Summary:

The purpose of this proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and the Council is to amend Directive 2009/42/EC.

The Commission adopted the proposal by written procedure on 8th March and sent it to the Council and the European Parliament.

In order to reach an agreement at first reading, the Presidency met the EP Rapporteur in April.

This dossier was discussed at the STATIS WP meeting of 29th April 2010, reaching an agreement in the first meeting. The proposal was submitted to the COREPER and the Council for its formal adoption.

The Rapporteur of the Committee on Transport and Tourism of the European Parliament prepared a draft report on 6th May proposing a number of amendments concerning the delegation of powers to the Commission as consequence of the Lisbon Treaty. The EP plenary opinion is forecast for 6th September.
