**Hotel Tourism Short-Term Trends (HOS/HPI/HII)  
November 2009. Provisional data**

**Overnight stays at hotel establishments decrease 3.6%\* in November, as compared with the same month in 2008**

**The interannual rate of hotel prices decreases 6.5%**

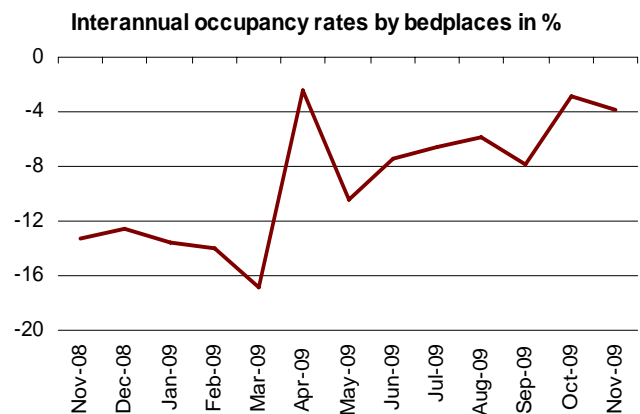
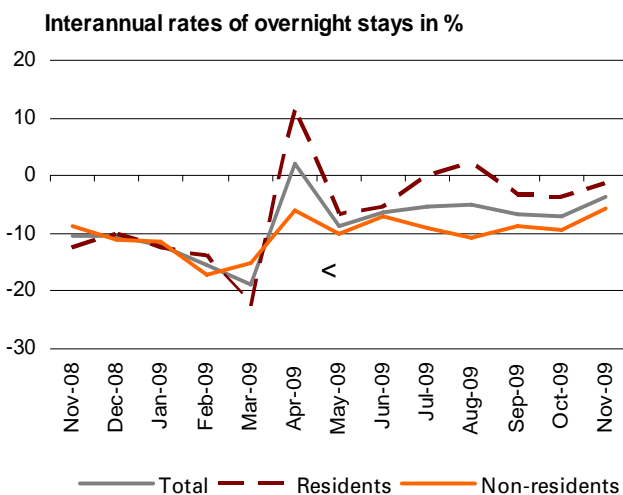
During the month of November, 13.3 million overnight stays were recorded in hotel establishments, indicating a 3.6% decrease as compared with the same month in 2008. A 1.5% decrease in overnight stays was recorded for residents in Spain, while the rate for non-residents presented a decrease of 5.6%.

**The average stay decreased 0.8%** as compared with November 2008, standing at 2.8 nights per guest.

During the first eleven months of the year, overnight stays decreased 6.9%, as compared with the same period the previous year.

In turn, the **Hotel Price Index (HPI) registered a decrease of 6.5%** in the month of November, with a rate 4.6 points lower than that recorded the same month of 2008.

**During the month of November, 40.1% of the available bedplaces were filled**, indicating a decrease of 3.9% as compared with the same month the previous year. **The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces was 45.7%**, with an interannual decrease of 0.3%.



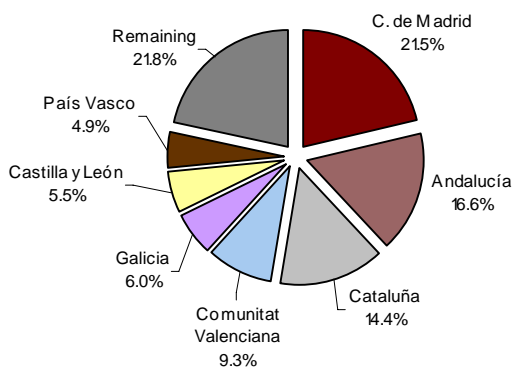
\* Due to the update made in the directory of hotel establishments in Canarias, the data published as of June 2009 (for Canarias and the national total) cannot be directly compared to those published last year. To bridge this gap in the series, some link coefficients have been calculated to allow users to compare data from different years. The coefficients will be published monthly on the INE website in the section dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled link coefficients.

**Overnight stays of German and British citizens decrease**

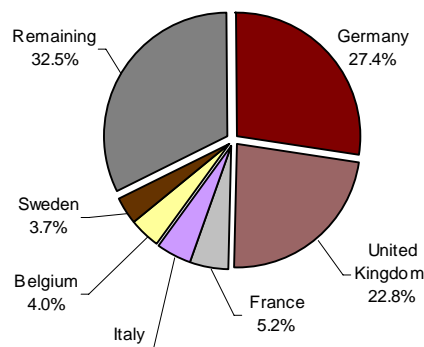
Guests from Germany and the United Kingdom made 3.4 million overnight stays in November, accounting for 50.2% of the total for non-residents. The German market experienced a 9.0% interannual decrease in its overnight stays, whereas the British market experienced a 13.8% decrease.

Overnight stays of guests from France, Italy and Belgium (the following countries of origin) registered interannual rates of -1.2%, -1.3% and -18.2%, respectively.

**Overnight stays of guests resident abroad by country of origin in %**

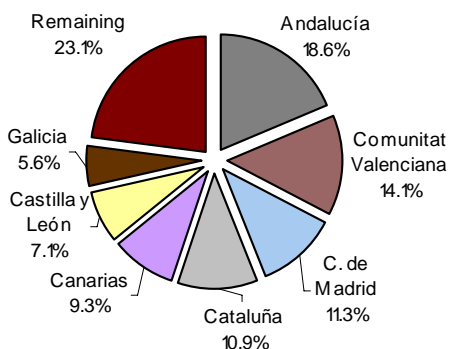


**Canarias is the preferred destination for non-resident guests**

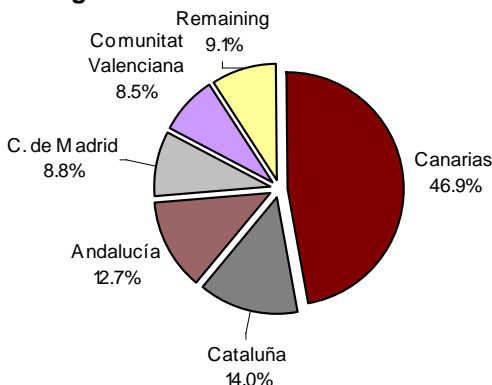
The main destination chosen by non-residents was Canarias. In this Autonomous Community, the overnight stays by foreign nationals, representing 46.9% of the national total, decreased 7.5% as compared with November 2008. The following destinations were Cataluña, with an interannual rate of 4.5%, and Andalucía, with a rate of -10.3%.

Andalucía, Comunitat Valenciana and Comunidad de Madrid were the main destinations chosen by guests resident in Spain, with interannual rates for overnight stays of -2.4%, 1.8% and 0.9%, respectively.

### Canarias reaches the highest occupancy rate in the month of November

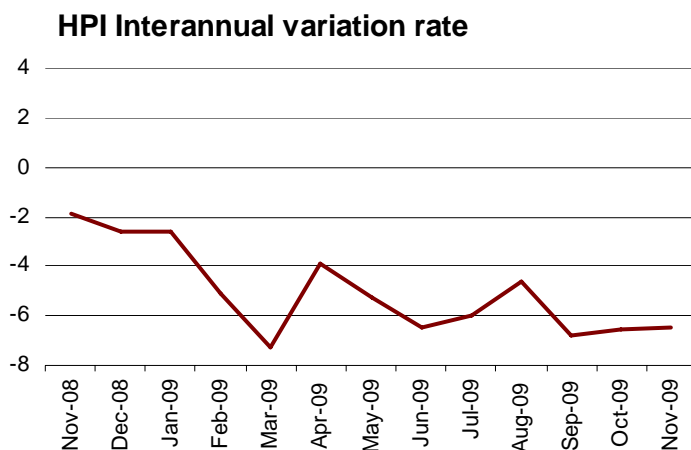
During the month of November, Canarias was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (62.1%), ahead of Comunidad de Madrid (44.2%) and Comunitat Valenciana (43.7%).

The **tourist areas** with the highest occupancy and overnight stay rates were located on the islands and the coasts. The island of Gran Canaria reached the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (70.9%) and the highest weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces (71.8%). The island of Tenerife registered the highest number of overnight stays in November, with more than 1.5 million.

The **tourist sites** with the highest number of overnight stays were Madrid, Barcelona and San Bartolomé de Tirajana. In turn, San Bartolomé de Tirajana had the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (73.9%), and recorded the highest weekend occupancy rate (74.3%).

### Hotel prices register an interannual rate of -6.5%

The interannual decrease of the HPI stood at -6.5% in November, 4.6 points lower than that registered the same month the previous year.



### Decrease in prices in all of the Autonomous Communities

Canarias, Comunidad de Madrid, Cataluña and Andalucía were the most relevant Autonomous Communities within the HPI in November, with a combined weight of 69.5% of the index. All of them registered negative interannual rates in November.

Canarias, which carried the greatest load in the weighting structure this month (25.3%), showed an interannual rate of -5.9%, that is, 0.9 points lower than the rate estimated in October. Hotel prices experienced a decrease of -11.6% in Comunidad de Madrid, as compared with the -11.7% registered the previous month. Cataluña showed an interannual rate of -9.8%, as compared with -9.0% the previous month. In Andalucía, the interannual rate was -2.7%, that is, 0.5 points higher than that obtained the previous month.

### Hotel prices decrease in all of the categories, as compared with the previous year

Prices of one-silver-star hotels were the only ones to increase in November as compared with the same month the previous year (0.8%).

By category, the most important decreases in November were recorded in five-gold-star (-10.1%) and four-gold-star (-6.8%) hotels. They were followed by three-gold-star (-6.3%) and one-silver-star (-3.1%) hotels.

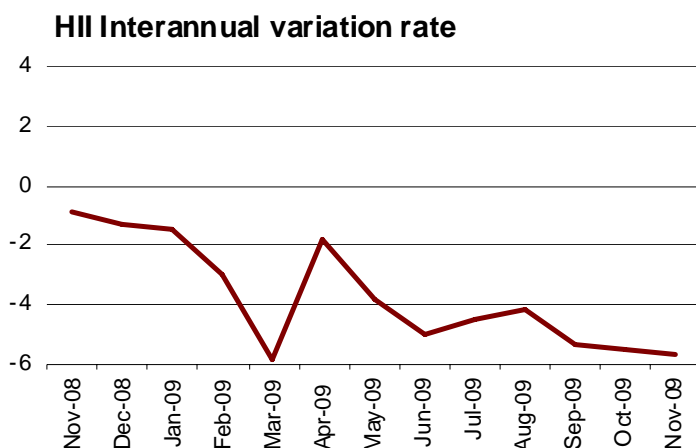
The remaining categories also showed negative interannual rates: three and two-silver-star (-2.9%) and two-gold-star (-2.1%) establishments.

### The interannual rate of the HII decreases 5.7% in November

The Hotel Income Index (HII), which unlike the HPI, also considers the variation in the structure, reflected an interannual rate of income received per occupied room of -5.7% in November. This rate was 0.3 points below that obtained the previous month, and 4.8 points lower than the rate registered one year ago.

The four Autonomous Communities with the greatest weight in this indicator, Canarias, Andalucía, Cataluña, and Comunidad de Madrid, presented negative interannual rates (-6.9%, -3.5%, -7.6% and -10.6%, respectively).

**Income per occupied room** decreased in all categories. The most moderate decreases were recorded in one-silver-star (-1.0%), two-gold-star (-1.4%) and one-gold-star (-1.6%) establishments. Three- and two-silver-star hotels registered a -1.9% variation rate, three-gold-star hotels registered -6.1% and four-gold-star hotels registered -6.9%. The most significant decrease was found in the five-gold-star category, with an 8.6% decrease as compared with November 2008.



## Methodological note 2009

### Hotel Price Index - Hotel Income Index Base change to 2008

Since the year 2000, the INE has been publishing the Hotel Price Index (HPI) and the Hotel Income Index (HII), compiled with the information that hotel businesspersons include in a specific section of the Hotel Occupancy Survey questionnaire.

The changes occurring in the sector in recent years encouraged the introduction of certain modifications in said section of the questionnaire, from January 2008 onwards. With these changes, we hope, on the one hand, **to collect the new distribution channels favoured by generalised Internet use**, and on the other hand, **to adapt the questionnaire to the terms and concepts that are most frequently used within the sector**, as well as to the data available in the business management systems themselves.

In order to introduce all of the new information collected in the new questionnaire model in the computation of these indicators in a precise way, it is necessary to carry out a base change. For this reason, starting from January 2009, the Hotel Price Index and the Hotel Income Index shall be published in base 2008.

A base change in an indicator implies a break in the historical series, preventing, in this case, the comparison, as of January 2009, with the indices from previous periods. **So as to avoid this break, and maintain temporal comparability, the series published until December 2008 have been linked.**
