Register of Spaniards Resident Abroad

More than 1.57 million Spaniards are resident abroad at 1 January 2010

Argentina, France and Venezuela, the foreign countries in which the most persons of Spanish nationality are resident

The number of persons of Spanish nationality who were resident abroad reached 1,574,123, according to data from the Register of Spaniards Resident Abroad (RSRA), dated 1 January 2010. 51.1% of this figure was female, and 48.9% was male.

By continent, 60.1% of the persons registered in the RSRA had affixed residence in America, 36.9% in Europe and 3.0% in the rest of the world.

40.3% of Spaniards resident abroad were born in Spain, 54.1% were born in their current country of residence, and 4.5% in other countries.

Considering age, 14.3% of those registered in the RSRA were under 16 years of age, 61.3% were between 16 and 64 years of age, and 24.5% were aged 65 years old or over.

By continent, 53.4% of the persons under the age of 16 were resident in America and 41.8% in Europe. These percentages were similar to those for the group aged 16 to 64 years old (57.1% were resident in America and 39.8% in Europe). It is worth noting that **71.6% of the persons over 65 years of age were resident in America.**
