

Organic Law 5/1985 of 19 June on the General Electoral System and its modifications. Article 24

Article 24.

1. The Provincial Delegations of the Electoral Census Office shall determine the number, limits of electoral sections, the corresponding premises and polling station officials.
2. The previous list shall be published in the province's "Official Gazette" on the sixth day following the call to vote and shall be displayed to the public in the respective town councils.
3. In the following six days, voters shall be able to make complaints against the demarcation undertaken, before the Provincial Electoral Board, which shall comment on these complaints within a period of five days.
4. Within the ten days prior to voting, the definitive list of sections, polling station officials and polling stations shall be published in the province's two main newspapers and shall be displayed to the public in the respective town councils.
5. Town councils should indicate the premises corresponding to each section and polling station.
