

Employment of Persons with Disabilities ¹ Year 2016

Main results

- The number of persons aged between 16 and 64 years old, residents of family homes and with officially recognized disability in 2016 was 1,840,700. This figure represents 6.1% of the Spanish working age population.
- 35.2% of persons with officially recognized disability were active, 1.3 percentage points higher than in 2015. This rate of activity was 42.8 percentage points lower than that of the population without disability.
- The unemployment rate for the group was 28.6% in 2016, a decrease of 2.4 percentage points from the previous year. This rate was 9.1 percentage points higher than the population without disability.
- The employment rate of persons with disability was 25.1%, an increase of 1.7 percentage points over 2015. 88.0% of those employed were salaried employees and, of these, 76.2% had an indefinite contract.
- 28.9% of people with disabilities who paid contributions to Social Security had some sort of reduction/bonus in contributions, which was 0.1 percentage points more than in 2015. The percentage of salaried employees with specific disability contracts was 28.7%.

Characteristics of the economically active population with disabilities

In 2016, there was a total of 1,840,700 working age (from 16 to 64 years) persons with certified disabilities, accounting for 6.1% of the total working age population.

In the following sections we analyse the employment situation of the group of people with disabilities who participate in the labour market (active), comparing this group with the rest of the population. Given that this comparison may have an impact on other personal characteristics, in addition to disability, first we present an overview of the active population characteristics, with and without disabilities.

In the active population with disabilities, a greater percentage of men was observed in 2016, more weight in the 45 to 64 year age group, and less representation of people with higher education than in the active population without disability. The latter may be the reason for some difference between both populations, especially in the employment rate.

Compared to the population of employed persons without disabilities, those employed with disabilities present the same differences in regard to sex, age and educational level as those indicated for the active populations.

The distribution by duration of the contract was similar in both groups, with the exception that the percentage of employed persons in the 'three and more years' division was slightly higher in persons with disabilities, to the detriment of the other contract duration intervals.

In terms of branches of activity, those employed with disabilities were better represented in the *Health and Social Services Activities* and in *Administrative Activities and Auxiliary Services*.

Regarding unemployment, the population with disabilities had a higher percentage of men, of people aged 45 to 64, and of unemployed with primary education compared to those unemployed without disabilities. On the other hand, there were fewer unemployed people with higher education and aged 16 to 24 years.

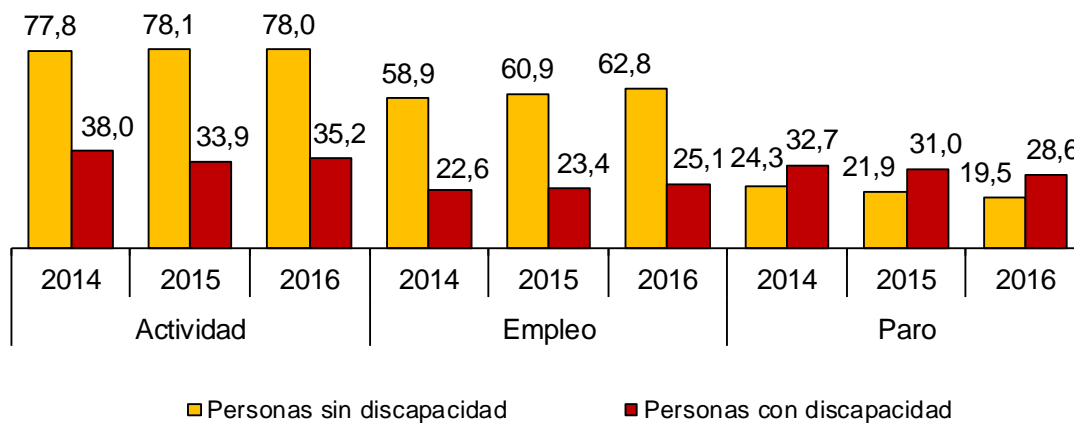

Activity, employment and unemployment rates

The most notable detail regarding the group of persons with disabilities is their low rate of participation in the labour market.

In 2016, there were 647,200 active persons with disabilities, with an activity rate of 35.2%, more than 42 percentage points lower than the population without disabilities (78.0%). This rate grew slightly compared to 2015.

Evolución de las tasa de actividad, empleo y paro (%)



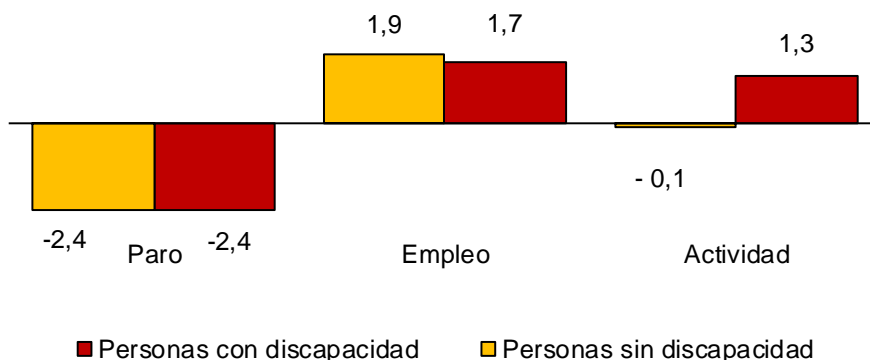
The number of working persons with disabilities in 2016 was 462,000. The employment rate was 25.1%, more than 37 percentage points lower than that for persons without disabilities. This rate grew 1.7 percentage points compared to 2015.

The number of persons with disabilities who were unemployed was 185,200. The unemployment rate exceeded the non-disabled population by more than nine percentage points (28.6% compared to 19.5%). The decrease in the unemployment rate when compared to 2015 was the same as the decrease for the non-disabled population.

Of the 462,000 persons employed with disabilities in 2016, 267,500 were men (57.9%) and 194,500 were women (42.1%).

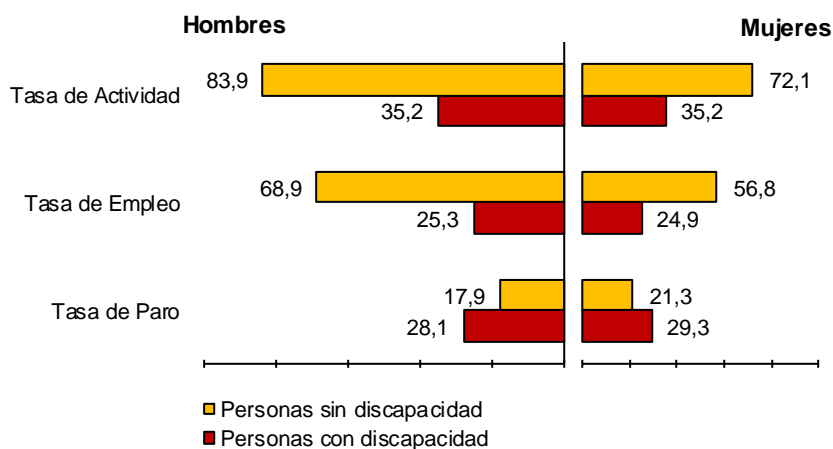

Women with disabilities had the same rate of activity as men in 2016 (35.2%), in contrast to the non-disabled population, where men were more active than women.

The employment rate of men with disabilities was 0.4 percentage points higher than the rate for women. For the rest of the 16 to 64 year old population, the difference was 12.1 percentage points.

On the other hand, the unemployment rate for women with disabilities (29.3%) was higher than the rate for the men (28.1%). The rate for women without disabilities was also higher, by about 3.4 percentage points.

The trends in the employment rates for both sexes were positive when compared to 2015. Thus, there was an increase of 2.1 percentage points in the case of women with disabilities and 1.5 points in the case of men. The employment rates for persons without disabilities also increased to a greater extent for men and to a lesser extent for women.

Moreover, unemployment rates decreased for both men with disabilities (2.8 percentage points less than in 2015) and for women (1.8 percentage points less). Unemployment also declined in the group of people without disabilities, with the decrease for women being more pronounced than that observed in the case of women with disabilities.

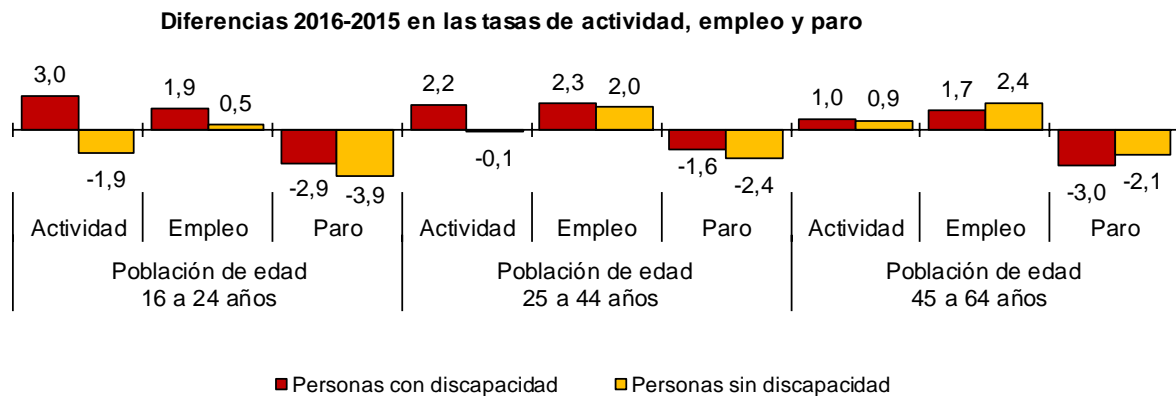
Disability and labour market, by age

In 2016, there was a higher rate of unemployment in the youngest population, while the highest activity rates were in the group of 25 to 44 years old, both for people with disabilities and for the rest of the population.

It should be noted that there was an increase in the activity rate (3.0 percentage points), and a decrease in the unemployment rate (2.9 percentage points) for young people with disabilities when compared to 2015.

In the 25 to 44 year-old age group, unemployment decreased by 1.6 percentage points for persons with disabilities, while the rest of the population decreased 2.4 percentage points.

In the 45 to 64 year-old age group, the unemployment rate dropped three percentage points for persons with disabilities, while the rest of the population decreased 2.1 points. In this age group, both the activity rate and the employment rate increase.



Evolución de la actividad por grupos de edad (%)

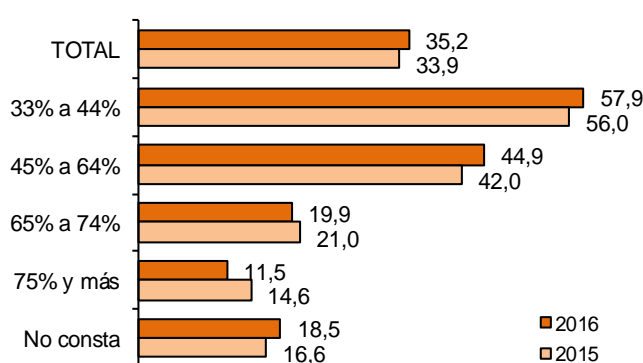

Disability and labour market, by type of disability

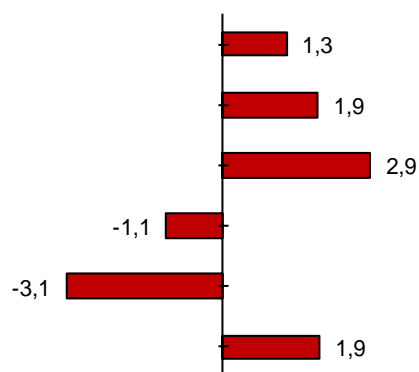
Participation in the labour market is heavily determined by the type and intensity of the disability. The activity rate for the less intense degrees of disability (less than 45%) was 57.9% in 2016 and progressively decreased to 11.5% for the highest degree of disability.

Compared to 2015, there was a decrease in the groups with degrees of disability greater than 65%. The greatest growth was in the group of 45% to 64% disability.

Diferencias 2016-2015

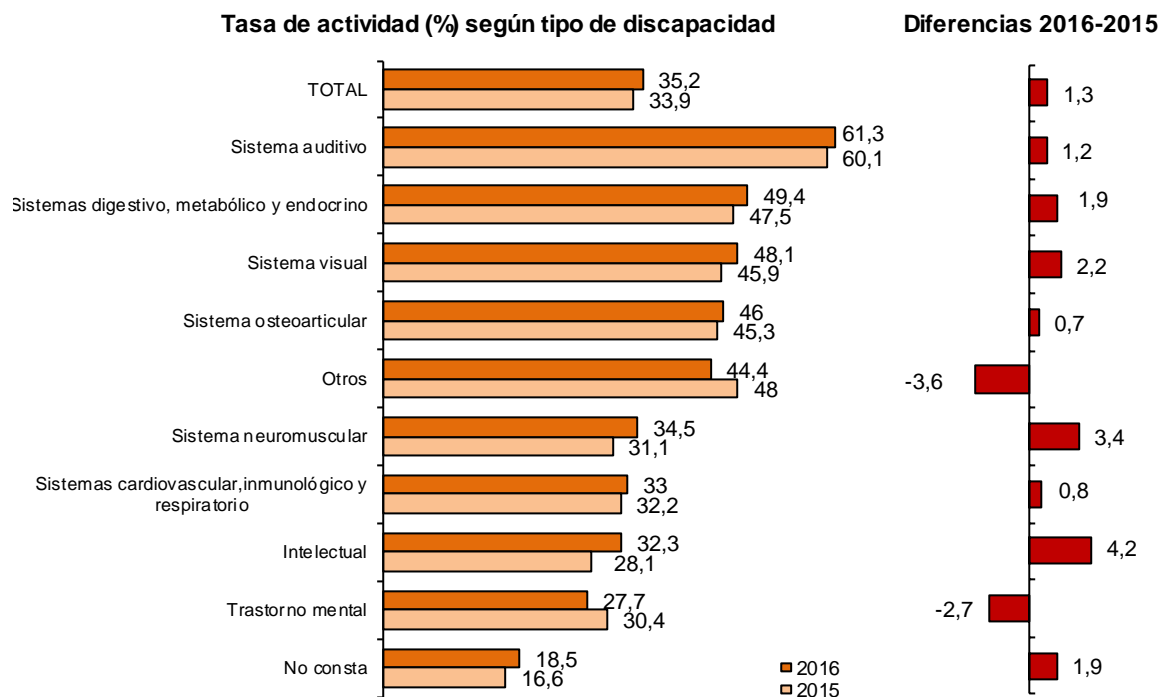

Persons with hearing deficiencies showed the highest activity rates (61.3%) and those with mental deficiencies had the lowest (27.7%).

Regarding the evolution with respect to 2015, the increases in the activity rates of the disability groups associated with the *Neuromuscular and Intellectual System* are worth mentioning.

On the contrary, the decrease in the activity rate is notable in the disability groups associated with *Mental disorders and Others*.

Labour Characteristics and disability

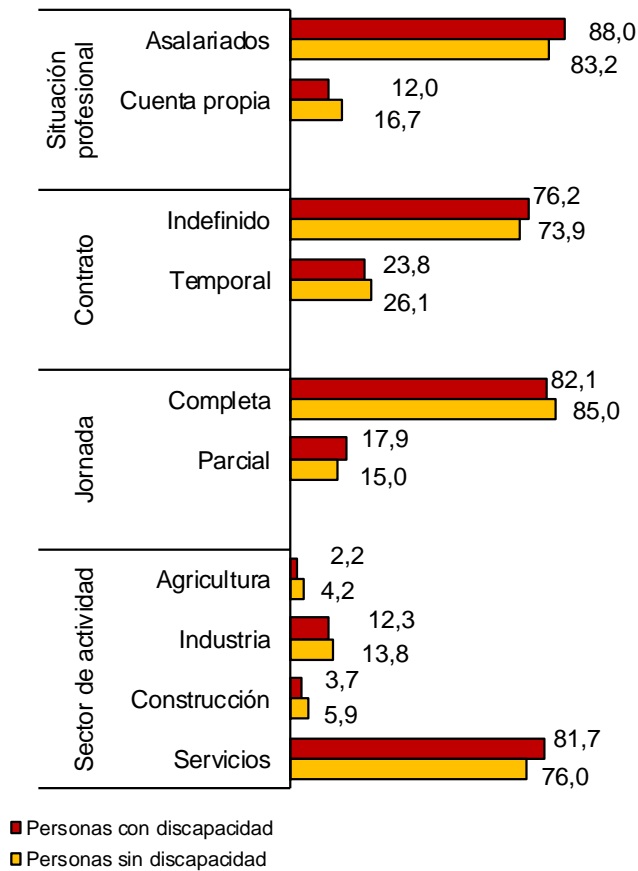
The majority of workers with disabilities were salaried, had indefinite contracts, full-time, and worked in the *Service* sector.

Thus, 88.0% of persons with disabilities who worked in 2016 did so as salaried employees (4.8 percentage points higher than persons without disabilities). 76.2% of them had indefinite contracts (2.3 percentage points higher than the non-disabled population).

82.1% of those employed with disabilities worked full-time, a lower proportion than workers without disabilities (2.9 percentage points less).

81.7% of those employed with disabilities worked in the *Service sector*, compared to 76.0% of those without disabilities.

Measures encouraging participation in the ordinary labour market ²

Among the policies intended to promote this group's participation in the labour market are those that favour their entry into ordinary employment. Notable policies include the reductions and discounts in contribution quotas, both for salaried workers and self-employed. And, in the case of salaried workers, the modality of specific hiring for workers with disabilities, in addition to entailing bonuses in the contribution quotas to Social Security, includes certain subsidies.

28.9% of people with disabilities who paid contributions to Social Security in 2016 had some sort of reduction/bonus in contributions, 0.1 percentage points less than in 2015.

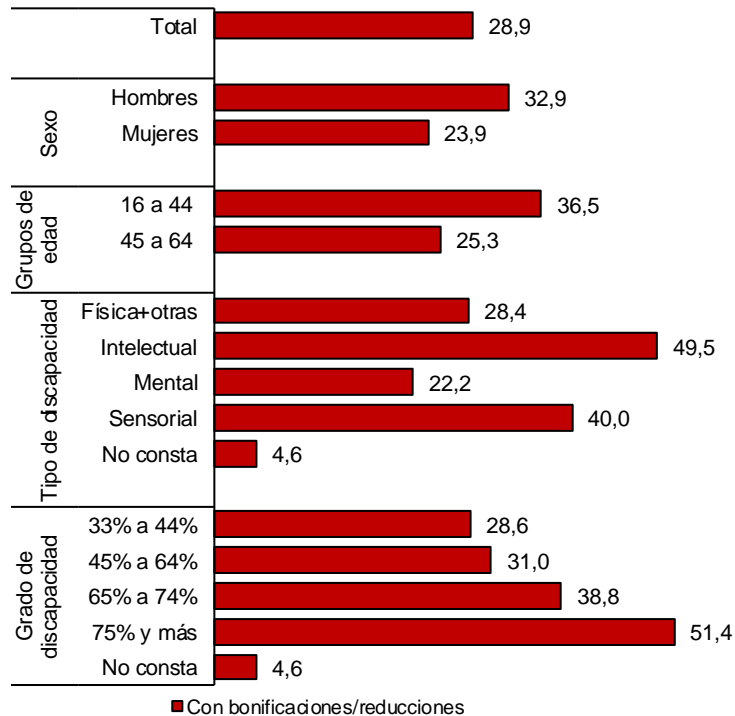
In 2016, the percentage of salaried workers with disabilities with this specific labour contract for disabilities decreased to 28.7%.

The reductions and discounts in the contribution quotas and the specific hiring benefited, above all, the male population, the 16-44 year age group, the disability group associated with sensory and intellectual deficiencies and persons with higher degrees of disability (75% and higher).

The group "No evidence" consists of pensioners who have a recognised permanent disability pension and are not registered in the BEPD.

Disability and economic activity protection

Public Social Benefits are pensions and subsidies paid from public resources whose purpose is to cover situations of disability, retirement, death and survival, family protection, unemployment for people over 52 and other statutory improvements and complementary benefits. Therefore, they are an important tool for the disabled population.

Of every 100 persons of working age, 13 received a benefit in 2016. In the specific case of persons with disabilities, the Public Benefit System helped 1,238,700 people (67 out of every 100). Of them, 20.8% (257,100 persons) were active.

Among persons with disabilities receiving benefits, 81.8% (1,012,900) received the benefit due to a work disability.

On the other hand, 2.0% (24,200) of people with disabilities who received a benefit did so exclusively in non-contributory terms, that is, without having previously contributed for them.

Another measure of protection for the group of people with disabilities is the recognition of the Situation of Dependency, after the approval of *Law 39/2006 of December 14, Promotion of Personal Autonomy and Care for people in situations of dependency*.

In 2016, 13.8% of persons with disabilities (253,700) were also officially recognized as in situations of dependency. Of these, 20,700 (8.2% of persons with dependent disabilities) were active in the labour market.

Personas con discapacidad según dependencia oficialmente reconocida. Año 2016

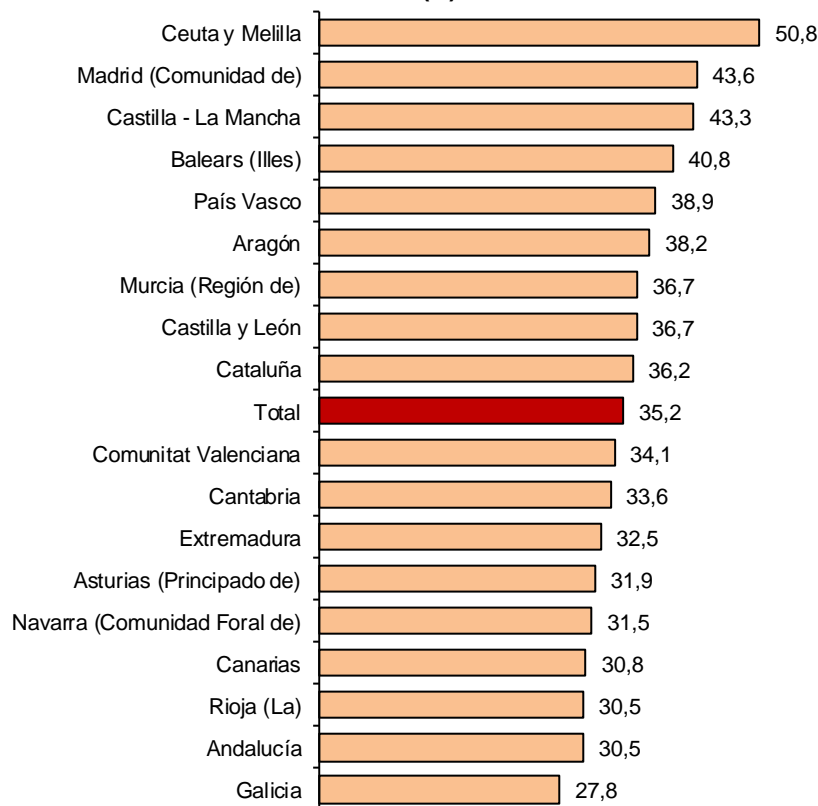

Disability and economic activity, by Autonomous Cities and Communities

The highest activity rates within the group of persons with disabilities in 2016 were in the Community of Madrid (43.6%), Castilla-La Mancha (43.3%) and in the autonomous cities of Ceuta and Melilla (50.8%).

On the other hand, the lowest activity rates were seen in Galicia (27.8%), Andalucía and La Rioja (30.5% in both).

Methodological note

The Employment of Persons with Disabilities (EPD) investigates the situation regarding the labour market of the group of officially recognized persons with disabilities who have a degree of disability greater than or equal to 33%. It focuses on people of working age, that is, with ages between 16 and 64 years.

By virtue of Royal Legislative Decree 1/2013, which approved the Consolidated Text of the “General Law on rights for persons with disabilities and their social inclusion”, social security pensioners who also have a recognized disability pension to the degree of total, long-term or severe disability will be considered as having a degree of disability greater than or equal to 33%, and state pensioners who have a retirement pension or retirement due to permanent incapacity or unfitness for work.

As a result of this Royal Decree, since 2015, the population scope of Employed Persons with Disabilities has included this group. This change supposes a rupture in the Employment of the People with Disability data series, which is the reason why the already published results of 2014 have been recalculated, including this new group to provide a measure of the change.

The EPD is contemplated in the National Statistical Plan and in the Annual Programs. This operation is carried out based on the information provided by the IMSERSO and Social Security, bodies to which the INE is grateful for their collaboration, as well as the Ministry of Health, Social Services and Equality, and the Spanish Committee of Representatives of Persons with Disabilities (CERMI) and the ONCE Foundation, entities that contributed to the completion of the first editions of the EPD.

The Employment of People with Disabilities integrates the statistical data provided by the Active Population Survey (EPA) with the administrative data recorded in the State Database of People with Disabilities (BEPD) of the IMSERSO. It also includes data on employment promotion measures from the General Social Security Treasury (TGSS), information on benefits received from the Registry of Public Social Benefits of the National Social Security Institute (INSS) and data dependence from the System for the Autonomy and Support for Dependent Persons (SAAD).
