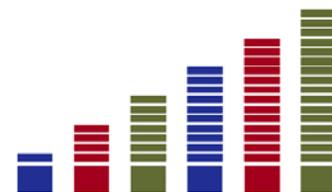

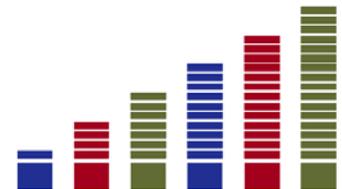

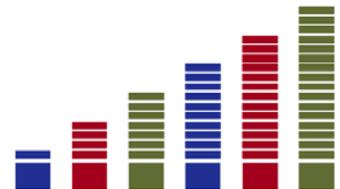
Context

- Move to digital collection
- Admin & 'Big' Data
- Reuse

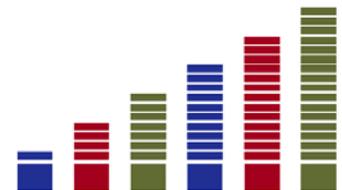


CORA

- CORA – Common OpenRoad Architecture
- 2014 vision for 80% business surveys on new platform
- Synergies between survey processes
- Agile development – incremental with largest benefit first
- DevOps team

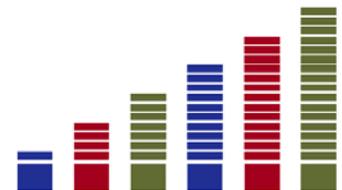


- Reuse of trusted procedures
- Standard data model
- Metadata driven
- Question and Questionnaire libraries
- Templated validation
- Responsibility to business users
- 10 – 12 surveys on platform



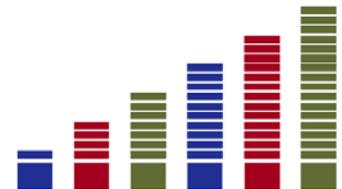
Changing times

- Appointment of CDO and CTO

- New Data Collection Transformation Programme

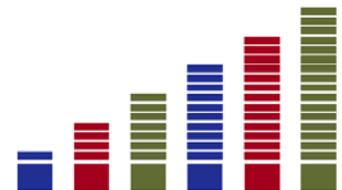
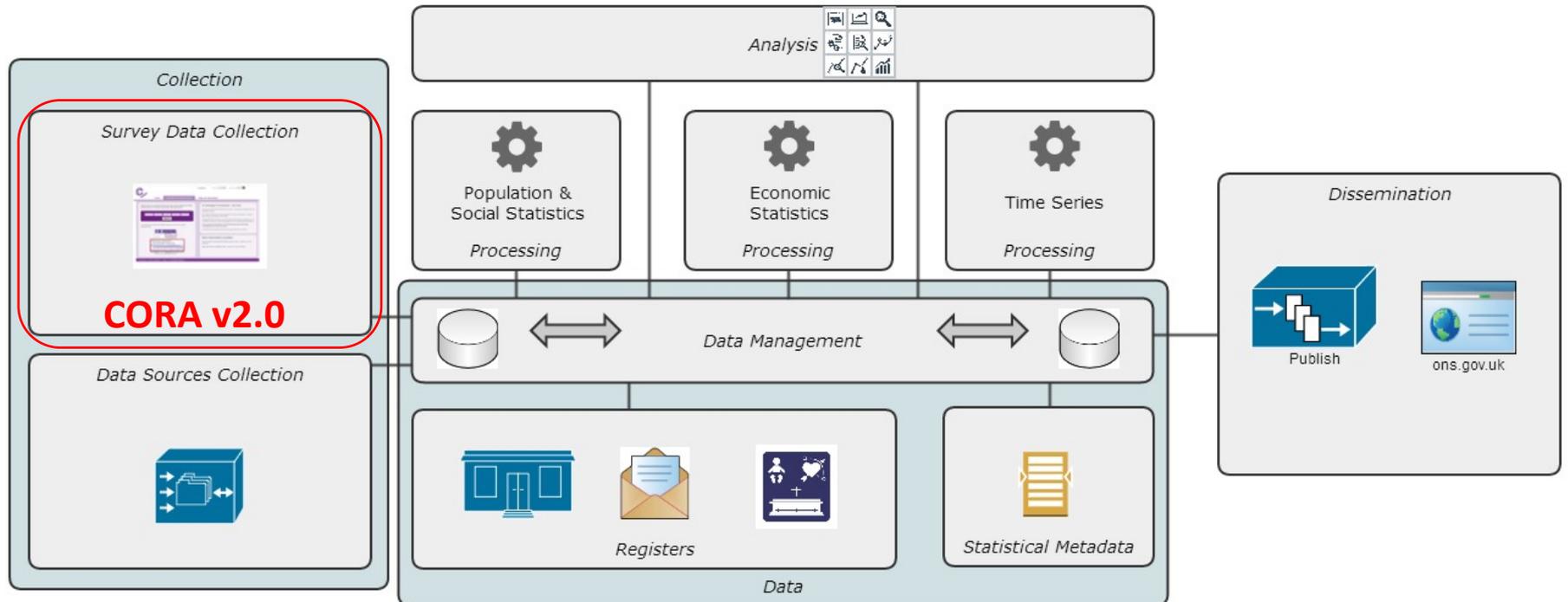


DCTP
