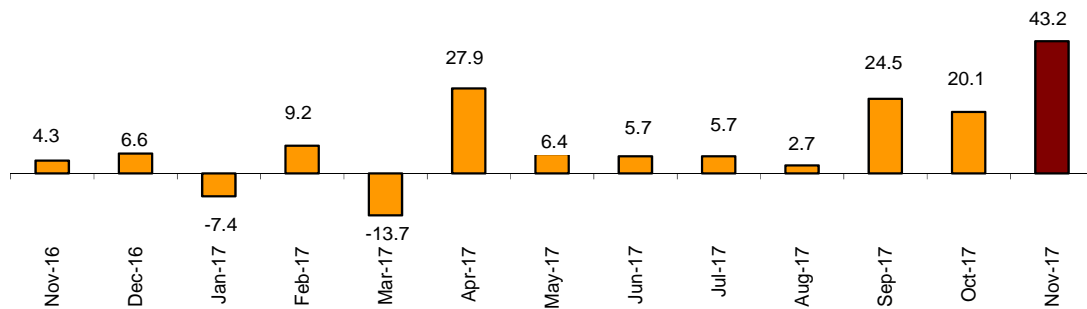
By tourist area, Pirineus was the main destination, with 23,276 overnight stays. The Parque Nacional del Teide reached the highest occupancy rate with 44.6% of the bedplaces offered.



Youth Hostels

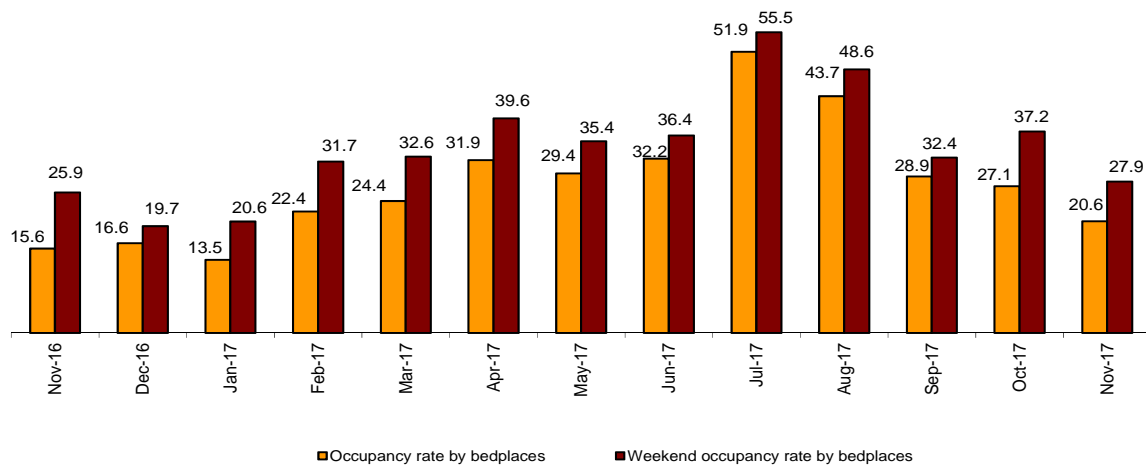
Overnight stays in hostels registered an annual increase of 43.2% in November. Resident overnight stays grew by 45.2%, and those of non-residents did so by 39.6%.

20.6% of the available bedplaces were occupied, 32.3% more than in November 2016. The weekend occupancy rate reached 27.9%, with a 7.8% increase.

By Autonomous Community, Cataluña was the preferred destination, with 49,232 overnight stays, 21.2% more than in November 2016. Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 62.6% of the bedplaces offered.

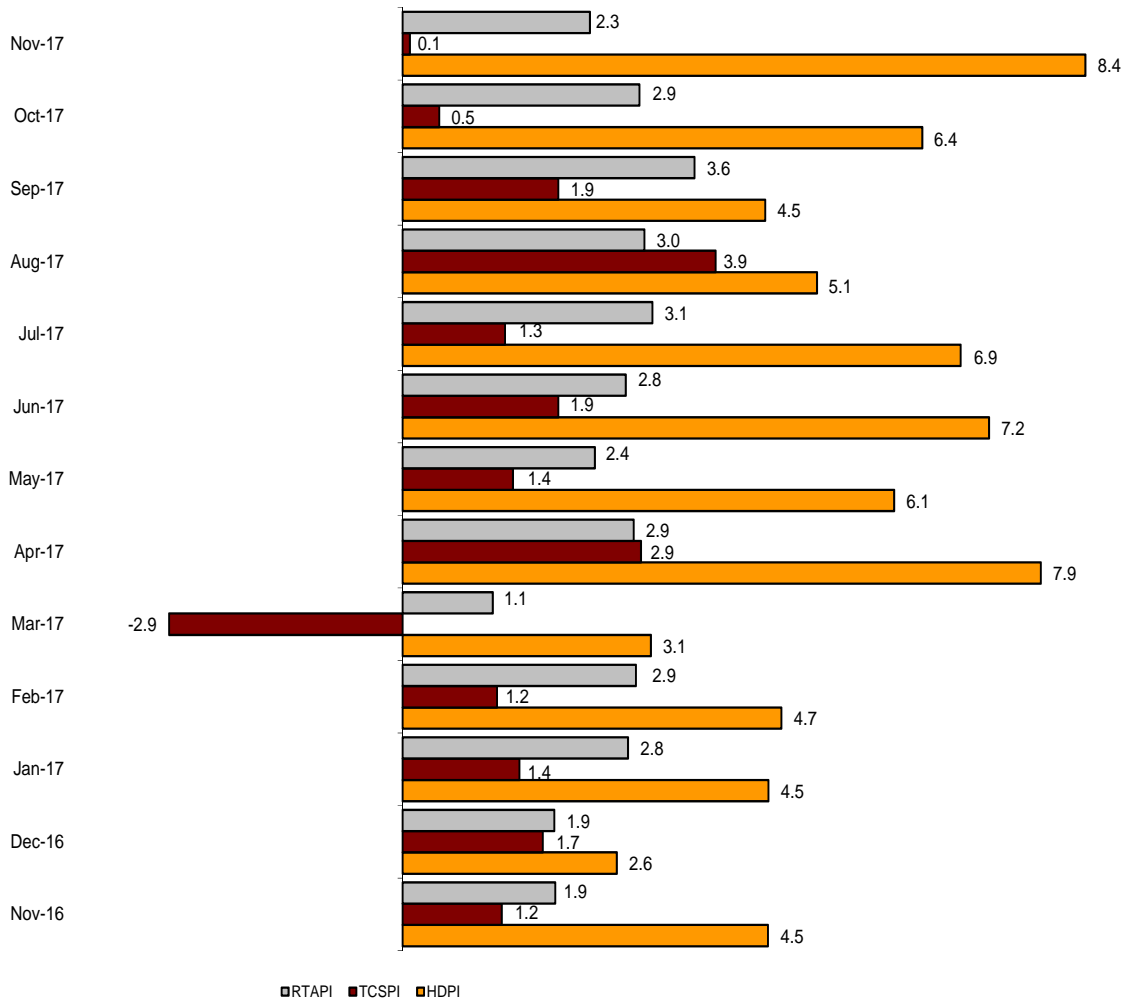
Price indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) increased 8.4%, as compared with November 2016. The rate for *tour operators and travel agencies*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (58.8%), increased by 9.3%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) increased by 0.1% in the annual rate. The *bungalow* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure in November (34.8%), decreased by 3.1% as compared with the same month of 2016.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) registered a 2.3% increase in November. The *weekend rate*, which accounted for 76.1% of the total weight, increased by 2.3% in the annual rate.

Evolution of arrivals and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In November, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels¹, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) registered a 2.3% increase in the annual rate. Resident overnight stays grew by 4.1%, and those of non-residents did so by 1.4%.

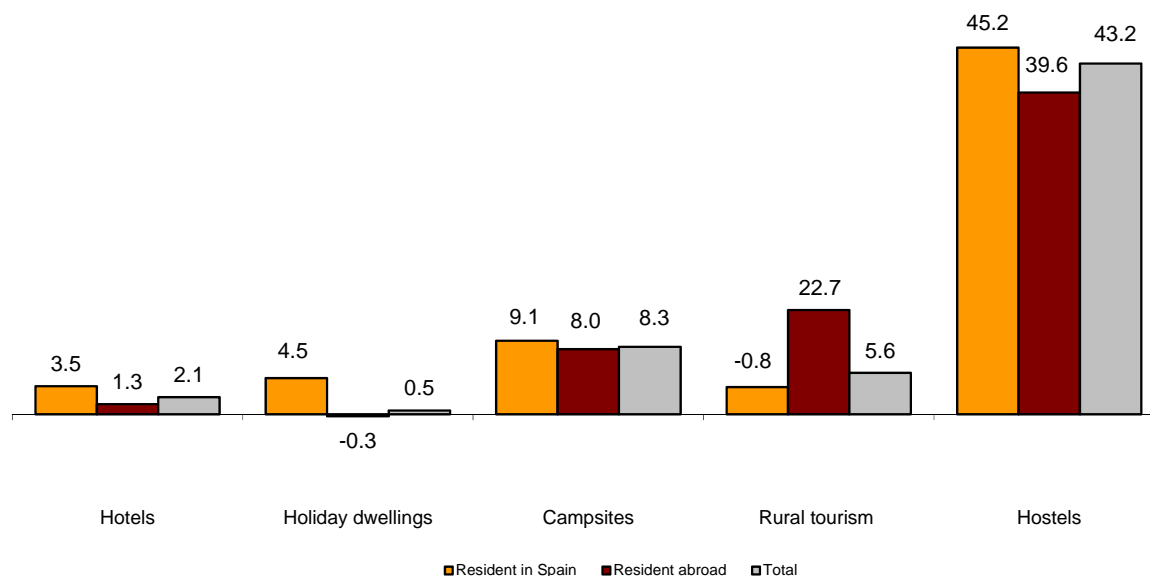
The average stay decreased 2.7%, and stood at 3.3 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total number of overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 75% corresponded to hotels and 25% to non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin for regulated tourist accommodation as a whole were The United Kingdom (with 24.9% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (20.0%) and France (5.1%).

Canarias was the preferred destination, with over 8.4 million overnight stays (0.3% less than in November 2016). It was followed by Andalucía, with over 3.3 million overnight stays (and an increase of 4.8%) and Comunitat Valenciana, with over 2.7 million, (and an annual increase of 4.2%).
