#### Elections to the European Parliament on 7 June 2009

## A total 35,510,837 voters will be able to vote in the elections to the European Parliament on 7 June 2009

# The electoral census will be available for consultation from 20 to 27 April

This coming 7 June, 35,510,837 voters will be able to vote in the elections to the European Parliament. Of this total, 33,974,358 are Spaniards resident in Spain, 1,254,724 are Spaniards resident abroad and 281,755 are citizens from other countries of the European Union.

#### Queries on the electoral census and claims from 20 to 27 April

The electoral census will be available for consultation from 20 to 27 April 2009 in municipal councils and in the provincial delegations of the Electoral Census Office. Voters resident abroad may check their registration data, during this same period, at the respective consulates.

Queries at municipal councils may be made electronically, once the interested party has provided identification, or through the physical posting of the voting lists, if said electronic means are not available.

The **claims period**, if any error or omission is noticed regarding the data contained in the electoral census, **will run from 20 to 27 April**. Claims shall be submitted at municipal councils, consulates or the provincial delegations of the Electoral Census Office.

#### Census cards

The Electoral Census Office has issued all voters resident in Spain with a census card that indicates the corresponding polling station, as well as the voting premises and address.

Voters who find an error in the data reflected in the census card may submit a claim, to the corresponding municipal council, between 20 and 27 April.

### **Voters from other countries of the European Union**

Citizens from member countries of the European Union, who are resident in Spain and who have expressed their intention to vote in Spain, may vote in these elections.

In order to enable this expression of will, in October 2008, the Electoral Census Office contacted all those persons registered in the municipal registers, who would be of legal age on the day of the elections.

#### **Internet Queries**

The website of the National Statistics Institute (http://www.ine.es) offers information regarding the electoral census, with data of interest: the current census, claims, postal voting, deadlines, legal regulations, and figures for registered persons.

All voters may consult polling station and voting premises data. Likewise, voters holding an acknowledged digital certificate may consult their registration data in the electoral census.

In addition, in these elections, those voters who request the postal vote may track the processing of their application.
