Administrative data purposes

Total or partial replacement of primary statistical information needs, that is, which is collected via traditional surveys

Validation or calibration of the primary statistical information

Update of statistical units registers, essential to provide population and sampling frames with quality

Type of use of administrative data








constraints on its access ... big challenge for SP

- Certain areas/domains have legal specific rules for access to data that are not consistent with legislation that allows access to administrative sources by statistical authorities.
- Lack of understanding of the utility to society and cooperation of entities owners
- Poor quality of administrative data produced (in some cases).
- Lack of an institutional procedure to monitor the progress of legal acts involving the process of the creation of administrative data.
- Lack of an effective mechanism for ensuring the respect for the rights of the statistical authorities in the field of administrative data usage.







Administrative data appropriation process

Weaknesses in the administrative data appropriation

- Coverage and timeliness of administrative data not compatible with the European Regulation requirements of statistical data production.
- Confidentiality of data is very often an excuse/reason to not give administrative data to SP.
- Simplification, modification and/or elimination of administrative acts done unilaterally.







Potentialities of administrative data for statistical purposes

Critical factors

The adequacy of concepts, classifications, nomenclatures and variables of administrative data in what concerns statistical compilation needs


The **quality** of the administrative data itself

The access conditions and terms of transmission of administrative data

The **stability** of the administrative source and its contents

The operational capacity of the statistical authority in the management and storage of a specific administrative data, namely in huge data bases

Developed to make an inventory of potential administrative sources for statistical purposes, within a specific entity

QUAR


Responsibility and Assessment Framework (QUAR)

- Is an integrated approach in defining and assessing the annual main objectives and the indicators that are related to them at organizational level
- A global approach for assessing annual performance, dully aligned with the Strategic Objectives, whose results are used for measuring organization Excellency amongst other organizations in Public Administration

Feasibility studies (e.g.)

- Administrative data use from the Municipalities for the Indicators System of Urban
 Operations
- Increasing of use of administrative data from entities of the Ministries of Agriculture and Economy
- Feasibility study on the use of administrative data from entities related to public transport system
- Administrative data use sources to enhance statistics on internal migrations within the resident population estimates
- Administrative data sources in the new census model for 2021







Successful cases (1) Simplified Business Information


- **2006/2007** Simplifying and modernizing the administration in order to make life easier for enterprises and citizens
- Four national public entities were involved: Ministry of Finance, Ministry of Justice, Statistics Portugal and the Portuguese Central Bank
- 2015 The Ministry of Economy

- System where enterprises can present at the same time their accounting data for fiscal, statistical and annual accounting register in a single moment, using electronic means
- Acquire administrative data while simultaneously complying with **four** legal obligations
- All data is received in electronic format an it covers all the enterprises

Simplified Business Information (IES)


- The whole business production system was reengineered
- SIMPLEX + 2016 (modernisation and simplification of public administration /actions) includes simplified filling of IES in 2017
- **IES represents a giant leap** forward towards the improvement of the coverage, coherence, punctuality, timeliness, comparability and accuracy of business statistics



















Mapping exercise







Administrative data appropriation process Some Guidelines


Identify the legal changes to be made so that it becomes feasible to use the result of the mapping exercise

Identify the requirements for the use of data from administrative sources

Continue with the inventory studies of administrative sources Continue the development of protocols with entities owning administrative sources

Participate in the design process / review of administrative acts Enhance the catalog of administrative sources/data
