**Elections to the European Parliament on 25 May 2014****A total of 36,546,270 voters will be able to vote in the elections to the European Parliament on 25 May 2014****The electoral census will be available for consultation from 7 to 14 April**

This coming 25 May, 36,546,270 voters will be able to vote in the elections to the European Parliament. Of this total, 34,485,294 are Spaniards resident in Spain, 1,724,390 are Spaniards resident abroad and 336,586 are citizens from other countries of the European Union, resident in Spain and willing to vote in Spain.

**Queries on the electoral census and claims from 7 to 14 April**

The electoral census will be available for consultation from 7 to 14 April 2014 in municipal councils and in the provincial delegations of the Electoral Census Office. Voters resident abroad may check their registration data, during this same period, at the respective consulates.

The claims period, if any error or omission is noticed regarding the data contained in the electoral census, will run from 7 to 14 April. Claims shall be submitted at municipal councils, consulates or the provincial delegations of the Electoral Census Office.

**Census cards**

From 28 April onward, the Electoral Census Office has issued all voters resident in Spain with a census card that indicates the corresponding polling station, as well as the voting premises and address.

### **Internet Queries**

The website of the Electoral Census Office of the National Statistics Institute (<http://www.ine.es>) offers information regarding the electoral census, with data of interest: the current census, claims, postal voting, deadlines, legal regulations, and figures for registered persons.

The electronic office of the National Statistics Institute, <https://sede.ine.gob.es> offers information regarding the polling stations, voting premises and address by municipality, entering different search criteria.

Likewise, voters holding an acknowledged digital certificate may consult their registration data in the electoral census and they can also consult information regarding the polling station and voting premise where they should vote.

In addition, those voters who request the postal vote may track the processing of their application without needing a digital certificate.

### **Voter query processing**

The provincial delegations of the Electoral Census Office shall answer those queries activities of their jurisdiction (registration in the census, polling stations and electoral premises, census cards, postal vote, etc.) at their offices and by calling the following phone number 901 101 900.
