

Organic Law 5/1985 of 19 June on the General Electoral System and its modifications

Article 85.

- 1.- The right to vote is achieved via registration in the certified copies of the census lists or by specific census certification and, in both cases, by identifying the voter, which will be done using the national identity card, passport or driving license in which a photo of the holder appears, or, when dealing with foreigners, using the residence card.
- 2.- The certified copies of the census lists referred to in the previous paragraph shall only contain citizens of legal age on the voting date.
- 3.- Likewise, those people who prove their right to vote by being registered in the section census and showing the corresponding judicial decision may also vote.
