**Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
Year 2010. Provisional data**

**Oversight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increases
1.0%¹ in the year 2010, as compared with 2009**

The overnight stays recorded in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded the figure of 98.5 million in 2010, that is, 1.0% more than in 2009. This increase in overnight stays took place for both residents (with an interannual rate of 0.8%) and non-residents (1.1%).

The average stay dropped 1.8% in 2010, standing at 5.8 nights per traveller.


In turn, during the month of December, 4.8 million overnight stays were registered, 3.4% less than in the same month of 2009.

Holiday Dwellings


Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 59.7 million in 2010, that is, 1.1% more than in 2009. This increase was produced among both residents (with an interannual rate of 3.4%) and non-residents (0.4%).

Of the total overnight stays during the year, 50.9% were accounted for in the months between June and September. 74.3% of the total overnight stays were made by non-resident travellers, who represented 64.6% of the total travellers. During the year 2010, positive interannual variations were registered in overnight stays in March and in the period from May to October.

¹ Canarias and the national total are not directly comparable with the data published last year. In order to avoid this break in the series, linking coefficients have been calculated, allowing for comparing the data from different years. The coefficients are published every month on the INE website, in the area dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled "linking coefficients".

Holiday dwellings offered an average of 438,407 bedplaces throughout the year 2010, that is, 1.1% less than in 2009. The occupancy rate by bedplaces reached an average of 37.0%, that is, 2.1% more. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood, on average, at 39.3%, with an interannual increase of 4.0%. In turn, an average of 52.9% of the total available holiday dwellings were occupied, 3.1% more.

The British market consolidated its position as the main country of origin in holiday dwellings. Travellers from the United Kingdom made more than 15.5 million overnight stays, 0.7% less than in 2009. The following country of origin was Germany, with more than 8.5 million overnight stays and an interannual rate of -0.2%.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with 28.9 million overnight stays, 0.7% less than in 2009. The second destination of choice was Illes Balears, with 9.1 million overnight stays, 2.2% more.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Illes Balears and Comunitat Valenciana were the preferred destinations. In turn, Canarias, Comunitat Valenciana and Cataluña were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.

Illes Balears presented the highest occupancy rate, with an average of 63.8% of the available holiday dwellings occupied. It was followed by Canarias (61.2%) and Comunidad de Madrid (59.7%).

By tourist area, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with more than 9.4 million overnight stays. The island of Mallorca reached the highest average occupancy rate (67.1%) of the available holiday dwellings. The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.

During the past month of December, more than 3.3 million overnight stays were registered, 5.5% less than in the same month the previous year. Overnight stays of residents experienced an interannual rise of 1.7%, while those of non-residents decreased 7.0%. The average stay decreased 4.5%, as compared with December 2009.


Holiday Dwelling Price Index Evolution

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered an average decrease² of 1.1% during the year 2010. The *tour-operator and travel agency* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for all of the months (except August), presented an average decrease of 1.3%. By modality, 2/4 bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting exceeded 56.2% every month, decreased their prices an average of 0.2%.


In 2010, the interannual rate of the Holiday Dwelling Price Index remained between -4.6% and 1.4%.

Holiday dwelling prices increased 1.4% **in December**, 1.2 points higher than the rate from the previous month.

Tourist Campsites



Overnight stays at tourist campsites exceeded the figure of 31.0 million in 2010, for an interannual increase of 1.9%. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 0.4%, and those by non-resident travellers increased 3.6%. 70.0% of overnight stays were in the period from June to September.

Tourist campsites offered an average of 485,238 lots, 0.3% more than in 2009. An average of 35.6% of the available lots were occupied, 1.7% less. The average weekend occupancy rate by lots reached 38.6%, that is, 1.4% lower than in 2009.

Dutch, British, French and German citizens accounted for 24.8%, 21.8%, 18.1% and 16.6% of the total overnight stays by non-residents at tourist campsites in 2010, respectively. The Dutch market, which once again was the main country of origin, registered an increase of 5.2% in overnight stays, as compared with 2009.

Cataluña was the preferred destination in tourist campsites, with 13.5 million overnight stays, 1.7% more than in 2009. Comunitat Valenciana was the second destination of choice, with 5.6 million overnight stays, 7.5% more.

Among residents, Cataluña, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana were the preferred destinations. In turn, Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía were the destinations with the most overnight stays by non-resident travellers.

La Rioja reached the highest average occupancy rate for tourist campsites (with 64.1% of the available lots). It was followed by Comunitat Valenciana (50.8%) and Comunidad de Madrid (47.0%).

By tourist area, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with more than 6.3 million overnight stays. Costa Blanca reached the highest average occupancy rate (58.5%).

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays were Benidorm, Salou and Torroella de Montgrí .


During the month of December, 798,466 overnight stays were registered, 1.5% less than in December 2009. Overnight stays by residents increased 0.9% in the interannual rate, whilst those by non-residents decreased 2.7%. The average stay increased 2.7%, standing at 7.6 nights per traveller.

Tourist Campsite Price Index Evolution

The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced an average growth² of 1.1% in 2010. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure every month of the year (except January and February), presented an average increase of 0.7%.

By category, the *luxury and first class* category, with a weighting over 41.0% every month of the year, increased an average of 1.0%.

The interannual rate for the Tourist Campsite Price Index remained between -2.3% and 2.6% throughout the year. The greatest increase was recorded in June.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index presented an interannual rise of 0.7% **in December**, the same rate as the previous month.

Rural Tourism Accommodation


Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation exceeded 7.6 million in 2010, indicating a 3.4% interannual decrease¹. Overnight stays by residents dropped 4.2%, whereas those by non-residents rose 1.0%.

Of the total overnight stays during the year, 49.0% were accounted for in the months between June and September. 83.2% of overnight stays were by resident travellers, who represented 89.2% of the total travellers.


Rural tourism accommodation offered an average of 131,252 bedplaces throughout the year, 3.8% more than in 2009.

The occupancy rate by bedplaces reached an average of 15.8%, that is, 6.9% less than in 2009. The average weekend occupancy rate stood at 26.9%, that is, 5.5% less in interannual rate. The highest occupancy rates were reached during the months of July and August.

Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 1.4 million overnight stays, 4.8% less than in 2009. Cataluña was the second destination of choice, with 901,769 overnight stays, 11.7% less.

Among non-residents, Illes Balears was the preferred destination. In turn, Castilla y León, Cataluña and Principado de Asturias were the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers.

The highest average occupancy rate in rural tourism accommodation was registered in Illes Balears (with 41.0% of the available bedplaces). It was followed by Comunidad Foral de Navarra (23.9%) and País Vasco (23.3%).

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 435,591 overnight stays, and an average occupancy rate of 41.1% of the available bedplaces.

During the month of December, 658,414 overnight stays were registered in rural tourism accommodation, 5.9% more than for the same month the previous year. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 5.9%, and those by non-residents increased 5.4%.


Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index Evolution¹

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index registered an average drop of 1.6%² during the year 2010.

The *weekend* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for every month of the year (except July and August), presented an average decrease of 1.7%. By rent modality, *complete use*, with a weighting over 50.7% every month, decreased an average of 1.5% in price.

The interannual rates of the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index ranged between the -2.7% reached in the month of June and the 0.6% registered in February.

Rural tourist accommodation prices decreased 1.6% **in December**, two tenths more than the rate from the previous month.



² The average interannual variation rates of the year for the HDPI, TCPI and RTAPI have been calculated as the average of the variation rates of the HDPI, TCPI and RTAPI, weighted by the occupied holiday dwellings, occupied lots and occupied rooms-accommodation, respectively, for each month

Annex

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered an **interannual increase of 4.5%* in 2010**. This increase took place among both residents (whose interannual rate stood at 2.4%) and non-residents (6.1%).


In 2010, the average stay decreased 1.0%, standing at 3.7 nights per traveller.



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the year 2010, 73% corresponded to hotels and 27% to non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 25.6% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (with 24.9%) and France (with 7.3%).

Canarias was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 79.6 million overnight stays, 3.4% more than in 2009. It was followed by Cataluña, with more than 65.4 million overnight stays (7.4% more) and Illes Balears, with more than 58.5 million overnight stays (5.7% more).

Canarias, Illes Balears and Cataluña were the destinations preferred by non-residents. In turn, Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
