

- 1. How to select relevant sources in data production, combine them in an optimal way, and maintain the quality?
- 2. What are the necessary future skills and know-how needed in the data producers of official statistics? And of users?
- 3. Are the current globalisation statistics and their development agenda correctly set up for responding to the needs? How important are coordinated cross-national actions such as exchange of micro-data, profiling, etc.?
- 4. How far can/should official statisticians go in model-based estimation for indicators, and is this still "official statistics"? Can they be of use for policy-makers?
- 5. What are the characteristics of the interaction between statistics and society? What are the opportunities, dangers and risks? How could we help users (policy makers, general public) to deal with the "fallacy of the unambiguity of indicators" (statistics and indicators are not necessarily truly objective and value-free)
