Municipal elections on 24 May 2015

EU citizens may vote in the municipal elections if they express their wish to exercise that right in Spain

The deadline for expressing the wish to vote in the next municipal elections finishes on 30 December 2014.

The Electoral Census Office has sent a communication to 422,008 EU citizens to enable the paperwork

Citizens who are nationals of other countries of the European Union (EU) and are aged 18 years old or more on that day may vote in the municipal elections of 24 May 2015.

In order to vote it is a requirement to have expressed one's wish to exercise that right beforehand, paperwork which it has been possible to carry out in municipal councils on an ongoing basis since 2006.

EU citizens who have expressed the wish to vote in previous electoral procedures and continue to be resident in Spain remain voters, without the need to complete a fresh statement. There is currently a total of 418,187 voters who are nationals of other countries of the European Union for the municipal elections.

Paperwork for expressing one's wish to vote

EU citizens, who are on the municipal register and have not yet expressed their wish to exercise their right to vote in Spain, must do so if they wish to vote in the next municipal elections of 2015.

On a general basis, citizens can express their wish to vote by going to the municipal council where they are registered.

Moreover, in order to enable this paperwork, the Electoral Census Office has posted a communication to 422,008 registered persons who were not written to regarding previous municipal elections and have not expressed that wish.

These citizens need only complete and sign the formal statement contained in the communication and send it to the corresponding Provincial Delegation of the Electoral Census Office. Moreover, those with a Foreigner's Identity Number (NIE) may express their wish online, by going to the Electronic Headquarters on the website of the National Statistics Institute: https://sede.ine.gob.es/en

In turn, those resident in Spain that **are not on the Municipal Register** should go to their Municipal Council to be included on the municipal register and then complete the statement for voting available in the Municipal Council.

The **deadline** for expressing the wish to vote in the next municipal elections **finishes on 30th December 2014**.

Voters and communications sent by province

The largest presence of voters who are nationals of other countries of the EU is in the provinces of Alicante/Alacant (with 70,420), Madrid (55,677), Barcelona (31,781) and Illes Balears (21,052).

The provinces with the highest number of communications sent are Madrid (58,349), Barcelona (45,195), Alicante/Alacant (38,424), Málaga (31,890) and Valencia/València (29,602).

By country, the greatest presence of voters corresponds Romania (105,938), the United Kingdom (100,114), Germany (44,398), Italy (41,779) and France (31,343).

The nationalities with the highest number of communications sent are Romania (145,302), the United Kingdom (58,427), Italy (45,911), Bulgaria (28,756) and Germany (27,721).
