Hotel Tourism Short-Term Trends (HOS/HPI/IPHS) November 2017 Provisional data


Overnight stays in hotel establishments register an increase of 2.1% in November, as compared with the same month of 2016

Hotels invoice an average of 79.6 euros per occupied room, representing an annual increase of 4.0%

During the month of November, more than 17 million overnight stays were registered in hotel establishments, 2.1% more than in the same month of 2016. Overnight stays by travellers resident in Spain increased by 3.5% and those of non-residents did so by 1.3%.

The average stay decreased 2.7% as compared with November 2016, standing at 2.9 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first 11 months of 2017, overnight stays increased 2.8%, as compared with the same period of the previous year.




Annual rates of overnight stays in %


Destinations

Andalucía, Comunidad de Madrid, Comunitat Valenciana and Cataluña were the main destinations of travellers resident in Spain in November, with annual variation rates in the number of overnight stays of 2.1%, 5.2%, 0.6% and -4.1%, respectively.





The main destination chosen by non-residents was Canarias, with 48.8% of total overnight stays. In this Autonomous Community, overnight stays of foreigners increased by 0.4% as compared with November 2016. The following destinations of non-residents were Cataluña (with 13.5% of the total overnight stays and a decrease of 7.3%) and Andalucía (with 12.9% of the total and an increase of 5.7%).




Distribution of overnight stays of guests resident abroad in %



Hotel occupancy

In November, 50.6% of the available bedplaces were occupied, indicating an annual increase of 1.7%. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces increased 2.5%, and stood at 58.8%.



Canarias showed the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces in November (77.6%). It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (58.6%) and Comunitat Valenciana (52.8%).


By tourist areas, the South of Gran Canaria reached both the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (80.8%), and the highest weekend occupancy rate (82.3%). The island of Tenerife registered the highest number of overnight stays, with more than 1.9 million.

The tourist spots with more overnight stays were Madrid, Barcelona and San Bartolomé de Tirajana. The latter presented both the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (82.1%), as the highest weekend occupancy rate (83.7%).

Overnight stays according to the country of origin of the travellers

Travellers from the United Kingdom and Germany accounted for 22.4% and 21.3%, respectively, of total overnight stays of non-residents in hotel establishments. The British market fell by 3.4%, while the German rose by 1.0%.

Overnight stays by travellers from France, Sweden and Italy (the following issuing markets) recorded annual rates of 1.4%, -3.2% and -1.1%, respectively.




Distribution of overnight stays of residents abroad from the main countries in %

Hotel Prices

The annual rate of the Hotel Price Index (HPI) stood at 4.5% in November, which is 1.1 points less than the previous month and 0.3 points below that registered a year ago.

In November, Canarias, Cataluña, Comunidad de Madrid and Andalucía were the Autonomous Communities with the greatest weighting in the HPI (they represented 76.7% of the total weight). Hotel prices increased by 8.3% in the annual rate in Comunidad de Madrid, 6.6% in Canarias and 2,7% in Andalucía. In turn, they decreased by 0.5% in Cataluña.

By category, hotel prices increased in all of them. In one-gold-star establishments (9.6%), in three-gold-star establishments (6.3%), in one-silver-star establishments (4.8%), in four-gold-star (4.5%), in three and two-silver-star establishments (3.8%), in two-gold-star establishments (2.8%) and in five-gold-star establishments (2.1%).


Profitability of the Hotel Sector

The average daily rate per occupied room (ADR) of hotels was 79.6 euros in November, representing an increase of 4.0% as compared with the same month of 2016.

Meanwhile, the average daily revenue per available room (RevPAR), which is conditioned by the occupancy registered in hotel establishments, reached 47.8 euros, with an increase of 7.3%.


By category, the average invoicing was 166.3 euros for five-star hotels, 85.6 euros for fourstar hotels and 61.9 euros for three-star hotels. Income per available room for these same categories were 108.9, 59.6 and 39.5 euros, respectively.
