Hotel Tourism Short-Term Trends (HOS/HPI/IPHS)

August 2017. Provisional data

Overnight stays in hotel establishments increase 0.5% in August as compared with the same month of 2016


Hotels invoice an average of 105.6 euros per occupied room, which means an annual increase of 6.0%

During the month of August, a total of 46.7 million overnight stays were registered in hotel establishments, 0.5% more than in the same month of 2016. Overnight stays of travellers resident in Spain decreased 1.2%, and those of non-residents increased 1.5%.

The average stay decreased 0.5% as compared with August 2016, standing at 3.8 overnight stays per traveller.


During the aggregate July-August period, the number of overnight stays increased 1.0% as compared with the same period of 2016. Overnight stays by residents dropped 1.6%, whilst those by non-residents grew 2.5%.

During the first eight months of 2017, overnight stays increased by 3.1% as compared with the same period of the previous year.




Destinations

Andalucía, Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Galicia were the main destinations of travellers resident in Spain in August, with annual variation rates in the number of overnight stays of -4.5%, -5.5%, -4.1% and 6.5%, respectively.




The main destination chosen by non-residents travellers was Illes Balears, with 33.5% of total overnight stays. In this Autonomous Community, overnight stays by foreign nationals decreased 1.4% as compared to August 2016. The following destinations of non-residents were Cataluña (with 21.4% of the total overnight stays and an increase of 1.6%) and Canarias (with 19.5% of the total and a decrease of 0.1%).

Distribution of overnight stays of guests resident abroad in %




Hotel occupancy

In August, 77.5% of the available bedplaces were covered, with an annual decrease of 0.4%. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces decreased by 0.2%, standing at 80.2%.



Illes Balears showed the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces during August (91.1%). It was followed by Canarias (87.7%) and Comunitat Valenciana (81.2%).

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca reached the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (91.9%), and Palma-Calvià registered the highest weekend occupancy rate (93.9%). La Costa del Sol registered the highest number of overnight stays, with 2.4 million.


The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Barcelona, Madrid and Calvià. Formentera showed the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (97.5%) and Pollença the greatest weekend occupancy rate (97.4%).

Overnight stays according to the country of origin of the travellers

In August, travellers from the United Kingdom and Germany concentrated 25.7% and 19.7% of total overnight stays of non-residents in hotel establishments, respectively. The British market decreased by 3.9% and the German by 5.0%.

Overnight stays of travellers from France, Italy, and Netherlands (the following countries of origin) registered annual rates of -5.4%, -2.2% and 7.1% respectively.

Hotel Prices

The annual rate of the Hotel Price Index (HPI) stood at 6.5% in August, which is 0.4 points less than that of the previous month and 0.3 points below that registered a year ago.

Illes Balears, Cataluña, Andalucía and Canarias were the most heavily weighted Autonomous Communities in the HPI in August (accounting for 76.6% of the total weight). Hotel prices increased by 9.7% in the annual rate in Cataluña, 7.2% in Illes Balears, 6.6% in Canarias and 4,5% in Andalucía.

By hotel category, hotel prices increased in all of them. In two-golden-star establishments (7.8%), in three-golden-star establishments (7.7%), in one-golden-star establishments (7.4%), in four-golden-star establishments (6.3%), in one-silver-star establishments (5.5%), in three and two-silver-star establishments (4.7%) and in five-golden-star establishments (4.2%).

Profitability of the Hotel Sector


The average daily rate per occupied room (ADR) of hotels was 105.6 euros in August, which indicates an increase of 6.0% as compared with the same month of 2016.

Meanwhile, the average daily income per room available (RevPAR), which is conditioned by the occupancy registered in hotel establishments, reached 83.9 euros, with an increase of 6.4%.


By category, the average invoicing was 228.4 euros for five-star hotels, 116.9 euros for four-star hotels and 91.9 euros for three-star hotels. Income per available room for these same categories were 172.5, 99.9 and 78.0 euros, respectively.
