

The statistical organisation of the ministerial departments

The following text links those units with some statistical authority, both explicitly and implicitly established, and indicates their functional dependence.

After the title of each ministerial department, the Royal Decree that sets out its basic organic structure is specified between brackets and, where appropriate, the respective reference after those units with specific legislative development.

The order in which the units within each ministry are listed is that which appears in the corresponding Royal Decree, except for the units that exercise the statistical coordination in the department, which are specified first.

- c) To obtain, process and safeguard the data necessary for the compilation of the planned statistics, as well as to edit them and control their distribution.*
- d) To carry out the statistical research, work and reports assigned to it by the corresponding Authorities.*
- e) To collaborate with the National Statistics Institute and official statistical organisations, pursuant to Law 12/1989, of 9 May, on Public Statistical Function, in the areas that affect the Ministry of Defence.*
- f) To fulfil the obligations of the State, in terms of statistics relating to the Ministry of Defence, hired or having been hired with other States or International Organisations.*
- g) To promote the training of the staff of the Service.*
- h) To build and maintain updated a specialised documentary and bibliographic collection.*

The Inspections of Services under the responsibility of Inspectors of Services of the Economy and the Treasury shall perform the following functions:

The inspection of services set out in article 45.dos of Law 22/2009, of 18 December, regulating the financing system of the common-regime Autonomous Communities and cities with a Statute of Autonomous, and modifies certain tax regulations, as well as the coordination of the high inspection referring to the application of the hired or agreed tax systems. This function shall include that of the maintenance of those statistics regarding the management and collection of the taxes granted, derived from the above activity, as well as the preparation of the studies or indicators assigned to it by the bodies with jurisdiction.

The following functions correspond to the Subdirector General for Services Statistics:

The obtaining, compilation, analysis and use of information relating to the management and performance of services that are necessary for exercising the corresponding functions. The Inspectorate General shall maintain a permanent information system relating to the centres and organisations of the department, the resources used and their main objectives.

- To prepare the forecasts, analyses and reports regarding the economic-financial action carried out by the Public Administrations and for each one of their subsectors. Likewise, it is responsible for preparing reports regarding the treatment in the national accounts of the operations carried out by the public sector, and for compiling the statistics regarding public finances for other international organisations.

The coordination and management of the economic-financial information of the Autonomous Communities, as well as the analysis, monitoring and compilation of reports, statistics and publications relating to the accounting, budgetary and organisational aspects of the economic-financial management of the Autonomous Communities.

Subdirectorate General for Financial Relations with Local Entities

The following functions correspond to this subdirectorate general:

The collection, processing and dissemination of the economic-financial data of the local entities.

The Intelligence Centre against Organised Crime is *responsible for the preparation of strategic intelligence in the fight against all types of organised crime.*

The following functions, among others, correspond to this Centre:

To compile and disseminate the statistical information relating to this subject.
