Elections to the European Parliament of June 2009

More than 1.9 million EU citizens will be able to vote in Spain in the elections to the European Parliament of 2009

In order to vote, EU citizens must previously express their wish to exercise this right in Spain

The Electoral Census Office has registered, from the municipal registers, a total of 1,905,340 citizens of the European Union (EU) resident in Spain who may exercise the right to vote in Spain in the elections to the European Parliament of June 2009.

In accordance with community and Spanish electoral regulations, for these EU citizens to be able to vote in Spain, they must previously opt to do so:

- A. 201,100 nationals from European Union countries, not Spaniards, have previously expressed their wish to vote in Spain in the elections to the European Parliament. Their expression of said wish is permanent in nature, by which they may vote in the elections of June 2009 without the need for further paperwork. The electoral census office has informed these electors of this circumstance.
- B. For the remaining 1,705,240 community citizens, if they wish to vote in Spain, they must express their will to exercise this right. In order to facilitate this paperwork, the Electoral Census Office is sending them a communication that includes a formal statement and response form, which does not need a stamp.

Community citizens who are not recorded in the municipal register of inhabitants of their municipality of residence must register at their Municipal Council. At that time, if they so desire, they may fill out the formal statement form, which will be provided to them at the Municipal Council itself.

Distribution by province and nationality

By province, the greatest presence of citizens of European Union countries is found in Madrid (with 294,669 possible electors), Alicante (247,372), Barcelona (145,502) and Málaga (127,895).

By country of nationality, adult residents exceeding 150,000 hail from: Rumania (651,311), the United Kingdom (320,445) and Germany (170,185).
