#### Summary:

The purpose of this proposal is to establish a common framework for the collection, compilation, transmission and evaluation of European environmental economic accounts for the purpose of setting up environmental economic accounts as satellite accounts to ESA 95 by providing methodology, common standards, definitions, classifications and accounting rules, intended to be used for compiling environmental economic accounts.

The Commission adopted the proposal on 9<sup>th</sup> April and sent it to the Council and the European Parliament.

An informal written consultation to the Member States was carried out on 18<sup>th</sup> May in order to prepare the discussion for the meeting of the WP STATIS of the 1<sup>st</sup> June 2010.

The main issue for Member States concerns the powers conferred on the Commission to adopt delegated acts and much progress on this issue was achieved during the meeting of 1<sup>st</sup> June 2010. Consequently, Spain prepared a Presidency Compromise text for the meeting of the 22<sup>nd</sup> of June.
